TODAY'S GAMES: Having dropped their last three games, the Space Cowboys conclude their six-game series against the Rainiers... This is just the third series played away from Constellation Field for Sugar Land since the All-Star Break... All time, the Space Cowboys are 6-5 in Tacoma, taking 5 of 6 from the Rainiers last season from $4 / 19$ to $4 / 24$.
ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: Tacoma took a 1-0 lead in the first on a Jake Scheiner RBI double, but a solo home run by Dixon Machado tied the game in the third... Tacoma scored a run in both the third and fourth and a two-RBI single from Scheiner in the fifth made it a 5-1 Tacoma lead... Shay Whitcomb homered in the sixth to drive in a run and Machado singled in another run, pulling the Space Cowboys within two... However, Sugar Land left the bases loaded in the seventh, stranding 11 total runners in a 5-3 defeat.

ROSTER MOVES: 9/3-LHP Bennett Sousa claimed off waivers and optioned to Sugar Land... INF Rylan Bannon designated for assignment... 9/1-RHP Joel Kuhnel recalled by Houston... RHP Jake Cousins clears waivers, outrighted to Sugar Land... 8/31- OF Justin Dirden placed on the IL, retro to 8/30... 8/29-RHP Jake Cousins designated for assignment... OF Corey Julks optioned to Sugar Land... OF Michael Brantley activated from IL and completes ML Rehab
HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in 2020 and 7 international signings

## PROSPECTING: With the re-ranking of MLB Pipeline's

 Prospects, Sugar Land now has seven of the Astros' Top 30 prospects on their roster, including RHP Spencer Arrighetti (\#3), OF Joey Loperfido (\#6), LHP Colton Gordon (\#7), RHP Rhett Kouba (\#9), OF Pedro Leon (\#13), INF Shay Whitcomb (\#25) \& RHP Misael Tamarez (\#30).SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 5-13-2 in sixgame series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-1 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 3-7-1 overall at Constellation Field in 2023.

WHIT-BOMB: With a solo home run on Saturday night, Shay Whitcomb is now tied for third in Minor League Baseball in home runs, launching 31 total homers between Corpus Christi (12) and Sugar Land (19)... Between the Minor Leagues and MLB, he is one of just 21 players to launch at least 30 home runs this year.
The Space Cowboys infielder is also leading the way in the Astros' organization in home runs (31), RBI (89), Total Bases (226) \& Hits (116), T-2nd in Extra-Base Hits (48) \& 4th in Runs Scored (71).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Space Cowboys offensive efforts have been stunted by the Rainiers defense in the first five games of their series... Sugar Land has hit into 10 total double plays over the last five games... On the flip side, the Space Cowboys turned three double plays on Friday night, and have produced at least one twin-killing defensively in six of the last seven games, turning 13 total in that span.

MACHO-MACHO-MACHADO: Dixon Machado extended his on-base streak to 10 games on Saturday night, going 2 -for-2 with a single, a home run, 2 RBI, R and 2 walks... During Machado's 10 -game on-base streak, he's slashing .357/.513/.679/1.192 (10-for-28) with 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 6 runs scored and 10 walks... The infielder has hit safely in six of his last eight games including four multi-hit efforts... The San Cristobal, VZ native has registered multi-RBI games in three of his last four starts, plating 9 total batters in that span, and has also homered in three of his last four games.
LOWDOWN ON LOPERFIDO: OF Joey Loperfido was promoted to Sugar Land on $8 / 15$ and made his Triple-A debut that night, going 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored... At the time of his promotion, Loperfido was tied for the Texas League lead in OPS' (.940), 2nd in SIg $\%$ (.548), T-5th in Home Runs (19), 6th in Avg (.296) \& OBP (.392), 8 th in extra-base hits (40) \& total bases (172).

Loperfido has reached safely in 8 of his last 10 games, recording a .378 OBP with 2 doubles, a home run, 3 RBI, 7 walks and a pair of hit by pitches.
The 24 -year-old is 1st in the Astros' organization in Extra-Base Hits (50), 2nd in SLG (.528), Doubles (25), Total Bases (211) \& Hits (114), T-2nd in HR (22), 3rd in Avg (.285), Walks (61) \& OPS (.912), 4th in RBI (68) \& OBP (.384) and 5th in Runs Scored (69) and Stolen Bases (25).
RECORD KEEPING: Since $8 / 15$, RHP Joe Record has made seven straight appearances without allowing a run... Record has thrown 7.1 innings giving up just three hits while striking out 10 and holding opponents to $a .120$ batting average against.

His seven straight scoreless outings are tied for the second longest streak for a Space Cowboys reliever this season, behind only Record's 13 straight scoreless outings that he made from May 10 thorugh June 11 earlier this season.
PALMS SWEATY, SPENGER ARRIGHETTI: In 4 home starts in August, Arrighetti surrendered just two earned run across 21.0 innings... In 7 overall starts at Constellation Field, the righty is $1-1$ with a 2.10 ERA, allowing 8 earned runs in 34.1 innings while striking out 30 .
SEEING 20-20: Both Pedro Leon ( 21 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido ( 25 2B, 22 HR) have posted seasons in which they have at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 15 bases (Leon -15; Loperfido 25)... They are two of just 14 players in Minor League Baseball with at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 15 stolen bases, and Loperfido is one of just seven players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases.

RIDE THE BIKEI: On 6/24, Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from $5 / 2-5 / 7$, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high among full season MiLB teams.

RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABO: On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a $24-8$ win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) \& at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN: Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on $5 / 4$ against ABQ, going 4 -for- 5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: In the seventh inning on $5 / 5$ @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on $5 / 13$ \& $5 / 17$ (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On $5 / 2$ @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5 -for- 6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on $4 / 5 / 23$ vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on $5 / 7$, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD: As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in ' 16 and ' 18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its ' 13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT: Got the start in the opener on Tuesday night... Retired the side in order in the first but gave up a run in the second on a walk and a double inside of third by Jake Scheiner... Walked the next batter but proceeded to retired 9 of the next 10... Gave up his only other two runs in the bottom of the fifth on a bunt single and a two-run homer by Pedro Severino... Struck out seven and did not receive any run support in a 5-0 Space Cowboys defeat.

FLAME THROWER: Tamarez clocked 4 pitches over 99.5 mph on $7 / 30$ at Las Vegas, throwing pitches of $99.6 \mathrm{mph}(2 \mathrm{X}), 99.7 \mathrm{mph}$ and 99.9 mph during his 1.1 innings of relief... They are four of the five fastest pitches thrown by Space Cowboys pitchers this year; the only faster pitch was a 100.0 mph fastball from RHP Forrest Whitley on $4 / 25$ @ RNO.

ZEROING IN: Since returning from the IL on $5 / 20$, has walked 33 while striking out 68... Before going on the IL had walked 18 and struck out 8

COMING BACK: Placed on the IL on 4/29... Activated on 5/20.
WALKING THE TIGHT ROPE: Walked a career high 8 batters in 4.1 innings of work on April 11 against Oklahoma City. Despite the eight free passes, Tamarez allowed just one run against the Dodgers.

SHOW BEFORE THE SHOW: Made his Triple-A debut on Sept. 8, 2022 at Round Rock ... Made four appearances to end the year with Sugar Land, going 1-1 with a 2.50 ERA... In his final appearance of 2022, threw five nohit innings against and allowed a run on five walks and six strikeouts.

TOP OF THE ORG: Led the Astros' organization in 2022 in games started (23) and was second in strikeouts (142), trailing only Spencer Arrighetti (152). Also finished second in the Astros' organization in innings pitched (121.1).
