LAST TIME OUT: The Rocket City Trash Pandas blew a 9-0, fifth-inning lead and fell to Chattanooga 10-9 Friday evening. The Trash Pandas scored in the first on an RBI double from Orlando Martinez, then plated three more runs in the third on a balk, RBI triple from Ibandel Isabel, and a sac fly from Luis Aviles. They added five more in the fifth as Mitch Nay laced an RBI double, Torii Hunter Jr. scratched across an RBI single, and Gavin Cecchini lifted a sac fly. RBI singles from Izzy Wilson and Martinez capped the scoring. However, the bullpen for Rocket City struggled after allowing all 10 runs on 12 hits over the final 4.1 innings. Right-hander Kyle Tyler allowed five runs in four innings after Chris Rodriguez started and threw 1.1 scoreless innings. Oliver Ortega surrendered three runs on five hits in 1.2 innings, and closer Connor Higgins suffered the loss after giving up the final two runs in one frame of work. Rocket City cranked out a season-high 19 hits in the contest. Isabel was a homerun short of the cycle as he went 3-5 with two runs scored and RBI, Martinez finished 4-5 with two doubles, two runs scored and an RBI. First-baseman David MacKinnon had three singles, an RBI and a run. Hunter had three singles, RBI and run. Third-baseman Mitch Nay was 2-5 with a double, RBI and run scored, while Cecchini had two singles and a sac fly.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City nickname by launching 63 homers, which leads AA-South and is tied with NW Arkansas and Corpus Christi for the lead in all of AA. Outfielder Izzy Wilson leads the way with 11, which is tied for a league lead. Orlando Martinez and Mitch Nay are close behind with 10 home runs each.

GETTING K'S: Rocket City pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 463 batters through the first 45 games. That is good enough for second in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 16, which has happened twice, first on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. The also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, and another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5. Southpaw Reid Detmers leads the way with 60 K's after he punched out 14 Shuckers on 6/20 in game one of a doubleheader.

LOOKOUT, CHATTANOOGA, FOR ORLANDO: Rocket City outfielder Orlando Martinez had a career night in the 5/7 win over Chattanooga. The No. 17 prospect in the Angels' organization set new career highs with three home runs and six RBI and tied a career-high with four hits in the win. He became the first Trash Panda to record a multi-home run game. On 6/24, his two-run dinger against the Lookouts gave him his fifth homer (out of 10) at AT&T Field this season. He is seeing the ball much better as well. After dropping to a .218 average following an 0-4 night against Birmingham on 5/25, Martinez is 31-88 (.352) with six dingers and 15 RBI to give him a .289 average for the season. For the month of June, Martinez is slashing .338/.405/.577. He now has 28 RBI on the season, which tied for first in AA-South.

IZZY BEEN BUSY: Since turning the calendar to June, outfielder Izzy Wilson has been hitting out of his mind going 23-66 (.348) with six homers and 17 RBI. The first home run was especially memorable as he launched a three-run blast off Chattanooga starting pitcher Hunter Greene, one of the top prospects in all of MiLB, on 6/4. The following week, Wilson had a night to remember as he went 4-4 with two singles, two homers, two runs scored and two stolen bases on 6/10 against Tennessee. Izzy currently leads the Trash Pandas and is tied for second in AA-South with 11 dingers. In addition, Wilson stole four bases in the Tennessee series that began on 6/8. He currently has 11 steals in 15 attempts, which is tied for second in AA-South. He also has 26 RBI, which ranks fourth in the league.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Coming off one of his best performances of the season, Reid Detmers will take the hill for Rocket City. On 6/20 against Biloxi, Detmers struck out 14 batters in six-innings in game one of a doubleheader leading the Trash Pandas to a 3-2 win. The 14 strikeouts were a career-high for Detmers and tied for a season-high among Trash Pandas hurlers. Over a three-outing span from 5/12-5/25 he had allowed only three ER in 15.2 innings. His best performance came on 5/25 when he allowed an unearned run on one infield single in six innings of work with 10 strikeouts against one of the top hitting teams in AA, Birmingham. Unfortunately, the Trash Pandas only provided Detmers three runs of support over those three outings, leading to three straight no-decisions. Detmers finally notched his first professional win as he K'd 10 and walked none on five hits over five innings in a 3-1 win over Chattanooga on 6/5. A couple of so-so performances followed before he punched out 14 Shuckers in a 3-2 win over Biloxi on 6/20. Detmers racked up the K's over six innings. He leads all Rocket City hurlers with 60 strikeouts. Currently, he is ranked as the Angels No. 2 prospect and the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball by MLB.com.

WHAT IS A TRASH PANDA?

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunatics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds.

More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far - the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).



NEW MiLB RULES FOR 2021

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE DETMERS FILE: LHP Reid Detmers begins his pro career by making the jump straight to Double-A with the Trash Pandas. Selected by the Angels with the 10th overall pick in the 2020 draft, Detmers spent the 2020 season at the Angels Alternate Training Site in Long Beach. He is currently ranked as the Angels No. 2 prospect and the No. 58 prospect in all of baseball according to MLB.com. He started both the first game in Trash Pandas history on May 5 at Chattanooga and the inaugural game at Toyota Field on May 11 vs. Tennessee. On May 25, he recorded 10 strikeouts in his longest outing as a pro for his first quality start. Detmers finally earned his first pro win in his sixth start, striking out 10 and giving up one run over 5.0 innings in a 3-1 win over the Lookouts on June 5. In his last start on June 20 vs. Biloxi, he set a new career-high and tied a Trash Pandas franchise record with 14 strikeouts, including three in a row on nine pitches in an immaculate first inning in route to his second career win. Over five home starts, he is 2-1 with a 2.96 ERA (8 ER/24.1 IP) and 0-1 with a 4.22 ERA (5 ER/10.2 IP) in three games away from Toyota Field.

VS. CHATTANOOGA: Over 2 previous starts against the Lookouts this season, Detmers is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (4 ER/6.2 IP). He struck out 12 and walked two. He took the loss in his first professional start on May 5 before a win on June 5.

MORE NOTES

HISTORIC DEBUTS: Detmers made the start for Rocket City in the first game in franchise history on May 5 at Chattanooga. In his professional debut, he took the loss after giving up three runs in 1.2 innings. He did record the first strikeout in Trash Pandas history in the bottom of the first inning by firing a 95 mile-per-hour fastball past Wilson Garcia to end the inning. On May 11, he started the inaugural game at Toyota Field and recorded the first two strikeouts in the top of the first inning against Tennessee. In that game, he recorded nine strikeouts over 4.2 innings and did not factor in the final decision as the Trash Pandas fell 4-3 in 10 innings.

CARDINAL CRUSHING: Detmers pitched three collegiate seasons at the University of Louisville from 2018-20. In a shortened junior season in 2020 prior to being drafted, he was 3-0 with a 1.23 ERA (3 ER/22.0 IP) while leading the ACC with 48 strikeouts across his four starts. He struck out 10 or more in all four outings, including a 15-strikeout performance in his final start of the season at Wake Forest before the season was shut down. Over three seasons at Louisville, he was 20-6 with a 3.20 ERA (68 ER/191.0 IP) and 284 strikeouts over 41 games (30 starts).

RED, WHITE, AND BLUE: Pitched for the USA Collegiate National Team in the summer of 2019, going 2-0 over three starts with one run allowed in 12.0 innings. He picked up wins over Chinese Taipei and Japan, giving up just one hit in each start and holding both teams scoreless.

HIGH SCHOOL NOTES: Graduated from Glenwood High School (Chatham, IL), where he played his final prep season and finished his senior season with a 9-2 record, 1.87 ERA and 153 strikeouts. He played his first three seasons of high school baseball at Nokomis High School (Nokomis, IL). He received All-Conference honors all four years in high school.

FIRST DRAFT: Detmers was originally drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the 32nd round (950th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign. Just five picks later, the Angels drafted infielder David MacKinnon and he did sign with Los Angeles. MacKinnon and Detmers are now teammates with the Trash Pandas.

LIKE FATHER LIKE SON: Reid's father, Kris Detmers, was also a professional baseball pitcher. Over a seven-year professional career from 1994-2000, Kris pitched in the St. Louis Cardinals organization and reached as high as Triple-A Memphis, where he went 6-8 over 23 games in 1999. His 90 strikeouts for the Redbirds that season ranked second behind future big leaguer Rick Ankiel's 119.
