About the Last One: Orioles top pitching prospect **Grayson Rodriguez** made his home debut at Prince George's Stadium on Tuesday night but the Baysox fell in a nip and tuck affair 3-2. In 4.2 innings, Rodriguez allowed two earned runs and four hits while striking out six. Trailing 2-0 in the bottom of the fifth, **Doran Turchin** tied the game with a two-run homer to left-center. The home run was the fourth in the last three games for Turchin. Akron would quickly answer though scoring on an **Oscar Gonzalez** RBI-double to centerfield to put the Ducks up 3-2. On the night Bowie walked nine times, but the Baysox could not bring any of those runners around to score. The bullpen combined to allow one earned run in 4.1 innings. **Tyler Erwin** and **Steven Klimek** each worked scoreless appearances in the defeat. **Yusniel Diaz** returned to Bowie after a month on the injured list going 1-for-2 with a walk. **Greg Cullen** made his Double-A debut starting at second base as well for the Baysox. Despite the loss, Bowie still has the best record in the Double A Northeast League at 25-10. They remain 1.5 games ahead of Erie in the Southwest Division.

Home at Last: The Baysox return home to Prince George's Stadium after their longest road trip in team history at twelve games. Bowie went 8-4 against Hartford and Binghamton, and are now 6-0-0 in series this season. Bowie will now play 12 games at home in the next two weeks, before hitting the road at the end of June to take on Akron.

Peralta's Pitching: In the second game of the series, Bowie will send right-hander **Ofelky Peralta** to the bump for his fourth start and seventh appearance of the season. Peralta will be looking to rebound from his last outing, when he allowed four runs in just two-thirds of an inning against Binghamton. However, prior to that, Peralta had allowed just three earned runs combined in his previous five appearances. For more information on Peralta, see page two.

In the Other Corner: The RubberDucks will throw righty **Shane McCarthy** on Wednesday night as they look to take a 2-0 lead in the series. McCarthy, an 18th round pick in 2018 by the Cleveland Indians out of Seton Hall University, has started all six games he has appeared in this year for Akron, and has an 0-1 record with a 5.26 ERA. In his 25.2 innings, McCarthy has surrendered 17 runs (15 earned), and opponents are hitting .208 against him.

This Day in Baysox History: Bowie played their first home game at Prince George's Stadium on June 16, 1994. Major ice storms over the winter delayed the opening of the stadium, so for April, May, and the first part of June, the Baysox played their home games at Shipley Field at the University of Maryland, the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, and at Harry Grove Stadium in Frederick, Maryland. Bowie won their home opener at Prince George's Stadium, beating Binghamton 14-6.
