TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP Christan Zazueta (0-0, 1.93 ERA)

- T The 21-year-old was signed as an international free agent by the New York Yankees on January 17, 2022.
- T Zazueta was traded to the Dodgers, along with Matt Gage, from the Yankees for Caleb Ferguson on February 5, 2024.
- T He is the #8 ranked prospect in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization according to MLB Pipeline.
- T In his professional career, Zazueta is 16-14 with a 3.94 ERA in 70 games (61 starts) while giving up 230 hits, 128 runs, 120 ERs, 34 HRs and 74 walks with 332 Ks in 274.1 IP.
- T In 2025, Zazueta pitched for Rancho Cucamonga and Great Lakes. He was a combined 7-2 with a 2.41 ERA while giving up 53 hits, 19 runs, 18 earned runs, 7 home runs and 16 walks with 81 strikeouts in 66.1 IP.
- T Zazueta was named the Branch Rickey Minor League Pitcher of the Year by the Dodgers following the 2025 season.
- T In his 11 games (10 starts) for Great Lakes in 2026, Zazueta was 2-2 with a 3.88 ERA while giving up 35 hits, 21 runs, 5 HRs and 12 walks with 66 Ks in 48.2 IP.
- T In his three starts in June for Great Lakes, Zazueta was 0-1 with a 3.88 ERA while giving up 3 hits, 2 runs and 3 walks with 16 strikeouts in 11.1 IP.
- T In his six home games with Great Lakes, he was 2-1 with a 1.91 ERA and in five road games he was 0-1 with a 6.64 ERA.
- T In his three starts for Tulsa, Zazueta is 0-0 with a 1.93 ERA while giving up 9 hits, 3 runs, 3 HRs and 1 walk with 24 Ks in 14.0 IP. He has struck out eight in all three starts.
- T In his 14 games (13 starts) combined between Great Lakes and Tulsa, Zazueta is 2-2 with a 3.45 ERA while giving up 44 hits, 24 runs, 8 HRs and 13 walks with 90 Ks in 62.2 IP.
- T In his last start on July 7 against Springfield, Zazueta pitched 5.0 innings and gave up 4 hits, 2 runs, 2 home runs and 1 walk with 8 Ks.
- T With Tulsa, Zazueta has not allowed a hit to a left-handed hitter and issued just 1 walk with 10 Ks in 17 ABs. Right-handed hitters are batting .290 against Zazueta in 30 ABs.
- T In his career, Zazueta is 6-7 with a 3.98 ERA in day games and is 10-7 with a 3.91 ERA in night games.

GAMEDAY NOTES

- T A win today would give Tulsa its 11th series win and the seventh at ONEOK Field. A loss would be just the third series split this season and the second at ONEOK Field.
- T Josue De Paula and Mike Sirota are scheduled to play in the MLB All-Star Futures game on Sunday, July 12 at Citizens Bank Park. In 2025, De Paula was named the MVP of the Futures Game after hitting a go-ahead three-run homer.
- T The Drillers are 12-6 in day games and 7-6 on Sundays this season. In day games, Tulsa is hitting .266 with the most runs scored (129) and home runs (33) in Double A and the pitching staff has a 4.90 ERA. On Sundays, Tulsa leads Double A batting .284 with 95 runs scored and 23 home runs and the pitching staff has a 4.85 ERA.
- T Zyhri Hope has hit six home runs over his last nine games. In July, Hope leads active players in the TL with a .450 average, 21 RBI and 6 home runs.
- T Tulsa is batting .259 and the pitching staff has a 5.12 ERA against Springfield this season. Kendall George leads the team, batting .375 and Evan Shaw and Antonio Knowles are the only active Tulsa pitchers who have not allowed a run against the Cardinals. This week against Springfield Tulsa is batting .282 and the pitching staff has a 6.00 ERA.
- T Over the past 23 games, Tulsa has a .261 team batting average and has struck out 236 times, the second most in the TL. Tulsa starting pitchers have a 7.25 ERA over the last 23 games, the highest in the Double A, and the relievers have a 2.74 ERA in that span, which is the lowest in Double A. Tulsa pitchers have also given up 30 home runs during that span with 22 coming in the last 12 games.
- T The Drillers have scored 428 of their 554 runs this season and hit 63 of their 115 home runs while batting .277 against relievers compared to batting .259 against starters.
- T Tulsa's 29 home wins are the most in the TL and the second most in Double A. The 28 road wins are tied for the most in Double A.
- T Drillers starting pitchers have turned in 13 quality starts this season, which is the most in the TL. Adam Serwinowski leads the Drillers with five.
- T Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 37-12 and lead the Double A in hitting at .282, hits, (471), runs scored (339), home runs (77), walks (263) and OPS (.868) Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 32 of the last 49 games.
- T Tulsa has scored the most runs this season in the sixth inning with 81, which are the most in the Double A in that inning. The Drillers also lead Double A with 96 hits, 17 home runs, 58 walks and a .900 OPS in the sixth.
- T Tulsa has 33 comeback victories this season with 18 coming at ONEOK Field. The Drillers have scored 100 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which is the second most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.
- T The Drillers are 31-9 when scoring first and have scored first in 24 of 42 road games and in 16 of 44 home games.
- T De Paula currently leads active players in the TL in average at .322, in hits with 106, doubles with 27, runs scored with 74 and OPS at .964.
- T Hope leads the TL in RBI with 80. He is also second in hits with 92 and has hit the fifth most home runs with 19.
- T Tulsa relievers have inherited 144 runners this season and have allowed 54 to score, which are the second most in the TL.
- T The Drillers have allowed a combined 196 runs (181 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 6.31 ERA, which is the second highest ERA in those innings in the TL. Tulsa's offense also leads the TL for the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 177.
- T Tulsa's pitching staff has issued 454 walks, the most in Double A. The Drillers offense also leads Double A in walks drawn with 446.
- T The Drillers have a .268 team batting average against left-handed pitching, which is the second highest in Double A. Tulsa is also batting .269 against right handers, which is the highest in the TL and the third highest in Double A.
- T Sixty-five of the Drillers 115 home runs have been hit with runners on base, which is the most homers with runners on base in Double A.
- T Since joining the Drillers on May 19, Sirota has reached base in all 42 games he has played and reached base 94 total times. He is also on a 72 game on-base streak combined between Great Lakes and Tulsa and has reached base 164 times total during that span. The streak is the longest in all of MLB and MiLB this season. The recent Minor League Baseball record is 74 straight games set by Andrew Velazquez in 2014 with Single-A South Bend.
- T De Paula has recorded a hit and scored a run in nine consecutive games.

TULSA FALLS ON SATURDAY- The Tulsa Drillers lost to the Springfield Cardinals 10-4 on Saturday night as rain declared the game official in the bottom of the sixth inning at ONEOK Field. Seven of the Cardinals ten runs scored in the first inning on an RBI single, Jesus Baez's two-run homer, and Brody Moore's grand slam. Travis Honeyman drove in three more runs for the Cardinals in the third with his three-run homer. Tulsa produced its first two runs in the first inning as Taylor Young drove in two with his double. Kole Myers singled home the final two runs in the fifth inning.
