### TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Saints rallied to tie the game in the eighth inning, but the Bats would get the walk-off win in 10 innings on a wild pitch. Trailing 1-0 in the fourth, the Saints plated a pair of runs. Patrick Winkel hit a fielder's choice to score one and Alex Isola hit an RBI single to score the second, giving the Saints a 2-1 lead. The Bats would score the next three runs, taking the 4-2 lead. In the eighth, Anthony Prato and Isola hit RBI singles to tie the game at four. Jeff Brigham dealt 2.0 innings of strong relief, striking out five over the eighth and ninth to force extras. The Saints were held off the board in the 10<sup>th</sup>. In the bottom of the inning, Diego Castillo threw a wild pitch with the bases loaded, allowing the winning run to score and giving Louisville a 5-4 win.

**A TALE OF TWO SERIES:** The first trip to Louisville saw the Saints sweep the Bats, but have not had the same fortune this series. Below are stats from the Saints' last trip to Louisville and this week's:

**AND THEY'RE OFF!** The Saints have ambushed the Louisville Bats in the first inning this season, scoring 28 runs in the opening frame. Those 28 runs are the most any team has scored against any opponent in the first inning in all of baseball. It is also tied for the eighth-most runs a team has scored against one opponent in any inning across all of baseball.

**JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE:** After his single in the first inning on Saturday, Edouard Julien has reached base in 23 consecutive games, the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is tied four for the fourth-longest streak in franchise history with Austin Martin and Matt Wallner - 23G (2023). He trails only Trevor Larnach - 26 G (2022-23) and Jake Cave - 49 G (2022). During his 23-game streak, Julien is hitting .284/.468/.457 (.925 OPS).

**REHAB ROUNDTABLE:** The Saints have two Major League Rehab assignments added to their roster in Brock Stewart and Zack Weiss. Stewart has made two appearances (2.0 IP, 1H, 1ER, 2BB, 3K). Weiss made his first Triple-A rehab outing on Wednesday, striking out four and allowing a hit in 2.0 innings.

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .469 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in seven of the nine games he's played in, drawing six walks and been hit by a pitch four times. *He is third among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .456 across three levels.*

**WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH:** Chris Williams hit his 10<sup>th</sup> home run of the season on Wednesday and the 41<sup>st</sup> of his Saints career. He is now just two home runs away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43.

Williams has hit seven home runs in 12 career games at Louisville Slugger Field. His .130 HR/PA is the best for any Saints batter in Louisville and *is the fourth-best of any IL batter and any ballpark since 2021 (min. 30 AB)*. His 1.410 OPS in Louisville is the second-best for any Saints player in franchise history.

**SUMMERTIME SEVERINO:** In Yunior Severino's 42 games since May 21, he has hit .346 (53-for-153), with 10 home runs, drawing 31 walks to 42 strikeouts, owning a 1.052 OPS. Since June 1, Severino leads the IL in batting average at .356 and on-base percentage, sporting a .473 clip. He's fifth in OPS, at 1.075, ranking sixth in slugging percentage with a .602 mark. His 26 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

**TWINS UPDATE:** The Twins bounced back with a 4-2 win over San Francisco on Saturday. Simeon Woods Richardson struck out seven over 4.1 innings. Carlos Santana delivered a go-ahead homer in the sixth, giving the Twins a 3-2 lead. Cole Sands got his fourth win of the season, throwing 1.2 innings of perfect relief.

**WYNTON BERNARD - OF** #9

- Began the season with Triple-A Charlotte, hitting .306/.328/.446 with six doubles, one triple, three home runs and 14 RBI, going 11-for-12 in stolen bases.
- Was riding a 14-game hit streak when he joined the Saints, extended it to 15 games before snapping it on July 12.
- Has collected 1046 hits over 1051 career minor league games prior to joining the Saints.
- Twins mark the eighth organization of his career, opening with the Padres after getting drafted in the 35th round in 2012. He also spent time in the following minor league systems: Detroit (2014-16), San Francisco (2017), Chicago (NL) (2018-19), Colorado (2021-2022, 2023), Toronto (2023) and Chicago (AL) (2024).
- In 2023, he hit a combined .302/.375/.443 (153-506) with 36 doubles, one triple, 11 home runs, 65 RBI and 41 steals over 126 games between Class AAA Albuquerque in the Rockies organization and Class AAA Buffalo in the Blue Jays system.
- Made his Major League debut with Colorado in 2022. At 31, he became the oldest player in MLB history to record a hit and stolen base in their debut since Joe Delahanty in 1907.
- In 2022, he led the Pacific Coast League in average (.333) and OPS (.977), ranked second in slugging (.590) and hits (143), tied for second in triples (8) and extra-base hits (60), ranked third in total bases (253) and RBI (92), fifth in OBP (.387) and runs scored (95), seventh in doubles (31) and tied for seventh in stolen bases (30).
- His brother, Walter, played five seasons in the NFL for the Chargers, Colts, and Seahawks from 2001-05 and his brother Wayne played professional basketball in Europe from 2002-18
- Appeared on an episode of Family Feud with his brother Walter in 2011

  - 37th round pick by the Philadelphia Phillies in 2017 out of Cardinal Roy (Ancienne-Lorette, QC) SS, but did not sign

  - Speaks English, French, and Spanish. When he went to school at Alabama, didn't speak English well
