SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

TIME TO GO PROSPECTING: Baseball America and MLB Pipeline both released their updated Brewers Top-30 and overall Top-100 prospect lists on Wednesday and Thursday... OF Jackson Chourio (No. 2), C Jeferson Quero (No. 34) and RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 38) were all listed within the Top-40 of MLB Pipeline's new rankings... The Brewers have six MLB Pipeline Top-100 prospects, tied with the Cleveland Guardians for the second-most in baseball.

PROTECTING HOME TURF: Since the All-Star Break, the Shuckers have won nine of 12 games at MGM Park, tied for the second-highest winning percentage at home in Double-A over that span... The Shuckers have outscored opponents 77-52, a +25 run differential... The Shuckers have a 3.34 ERA at home over that span, the fifth-best mark in Double-A.

MAKING A SPLASH: 1B Ernesto Martinez has been an on-base machine over his first threw games in Double-A, reaching base in eight of 12 plate appearances (four walks, four hits)... He collected his first multi-hit performance in Double-A on Thursday.

Over his last six games, all coming against Cubs affiliates in High-A (South Bend) and Double-A (Tennessee), Martinez is 8-20 (.400) with two doubles. a triple. six RBI and four walks.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Biloxi Shuckers would qualify for the 2023 Southern League Playoffs, their first appearance since 2019... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half title in the division... The Shuckers are tied for the South Division lead and are three games ahead of the Montgomery Biscuits... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

<u>CLOSING IN ON THE RECORD BOOKS</u>: OF Jackson Chourio enters today three home runs away from becoming the first teenager in Double-A or Triple-A to record 20 home runs and 20 stolen bases in a season since **OF Delmon Young** in 2005 with the Montgomery Biscuits (TB).

- Chourio's 71 RBI are tied with OF Dillon Thomas for the second-most in a single-season in Shuckers' history (since 2015)... Chourio is three away from tying the single-season franchise record (74), set by OF Corey Ray in 2017.
- Chourio is currently among the Southern League leaders in hits [1st, 112], RBI (4th, 71], extra-base hits (T-4th, 38), stolen bases (5th, 32), average (7th, .284) and home runs (8th, 17).

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP TOBIAS MYERS [6-3, 5.38]: RHP Tobias Myers makes his 20th start of the year, marking his third straight year with at least 20, and the fourth time in his career... Myers struck out seven and allowed one hit over five shutout innings in his previous start, on August 6, at Pensacola... Myers has gone at least five innings in each of his last five starts.
