SEA DOGS WIN AGAIN Despite trailing in the eighth inning, the Sea Dogs came back to beat the Altoona Curve last night, 13-8 at Hadlock Field. Alex Binelas ignited the scoring with a two-run single after both Anthony and Campbell reached on singles to extend their on-base streaks. Altoona scored a run in the top of the second after a successful double steal. Sammy Siani stole home to cut the lead in half. In the bottom of the second, Campbell hit an RBI single to score Luis Ravelo and extend a two-run lead. A sacrifice fly to right field from Kyle Teel put Portland up by three. The Curve tied the game in the top of the third scoring three runs. An RBI double from Abraham Gutierrez highlighted the scoring. Marrero blasted his first homer of the game to right-center field in the bottom of the third to put Portland back on top, 5-4. Tsung-Che Cheng countered with a grand slam in the top of the sixth inning to give Altoona their first lead of the series, 8-5. Anthony roped his third hit of the day in the bottom of the sixth. The RBI single put Portland within two.

THE EIGHTH INNING Portland sent eleven to the plate last night in the eighth inning to score seven runs on six hits. Marrero smoked his second homer of the night to lead off the inning and put Portland within one. A bases-clearing double from Blaze Jordan gave the Sea Dogs a 10-8 lead. Marrero capped the inning with his fourth hit of the night. A two-run double put Portland on top by five and completed the comeback, 13-8.

THE ELIH MARRERO GAME Catcher Elih Marrero blasted two home runs with a pair of doubles in last night's win. He also drove home three runs and scored three runs. It was the first multi-homer game of his career and tied a career-high in hits. Marrero was also catching last night and threw out two would-be base stealers.

ROMAN ANTHONY ALSO STANDS OUT Roman Anthony also had a very strong night at the plate recording four hits with two runs and one RBI. It was just the second time in his career he had four hits in a game and the first time since August 15, 2023 with the High-A Greenville Drive.

THE STREAKS CONTINUE Kristian Campbell and Roman Anthony both extended their on base streaks last night in the first inning with a pair of singles. Campbell has now reached base in 23 consecutive games batting .352 (31-for-88) with ten doubles and 13 RBI. He also has swiped 10 bases while only being caught twice. Anthony is hitting .346 (28-for-81) in his 19 game on base streak with four doubles, a triple and four home runs. He also has 13 RBI. Campbell's streak is the longest active in the Eastern League and the longest of the season for a Sea Dog.

SEA DOGS STAY STRONG After losing four straight games from July 20th to the 24th, the Sea Dogs have gone on a tear. With another win last night, Portland has won 11 of their last 12 games.

BEST IN DOUBLE-A The Sea Dogs have the best batting average (.267) in Double-A and also lead the level in runs scored (553), doubles (228), RBI (509), OBP (.351), SLG (.426) and OPS (.777). They also rank fifth in walks (406) and seventh in stolen bases (150). The pitching staff ranks first in saves (21) and seventh in ERA (4.54).

WHERE DO WE STAND Portland currently sits atop the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, 2.0 games ahead of the second-place Somerset Patriots. The Hartford Yard Goats are 2.5 games out of first place while the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are in fourth place, 4.5 games behind the Sea Dogs. Both the Reading Fightin Phils and New Hampshire Fisher Cats are 10.0 games out of first place.

THIS DATE IN SEA DOGS HISTORY August 8, 2009 – Portland plays their second career game at Fenway Park, defeating the Bowie Baysox 3-2. Jason Place homered over the Green Monster and finished with 3 RBI. Ryne Miller earned his first Double-A win, hurling two scoreless innings of relief.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP Hunter Dobbins makes his 19th start for the Sea Dogs today. Dobbins last pitched on August 2nd against the Erie SeaWolves and tossed 5.0 innings allowing two runs (one earned) on six hits while walking two and striking out four. Dobbins has faced the Curve once. On May 31st he tossed 7.0 shutout innings allowing three hits while walking one and striking out eight. The eight strikeouts and 7.0 innings both matched a season-high for Dobbins.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

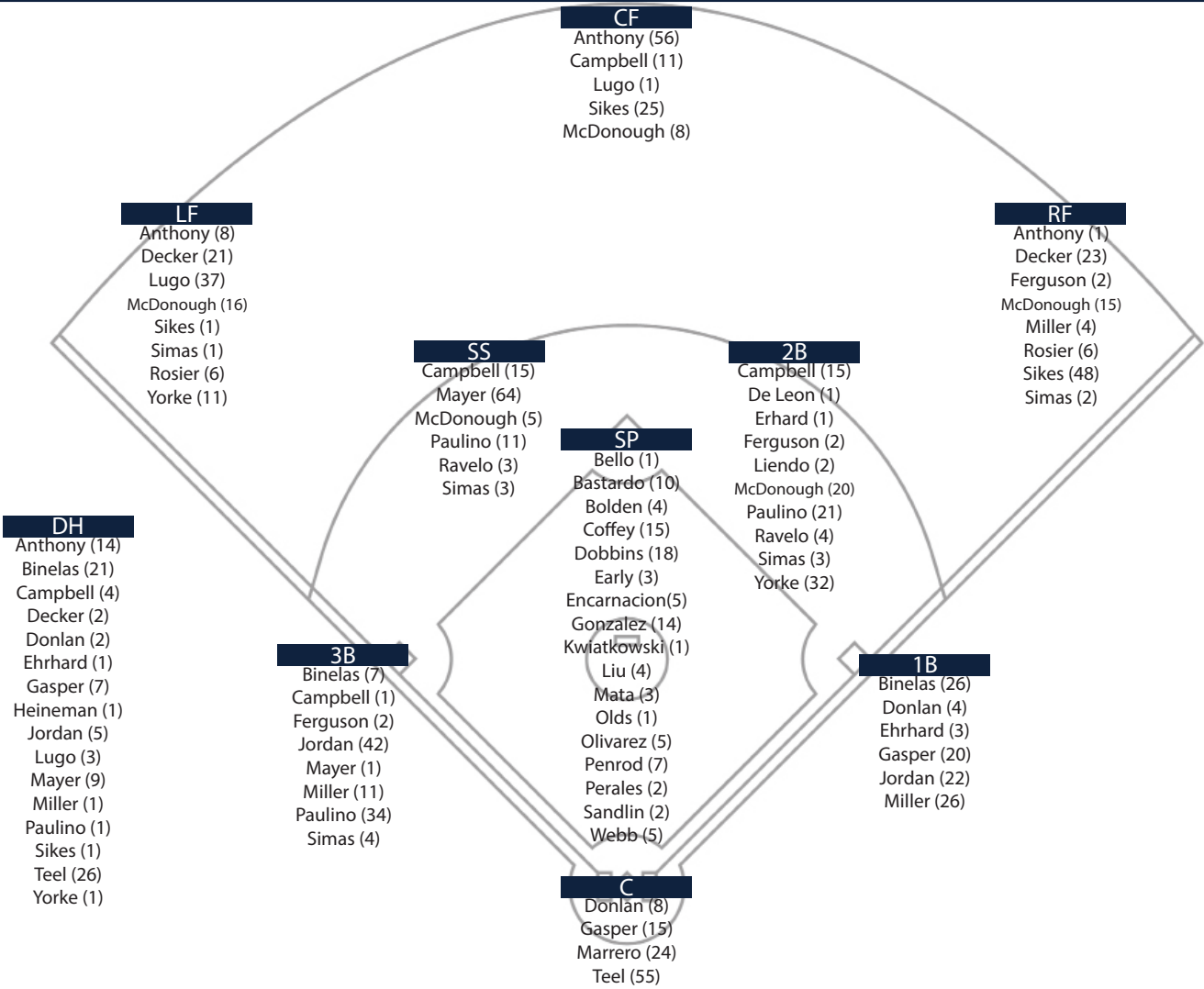
