### INDY BITS

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** The Indianapolis Indians offense could not rally in the ninth as they suffered their second loss of the series to the Louisville Bats at Louisville Slugger Field on Wednesday afternoon, 4-3. Louisville started the scoring in the third inning when Hernán Pérez crushed a solo shot off a Cam Allred fastball. Indianapolis quickly responded in the following frame when Jake Lamb roped a double to right field to score Nick Gonzales. After walking earlier in the inning, Henry Davis scored the second run of the inning on a sacrifice fly courtesy of Liover Peguero. After a pitching change with the bases loaded in the fifth, Casey Legumina drilled Davis on a fastball that allowed Matt Gorksi to score from third after he singled earlier in the frame. At the turn of the inning, Louisville responded with a run of its own on a fielder's choice that plated Levi Jordan. Trailing by a run after six innings of play, Louisville relied on timely hitting to tie the game in the seventh with a Livan Soto single and take the lead in the eighth with an Austin Wynns double. In the ninth, Tony Santillan held off a late rally from Indianapolis after Ji Hwan Bae and Henry Davis started the rally with singles. Davis was doubled up on first base by a Jake Lamb line drive caught by first baseman Edwin Ríos to end the game.

**ALLDRED VS. THE BATS:** Cam Allred has been an effective force against Louisville in his career, going 4-0 with a 3.58 ERA (13er/32.2ip) and 29 strikeouts in 11 games (three starts) since making his Triple-A debut at Louisville on 9/8/21. Yesterday, he tossed 5.0 two-run (one earned) innings with no walks and five strikeouts. Allred's previous appearance at Louisville Slugger Field came on 6/29/23, when he spun a quality start and career-high eight strikeouts to earn the win. In five career games (two starts) in Louisville, he is 2-0 with a 2.50 ERA (6er/18.0ip) and 18 strikeouts.

**RAKE LAMB:** Jake Lamb went 1-for-5 with an RBI double yesterday at Louisville to extend his hitting streak to nine games since 4/25. He has now reached base safely in 25 of 26 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.388, 33-for-85) while also ranking third in on-base percentage (.472), fifth in OPS (1.060) and 10th in slugging percentage (.588). During his hitting streak, he owns a .382 batting average (13-for-34) with seven runs, five doubles, one home run and seven RBI. Since 4/18, when his current 14-game on-base streak began, he is hitting .435 (20-for-46) with nine runs, seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, eight walks, a .492 on-base percentage and 1.144 OPS.

**GONZO GETS ON BASE:** Nick Gonzales, who trails teammate Jake Lamb as the International League's second-best hitter with a .358 batting average (43-for-120) this season, went 0-for-2 but reached base safely on three walks yesterday at Louisville. He has now reached base safely in each of his last eight games with a .276 batting average (8-for-29), 11 runs, three doubles, one triple, two home runs, six RBI and as many walks (7) as strikeouts (7). In addition to batting average, Gonzales also ranks among IL leaders in runs (1st, 33), doubles (1st, 14), hits (T-1st, 43), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 20), total bases (4th, 73), slugging percentage (7th, .608) and OPS (7th, 1.039).

**WELCOME HOME:** University of Louisville product Henry Davis went 1-for-3 with a run, walk and RBI yesterday at Louisville in his second game after being optioned by Pittsburgh last week. Davis began the season on the Pirates' Opening Day roster and hit .162 (11-for-68) with seven runs, three doubles and four RBI in 23 games with the big-league club before being optioned last week. In 14 Triple-A games with Indy last season, he hit .375 (18-for-48) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, a .516 on-base percentage and 1.120 OPS. He was the first baseball player from Louisville to be selected first overall and the fourth student-athlete taken No. 1 overall from the school regardless of sport.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians will look to win their first contest of the six-game series at Louisville tonight at 6:35 PM at Louisville Slugger Field. The Bats took two of three meetings during the opening series between the two teams from 3/29-3/31 and lead the season series, 3-1. Continuing the series for the Indians today is LHP Geronimo Franzua (1-1, 6.08), making his second appearance against Louisville this season. Countering for the Bats is RHP Brett Kennedy (1-3, 6.03), who is 1-0 with a 6.97 ERA (8er/10.1ip) and five strikeouts in two career starts against Indy.

**FRANZUA TAKES THE BUMP:** Southpaw Geronimo Franzua is set to make his first start with Indianapolis and 22nd in affiliated baseball tonight at Louisville. Franzua made his last start with FCL Pirates on 6/6/23, his first appearance after spending 10 years playing in Japan. He appeared with DSL Astros from 2011-13 and made 20 starts in 37 appearances. In his career as a starter in affiliated baseball, he is 1-9 with a 4.61 ERA (36er/70.1ip) and 55 strikeouts.

**NEWBIES:** Outfielder Matt Fraizer and right-handed pitcher Isaac Mattson were promoted from Double-A Altoona on Tuesday ahead of Indianapolis' series-opener at Louisville. Fraizer is set to make his Triple-A debut after spending the last two seasons with the Curve. Mattson was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent in the offseason and owns a career 1-2 record, 5.89 ERA (29er/44.1ip) and 57 strikeouts in 42 Triple-A appearances.

**THIS DATE IN 1963:** Fritz Ackley threw 5.2 scoreless innings and Warren Hacker followed suit with 3.1 scoreless frames as the Indians blanked Jacksonville on the road, 6-0. Third baseman Don Buford, who was the 1963 Team and International League MVP, went 3-for-5 with one RBI atop the lineup. Second baseman Ramon Conde finished 2-for-4 with a double and RBI, as well.
