GAME 113: After winning the first two of the series and dropping the last two, the weekend has arrived at Virginia Credit Union Stadium in this six game set between the FredNats and the Boston-affiliated Salem Red Sox. Fredericksburg's defense has been lacking the last two days, allowing Salem to score unearned runs and extend innings to do damage. Tonight, Fredericksburg sends Bryan Polanco to the mound, who took a perfect game into the 6th inning the first and only time he faced the Red Sox this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg got a two-run homer from Nick Peoples, but that was the entirety of the offense in a 6-2 defeat to Salem. The offense only managed four total hits. A positive was another solid start from Travis Sthele, who pitched five innings of three-run ball. Seaver King picked up a base hit and his first professional stolen base in the loss.

INSTANT IMPACT: Washington's top two picks in the 2024 draft - Seaver King and Caleb Lomavita - both made their professional debuts this week and have majorly contributed to the two wins this week over Salem. King has two hits in both his games so far, including a triple in the first inning of last night's game to open the scoring. Lomavita has two hits in two games and has scored five runs, reaching base in six out of nine plate appearances. In MLB Pipeline's updated post-draft rankings that were released yesterday, King is Washington's 5th-best prospect and Lomavita is ranked 10th.

HOT AUGUST: A few FredNat hitters are off to a good start through the first half of August. Brandon Pimentel, Jorgelys Mota, Everett Cooper III and Cristhian Vaquero are all hitting over .300 this month with an OPS over .800. Those four hitters have been key to Fredericksburg's offense averaging over five runs per game in August.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In seven starts since July 1, Sykora has allowed a total of six earned runs for an ERA of 1.29 in that time frame. He's got 49 strikeouts and nine walks in those six starts, and the FredNats have won five out of the six games. The opponents are hitting .112 against him in that time frame, and .162 for the entire season. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well.

NO-HITTER! Last Friday, Travis Sykora, Angel Roman and Merrick Baldo combined to throw the first nine inning no-hitter in Fredericksburg Nationals history. It was the 32nd total no-hitter this year in Minor League Baseball, but only 20 of those have come in full-season ball. Of the 32 total no-no's this year in MiLB, only 16 of them have come in nine innings. It was the second no-hitter this year in the league.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 203-169 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Frelich, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Frelich begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TODAY'S START: Bryan Polanco is set to make his 16th start of the season, this evening, against the Carolina Mudcats. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, and has been a key member of the starting rotation after the promotion of Jose Atencio in mid-May.

NOTHING NEW: While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: Polanco has started twice against Salem this year, covering 11 innings and has allowed just two earned runs. Bryan has also racked up 13 strikeouts, against one free pass.

LAST TIME OUT: Polanco worked just two frames against the Mudcats last start, giving up two hits and two earned runs.
