### INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indians offense exploded for five runs in the eighth inning to defeat the St. Paul Saints on Friday night at Victory Field, 7-2. St. Paul got the scoring started in the second inning on a solo shot by Tony Kemp, but the lead was short-lived. Indianapolis responded in the bottom half with an RBI single by Grant Koch to score Canaan Smith-Njibga from second base. In the fourth, the Saints turned to their three-hole hitter DaShawn Keirsey Jr. to retake the lead. Following a leadoff walk, he grooved a double into the left-center field alley to score Max Kepler. An RBI two-out double by Nick Gonzales scored Ji Hwan Bae from first base to knot the game again in the bottom of the fifth. Tied 2-2 in the bottom of the eighth, the Indians used free bases to their advantage. With the bases juiced following two walks and a single, Jake Lamb plated the game-winning run on a sacrifice fly. The inning featured another walk and two catcher interferences on Patrick Winkel to extend the outpouring, with RBI singles by Malcom Nuñez and Matt Gorski highlighting the offense.

FIRST FOUR: Since converting to the new six-game series format in 2021, the Indians have never won the first four games of any series, home or away, until this week. The closest they have gotten to going 4-0 to start a series was when they went 3-0 from 6/15-17/21 vs. Memphis. The Indians have won five-straight games after dropping the series-opener three times in that time span: 8/31-9/4/22 @ Louisville, 4/6 (1)-9/23 @ Louisville and 5/3 (2)-7 @ Toledo.

STYMYING THE SAINTS: The Indians are firing on all cylinders this week as the only team to go 4-0 to begin the series and one of two to hold their opponent winless (also: Worcester, 3-0 vs. Durham). Over the past four games, Indianapolis is hitting .313 (41-for-131) with 24 runs, 11 doubles, two triples, 24 RBI and a .803 slugging percentage. Indians pitching, however, has been the name of the game with a league-leading 44 strikeouts while holding St. Paul to a .197 batting average (25-for-127), second lowest in the 20-team IL. The pitching staff also ranks second in the IL in ERA (2.50, 10er/36.0ip).

NICKY G LEADS THE LEAGUE: Nick Gonzales went 2-for-5 with a run and RBI double last night to extend his league-leading on-base streak to a career-high 18 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 18-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona. His fifth-inning double not only extends his hitting streak to 11 games dating back to 4/6, but was his 11th in just 18 games this season to extend his lead over the International League. Gonzales has been on fire with three more doubles than anyone else. Nine of his 18 games have featured multi-hit performances, and he currently leads IL leaders in hits (29) and doubles while also ranking in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 13), batting average (2nd, .387), runs (2nd, 19) and total

NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES: The Indians' 47 doubles this season currently leads all 30 Triple-A teams. In addition to leading the International League, Nick Gonzales is currently leading the pack among all Triple-A teams with three more than anyone else. The Indians as a team are also hitting .282 (175-for-620), good for the second-best batting average in all of Triple-A behind Durham (.289, 187-for-646), and rank 5th among teams in hits (behind Durham, Norfolk, Reno and Oklahoma City).

NO PROBLEM FOR PERALTA: Wily Peralta made his first start of the 2024 season last night and shut down the Saints offense with 3.0 innings of one-hit ball, his only baserunner surrendered coming via a Tony Kemp solo homer in the second lining. He paved the way for a successful bullpen day for Indianapolis in which just three pitchers combined to hold St. Paul to two runs. Nick Dombkowski, who was promoted from Double-A Altoona this week made his first appearance with Indy and tossed 4.0 one-run frames - tying the longest outing by an Indians reliever this season. Brady Feigl then entered, earning the win with 2.0 perfect innings and four strikeouts.

NUÑEZ'S KNOCKS: Malcom Nuñez has been a consistent presence for the Indians offense as of late, hitting safely in each of his last five games with five extrabase hits and six RBI. He has driven in at least one RBI in his last four games and is one game shy of tying his team-leading five-game RBI streak (3/31-4/6 [1]). Last night, he joined Nick Gonzales in being one of two Indians with two hits. In April, he has reached base safely in 12 of 14 games with a .340 batting average (16-for-47), six doubles, two homers and 11 RBI.

LAMB CHOPS: Jake Lamb joins Nick Gonzales on the International League leaderboards this season, ranking among qualifiers in batting average (6th, .364) and on-base percentage (10th, .455) through 14 games this season. Last night, he singled and drove in the Indians game-winning run with a sacrifice fly to score Ji Hwan Bae. Lamb had his 11-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday after being reinstated from the temporary inactive list, but has since picked up. He has hit safely in 10 of his 14 games played and has more walks (9) than strikeouts (7) so far this season.

TONIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians will look to win their fifth straight game vs. the St. Paul Saints this week. It is their first of three head-to-head series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. Taking the mound for Indianapolis tonight is LHP Michael Plassmeyer (1-2, 8.62), who jumped out to an impressive start this season with back-to-back one-run outings with 14 strikeouts from 3/29-4/4. Countering for St. Paul will be more of the same from RHP Caleb Boushley, who surrendered one run in his season debut on 4/3 but has since given up multiple runs in his last two starts.

THIS DATE IN 1974: On a beautiful Saturday afternoon in Indianapolis, the Indians played their home opener at Bush Stadium and built a 10-0 lead en route to a 10-5 win over Omaha, improving the club's record to 4-0 on the young season. Indians starter Rawly Eastwick threw 7.1 innings of no-hit baseball before running out of gas and surrendering five runs on four hits in the eighth, and Joel Youngblood and Ed Armbrister each hit home runs for Indianapolis. Omaha's third baseman that day was future Hall of Famer George Brett. It was the first game ever broadcast in Indianapolis by the Voice of the Indians, Howard Kellman!

The Indians' 12 home runs this season are tied for last in the International League (also: Nashville) and the second-fewest in Triple-A (Salt Lake, 10).

**Michael Plassmeyer:** The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his fifth start of the season and second at Victory Field tonight vs. St. Paul.

**Last Outing:** Plassmeyer suffered the loss after giving up eight runs on eight hits in 1.2 innings last Sunday at Toledo.

Against the Saints: Plassmeyer has never faced St. Paul.

**Walk It Off:** Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion — three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ...
