**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are wrapping up their 25th anniversary season, opening up a six-game series at Akron.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Carter Bins came up with another clutch RBI, driving in Jackson Glenn in the 8th inning, to lead Altoona to a 3-2 win in the series opener at Akron.

**GET SHORTY:** Righty Aaron Shortridge became the first Curve pitcher since 2015 to earn 11 wins in a season with a rain-shortened win against Harrisburg on Saturday, September 9. The last Curve arms to win 11 times in a season were Jason Creasy (12) and Chad Kuhl (11) during the 2015 season. Overall on the season he ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 26 starts, 1st with 10 wins, 1st in complete games with two and 2nd with 135.1 IP.

**BUBBA'S BURGERS:** Right-hander Bubba Chandler electrified in his Double-A debut on Friday, September 9 against Harrisburg. Chandler retired 13 straight batters to begin his Curve career allowing just a bloop single in 5.0 innings. Chandler struck out 8 on 69 pitches, 51 strikes. In his last 9 starts between Greensboro and Altoona he's gone 7-1 with a 1.66 ERA (9 ER / 48.2 IP), with just 27 hits, 13 walks and 51 strikeouts. He and Anthony Solometo are 2 of the 13 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20-or-younger. The Pirates and Arizona Diamondbacks (Hansel Rincon and Yu-Min Lin) are the only teams to have 2 pitchers age 20-or-younger to reach Double-A.

**NOTHING SULLEN:** Righty Sean Sullivan has been one of Altoona's rocks in the rotation this season and he turned in another brilliant performance on Thursday, September 7 against Harrisburg with a season-high 9 strikeouts in 7.0 innings. Sullivan allowed just four singles and an error behind him led to a run in the sixth inning as he cruised through the evening on just 83 pitches. Sullivan has a 5-0 record with a 2.95 ERA (13 ER / 39.2 IP) in his last 7 appearances, 5 starts. In that time he's struck out 34 batters and walked just 11 while holding opponents to a .234 average against. Sullivan has his name all over the Eastern League leaderboards this season: 6th in ERA (3.98), 10th in IP (108.2), and 6th in WHIP (1.27).

**THE YOUNG LEFTY:** Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C Ryan Doumit, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP Sean Burnett, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003. Solometo has thrown the third-most innings by a pitcher age-20 or younger at the Double-A level this season (50.1) and has walked just 6.5% of batters he's faced. He is one of 13 pitchers to reach Double-A at age 20 or younger this season.

**STREAKING:** Altoona owns the two longest hitting streaks in the Eastern League this season with Tsung-Che Cheng's 17-game streak in late-July/early-August and Matt Fraizer's 17-game streak which came to an end on Thursday, September 7. Fraizer also reached base safely in 18 straight games in which he batted: .342/.377/.507 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 2 HR and 10 RBI. Fraizer's 109 hits rank 5th in the Eastern League and his 66 runs scored rank T-5th in the Eastern League.

**NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE:** Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man Joe Perez reached base safely in each of his 25 games played with Altoona, batting .341/.477/.624/1.101 with 3 2B, 7 HR, 18 RBI, and 24 K's. Twice in a Curve uniform he's homered in back-to-back games. His 1.101 OPS is 4th-best among Double-A players since his debut on August 12.

**STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE:** Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Wednesday, September 13, Altoona has struck out 1,074 times, the fewest among Double-A teams and 4th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's was the last Double-A team to reach 1000 strikeouts this season.

**THE RUBBER DUCKIES:** Rouglas Odor, the uncle of San Diego Padres infielder Rougned Odor, is back in the rubber city as Manager for a fourth season after previously coaching in Akron with the Aeros from 2011-2013 and later as the Hitting Coach in 2015-17. His squad features some top Guardians prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 6 INF Juan Brito, No. 19 RHP Tanner Burns, No. 20 OF Petey Halpin, No. 26 LHP Doug Nikhazy, No. 27 LHP Will Dion.

**THE FIRST QUAKER:** Tristan McKenzie makes a rehab start for the RubberDucks tonight. McKenzie went on the IL on June 17 with a right elbow strain. A competitive Balance A round pick by Cleveland in 2015, McKenzie pitched for the Akron RubberDucks in 2018. The native of Royal Palm Beach, FL was 7-4 with a 2.68 ERA and 87 strikeouts over 90.2 innings across 16 starts with Akron. In 66 career games with Cleveland, McKenzie is 18-22 with a 3.70 ERA and 383 strikeouts over 354.2 innings pitched. He struck out 13 batters and allowed just four runs over 11.0 innings in two postseason starts for the Guardians in 2022.

Tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his Double-A career, longest by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras threw 18.2 IP to start the 2021 season... Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retiring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed (4 earned) on 6/22 vs. Bowie... Made his first appearance post-All Star break in a one-inning relief outing on July 18 vs. Reading... Tossed his first career complete game as a professional in a 7-inning affair with Erie on 8/9 in the first of a doubleheader, first CG by a Curve pitcher since **Trey McGough** in 2021 (5.0 IP) and first 7-inning CG since **Domingo Robles** in 2019...
