MAY THE 4TH BE WITH YOU: After dropping back-to-back close games that were up for grabs in the 9th inning and a rainout yesterday, the FredNats aim to end the series in Salem on a positive note with RHP Davian Garcia getting the Sunday start. He faces Salem righty Steven Brooks. Garcia has faced Salem once before in a start on the first home stand of the season, allowing six hits and four runs in 2.2 innings in what was his first start of his professional career. In his last three starts, Garcia has covered 13 innings and allowed just five earned runs.

ABOUT LAST GAME: Nataneal Yuten walked off the FredNats for the third time in the last two seasons with a base hit in the 10th inning to push the Sox to a 3-2 victory. Jackson Ross drove in both FredNat runs, including a go-ahead home run in the 9th that gave the FredNats a 2-1 lead at the time. Freili Encarnacion tied the game with a line drive home run in the bottom of the 9th. Yoel Tejeda Jr. pitched five innings of one-run ball with a career-high seven strikeouts.

THIS SERIES IS WILD: The FredNats have lost three games in a row in which they had great chances to tie or take the lead in the 9th. In Wednesday's game, Fredericksburg had the tying runs in scoring position in the 9th inning when Moises Gallardo was called out on a pitch clock violation to end the game. On Thursday, the FredNats scored four runs in the 9th inning to cut a 5-0 deficit to 5-4, and then with the tying run at third base and one out, the Freddies weren't able to get the tying run in. Then in last night's game, Fredericksburg had a 2-1 lead in the 9th disappear after a solo homer and then a walk-off single in the 10th.

RISP STRUGGLES: After going 0-for-6 with runners in scoring position in last night's loss, Fredericksburg's recent offensive struggles with RISP continues. Overall, the Freddies are hitting .228 with a .666 OPS with runners in scoring position this year, which is middle of the pack in the Carolina League. In the last 10 games, however, the team is hitting just .169 with a .512 OPS with runners in scoring position, and just hasn't been able to get the big hit when its really needed to these last three nights in Salem.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 39.6% of base runners this year and ranks second in Single-A with 11 caught stealings, and Rombach is 12th in Single-A with eight caught stealings. He is throwing out 28% of potential base stealers. Fredericksburg's 19 total caught stealings from the catchers ranks second in Single-A behind Charleston.

THIS BULLPEN, MAN: The FredNat bullpen continues to be a dominant unit for Fredericksburg. After four more innings last night, the bullpen ERA stands at 3.19, which is not only the best in the Carolina League, it's the second best in all of Single-A baseball and the 9th best in all of Minor League baseball. The FredNats currently have five relievers that have an ERA under three heading into this game with the RiverDogs. The bullpen has logged 124 innings this year compared to the starting rotation's 95.1, and the group has 152 strikeouts and only 62 walks.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

WELCOME TO FXBG: Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer...this is his debut season.

LAST TIME OUT: Garcia dealt with walk issues, pitching for the second time against Charleston in last week's series (Games 1 and 6). He allowed three earned runs in 4.2 IP on Sunday, after tossing five scoreless innings for his first career win in Tuesday's game.

PRO MOMENT: Garcia's first career appearance came in relief during the FredNats' second game of the season at Carolina. The righty fired 1.2 scoreless innings in his pro debut, striking out two Mudcats. Since then, he's exclusively been used as a starter.

COLLEGE EDUCATED: Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
