Tonight: Welcome to the 27th season of Lansing Lugnuts baseball! The Nuts, entering their third season as the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play at the Great Lakes Loons, the High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lansing went 4-8 at Dow Diamond in 2022 en route to a 10-14 record overall against the Loons.

If the Luggies win tonight, it would... improve Lansing's record to 13-14 all-time on Opening Day... improve the Lugnuts' record to 4-1 against the Loons on Opening Day... be Craig Conklin's first MiLB managerial win.

LUG•NOTES

Meet the New Boss: **Craig Conklin**, the Nuts' Assistant Hitting Coach last season, becomes the 18th manager in Lugnuts team history. Hailing from Malibu, Calif., Conklin entered professional baseball as an area supervisor at the Major League Baseball Scouting Bureau. He then spent four years scouting Southern California for the Athletics before serving on the Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators' staff in 2019 and on the Single-A Stockton Ports' staff in 2021. This is his first season managing in Minor League Baseball.

Opening Notes: The Nuts have matched up with the Loons on four prior occasions in the season-opening series, going 3-1 on Opening Day. - In 2012, the Nuts raised the curtain with a three-game sweep in Lansing, the tone set by dominant scoreless performances in tandem by future Major Leaguers **Noah Syndergaard** (3 IP, 6 K) and **Anthony DeSclafani** (3 IP, 4 K) on Opening Day.

- In 2016, the Lugnuts were snowed out and rained out in the first two scheduled days at home against the Loons, turning around and heading to Midland for the next two days (a 5-4 loss in which the broadcaster computer was broken by a **Jordan Paroubeck** foul ball and another rainout). - In 2017, the first day was postponed, but teenagers **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** homered the next day as the Lugnuts swept a four-game home-and-home series.

- And in 2018, the Lugnuts dominated the Loons at Dow Diamond, 12-1, with **Yennsy Díaz** striking out 10 in 5 2/3 innings of one-hit ball. The offense scored six runs in the ninth inning to turn the game into a full-on rout.

Familiar Faces: In addition to Conklin and pitching coach **Don Schulze**, entering his third straight season in Lansing, the Lugnuts' roster includes 18 players with prior experience in Mid Michigan: 17 players who saw time in 2022, including relievers **Brock Whittlesey**, **Jack Owen** and **Jorge Juan** and outfielders **Lazaro Armenteros** and **Jonny Butler** who suited up for Lansing in both 2021 and 2022, and not including catcher **Cooper Uhl**, who played 13 games for the Luggies in 2021 and spent all of 2022 in Stockton.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: In their Lugnuts debut, on a snowy day at Great Lakes, Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., and Bo Bichette both hit oppo homers to help the Nuts beat the Loons, 6-3, in Game 1 of a season-opening doubleheader. In Game 2, Tayler Saucedo (2 2/3) and Geno Encina (4 1/3) combined on a four-hit shutout in a 2-0 victory.

2019: The Lugnuts rallied from deficits in the seventh, eighth and ninth innings to beat Fort Wayne, 5-4, on Johnny Aiello's bases-loaded hit-by-pitch in the bottom of the ninth at Cooley Law School Stadium. Trailing 1-0 in the seventh, the Lugnuts tied the game on a Hagen Danner solo homer. Trailing 3-1 to the eighth, Otto Lopez (whose throwing error had helped the TinCaps retake the lead) drilled a two-out game-tying two-run homer. And after Tucupita Marcano's RBI single gave Fort Wayne a 4-3 lead in the top of the ninth, Carlos Belen loaded the bases with none out, tossed a run-scoring wild pitch to tie the game, and drilled Aiello to give the Nuts the win. It was the second time in the game that Aiello had been hit by a pitch.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
