Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play a doubleheader at the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres, the Nuts' ninth doubleheader of the year and their second against Fort Wayne. The Lugnuts are 3-12 against the TinCaps this year, dropping the first three games of this current series before yesterday's postponement. Tomorrow marks the final meeting of the 18-game season series between the two teams.

Starting Matchups: The Lugnuts turn to southpaw **Jack Owen**, the reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week and an undrafted free agent from Auburn, and right-hander **Blake Beers**, a 2021 19th-round selection from Michigan who tossed six scoreless innings against Fort Wayne earlier this year. The TinCaps counter with West Virginia teammates **Ryan Bergert** and **Jackson Wolf**.

LUG•NOTES

Congratulations: Tonight's starter, **Jack Owen**, was nearly perfect last Friday, setting down the first 14 Loons and settling for six innings with one base runner (a Jose Ramos fifth-inning single), striking out seven. For his effort, Owen was honored as the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week. He is the second Lugnuts pitcher honored by Minor League Baseball this year, joining **Jeff Criswell** (May 1).

The Future is Now: Outfielder **Denzel Clarke**, the A's No. 14 prospect, is among the top prospects selected for the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium tonight. The 22-year-old Clarke, MLB Pipeline's No. 14 Athletics prospect and No. 3 Athletics outfield prospect, is the fourth current Lugnut to participate in the Futures Game, joining Ángel Perdomo (2016) and Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017). A native of Pickering, ON, Clarke was drafted by the Athletics in the fourth round in 2021 from Cal State Northridge. He joined the Lugnuts on June 14 from Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .295/.420/.545 with 14 doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 14 stolen bases. He has two doubles and three home runs through 14 games with the Nuts.

Let's Play Two: The Lugnuts are 5-11 in their 16 doubleheader games this year, sweeping one and getting swept in four (including once by the TinCaps).

Clean Baseball: The Nuts have committed only four errors in their last 14 games, with 11 fully errorless games. (Interestingly, the opposition has only committed five errors in that span, with 10 errorless games.)

Hot in July: Infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** is hitting .368 (14-for-38) with two doubles in 10 games this month, striking out just once in that span. **Jack Winkler** (.333/.440/.452, .892 OPS, five doubles and 10 RBIs in 12 games); **Joshwan Wright** (.333/.381/.513, .894 OPS, two doubles, one triple, one HR) and **Tyler Soderstrom** (.294/.375/.618, .993 OPS, three doubles, one triple, two homers) have also been productive in July.

Among the MWL Leaders: **Tyler Soderstrom** is 2nd in the Midwest League with 58 RBIs, 5th with 141 total bases, 4th with 35 extra-base hits and 5th with 15 home runs. Others among the best in the circuit include **Kumar Nambiar**, who is 1st with 30 relief appearances, while **Trayson Kubo** is tied for 4th with seven saves.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: The Lugsnuts' finest road trip of the year was a seven-victory, nine-game, 10-day trek from Lake County, Ohio, to Kane County, Illinois, to Clinton, Iowa. You couldn't have blamed the Lugs if they had lost their opener at the Clinton LumberKings' Alliant Energy Field, but Carlos Perez wouldn't let it happen. The 20-year-old catcher went 4-for-6 with four RBIs, lining a game-tying single in the ninth and a go-ahead single in the eleventh inning to lift the Lugsnuts to an emotional 8-5 victory. The game featured dramatic defense, close calls, heated arguments and the ejections of the Lugs' Jake Marisnick in the ninth and Clinton manager Eddie Menchaca in the tenth inning.

Glory Days: Attended JSerra Catholic High School in San Juan Capistrano, California... named 2015 Perfect Game 16U Pitcher of the Year and 2015 Perfect Game Underclass National Championship Most Valuable Player... 2016 Second Team Louisville Slugger High School All-American... 2017 West Coast League Pitcher of the Year... 2017 Summer Collegiate Second Team All-American... coming out of high school, was ranked the No. 2 left-handed pitcher in California... others from JSerra include the 1st overall pick of the 2017 draft, Royce Lewis and Cleveland catcher Austin Hedges

War Eagle: Used as a freshman at Auburn to pitch in midweek games, rising to receive the honor of starting SEC Tournament opener vs. Kentucky... fellow members of that 2018 Tigers rotation: Casey Mize and Tanner Burns... excelled as a sophomore, leading the Tigers with a 2.75 ERA and bringing them to the College World Series, starting the opening game against Mississippi State (5 innings, 1 run)... entered senior year as one of eight SEC pitchers with a sub-4.00 ERA in 100+ innings, but did not pitch in non-conference action due to injury (dislocated thumb) and finished with a 5.47 ERA in 11 games, 9 starts... led Auburn as a senior in strikeouts (46) and innings (51)... in all, appeared in 43 games for Tigers (30 starts): 11-10, 4.26 ERA, 175 1/3 innings, 165 strikeouts... named to Spring SEC Academic Honor Roll, 2019-2021.

Home Cooking: Hometown of Aliso Viejo is located in southern Orange County in southern California... "Aliso Viejo" means Old Sycamore (or Old Alder) in Spanish (there is a sycamore located near Aliso Creek that is over 400 years old)... city motto: "Live Life Inspired"... only officially became a city on March 6, 2001.

Sophomore Year in the Pros: Opened 2022 season in Stockton bullpen, making only one spot start (April 30 vs. Fresno: Loss, 2 1/3 IP, 4 H, 4 UER, 1 BB, 3 K), but has been used entirely out of the Lugnuts rotation upon joining the team... in California League, limited lefties to .188/.235/.313 with 1 HR, 1 BB, 13 K, while righties slashed .261/.308/.450 with 4 HR, 8 BB, 35 K... with the Lugnuts, lefties are hitting .267 in limited action (4-for-15) compared to right-handers .235 (8-for-34).

Honored: Named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week after tossing six nearly perfect innings vs. the Great Lakes Loons, July 8th... set down first 14 batters, striking out seven, before Jose Ramos singled up the middle with two outs in the 5th... retired next four batters in order... 69 pitches, 49 strikes; 5 groundouts, 5 flyouts... Kumar Nambiar pitched the 7th and 8th innings, allowing one hit, and Trayson Kubo struck out the side in a perfect 9th to preserve a 1-0 win in two hours and three minutes... game's only run supplied by a Tyler Soderstrom RBI double in the 3rd inning.

Draft Day: Signed for \$40,000 as the 578th pick in the 2021 draft... signing scout: Rich Sparks, the 2006 Dick Bogard Scout of the Year, who scouts Indiana/Kentucky/Michigan/Ohio and also signed A's catcher Sean Murphy, former Lugnuts Marty Bechina, Max Schuemann and Jack Weisenburger, current Lugnut Jeff Criswell, and likely future Lugnut Mariano Ricciardi... third Michigan Wolverine drafted in 2021, following southpaw Steven Hajjar (2nd round, Minnesota) and shortstop Benjamin Sems (15th round, Colorado).

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, currently slugging for Arizona, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name.

Scouting Report: Noted for fastball touching 97 mph, though slider is considered best pitch... posted 17% SwStr % at Stockton.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.
