Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Trenton Denholm** to the mound tonight, looking to snap a 2G skid (last 3G losing streak was 4/8-4/10).

Buffalo will counter with RHP **Chad Dallas**. Columbus is 11-6 (.647) versus right handers this year. Dallas has pitched against Columbus once in his career, not figuring in the decision at Huntington Park on 4/20 (5.2IP, 7H, 3R, 3ER, 0BB, 5K).

vs. the Bisons

Since 5/23/09, the Clippers are 41-67 (.380) against the Bisons, despite being outscored by only 40 runs (485-525). Among those 108G, the Clippers are 19-22 (.463) in games decided by at least four runs and 22-45 (.328) in games decided by three or fewer. In Buffalo, the Clippers have been victorious in 11 of the last 17G, winning both series played since the expansion of the International League.

Bizarro Weekend

The Clippers won their first Friday game of the season last week (5-21 on Friday since starting last season 5-0) and followed up with their first Saturday loss the next night (29-10 on Saturday since starting the 2024 season 2-12). They ended last weekend with a win on Sunday, as they are now 9-24 on Sundays since Septemebr of 2024. On the road, Columbus has lost six straight and 12 of 13 on Friday.

Seventh Circle of Hell

Columbus gave up a pair of runs in the 7th last night and the 29 runs given up in the 7th over the course of the season is the most in the IL (+7 on 2nd, Rochester; run differential of -16 is worst in the IL). From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have tallied 46 runs (12 more than any other IL team; +30 run differential is best). Columbus has allowed a run in the 9th only twice all year, losing both games by a run.

High, But Not *That* High

Columbus batters racked up 10K last night, hitting double digits for the 13th time this year, to move into a tie for 5th most strikeouts in the IL (223). Along with 144BB (2nd) and 33HR (4th), the Clippers are the only team in the IL to rank among the top five in each of the three true outcome categories. However, their 40.9% rate ranks a distant 4th in the IL (Durham leads at 46.7% due to an astronomical 281K).

Walters Rehab

Andrew Walters (right lat surgery) has remained with the Clippers on rehab, as **Hunter Gaddis** and **George Valera** ended their assignments last Monday. Walters has pitched five times so far, giving up a homer in two outings (2-run shot on 4/7 at Worcester and a solo bomb on 4/10 at Worcester). All-time in Columbus, 63% (9) of his 16ER allowed have come on 6HR (one every 33.3BF).

Under the Radar

Petey Halpin extended his hit streak to 10G last night (.289, 13x45, since 4/12), while reaching base in his 12th straight (.328OBP since 4/10). Halpin has reduced his strikeout rate to 19% (11K in 58PA) over the course of his on base streak, compared to 30% (15K in 50PA) through his first 10G of the season. His run scored on Tuesday was the 100th of his Clipper career (2nd in the IL since debut, 3/28/25).

Discerning Eye

Travis Bazzana earned another walk last night (6BB in 15PA this series, 5BB in 41PA of 9G prior), boosting his walk rate to 17% (24% last year). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/12/25, Bazzana has walked more times than any other player in the IL (47; 4th best OBP, .413). Over his last 11G, he has reached base in all (.519OBP), while hitting .390 (16x41) with 9XBH (.707SLG).

Next Milestone

Milan Tolentino nabbed a base last night to give him 5SB and 6HR through the first four weeks of the season, as he is pacing for the first 30-30 campaign in Clipper history (recorded the franchise's first 20-20 season last year). He is one of a dozen Clippers to reach 25 of each in his career, doing so in just 145G (everyone else in the club played 226+). Tolentino is 0x10 this series (10x17 in 5G prior).

Bad Dream

Wednesday's multi-error game was the seventh of the year for the defense (all since 4/3; .966 fielding percentage in the last 18G, worst in the IL), as they now have 21E through 24G. Last year, the Clippers made multiple mistakes in only 14G total and it took until game #46 for them to reach 21E. Columbus pitchers (6E) and catchers (5E), have paired to form the worst defensive battery in the IL (.957).

This Date in Clipper History

4/24/1992

The Clippers beat the Red Barons of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre by a score of 7-2. **Gerald Williams** drove in 3 runners to lead Columbus. The 1992 club placed eight players on the postseason IL All-Star Team, including **Williams (OF)**, **JT Snow (1B)**, **Hensley Meulens (3B)**, **Dave Silvestri (SS)**, **Bernie Williams (OF)**, **Torey Lovullo (DH)**, **Sam Militello (SP)** and **Mike Draper (RP)**.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,417 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 31-32 (.492) in pitch reviews, with batters going 19-22 (.463) and pitchers/catchers going 12-10 (.545). They have run out of challenges in 13G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-35 when playing past regulation (.588, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 85G to require extra play, 68 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 16th in the IL this year (.974), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 13G this season (7-6, .538), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsports in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 398-418 (.488), 368-372 with Columbus (.497).
