Today's Games: The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp will play a doubleheader, first the regularly scheduled 11:05 a.m. game before the makeup of the rainout on April 22. The Sounds scored six runs in the eighth to run away for an 11-4 win last night. Right-hander Caleb Boushley faces right-hander Jeff Lindgren in game one, followed by a matchup between Robert Gasser and Ronald Bolaños.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his league leading 13th start of the season in game one. The right-hander is 3-2 with a 5.19 ERA (50.1 IP/29 ER) this season. He earned the win in his last start on June 1 at Charlotte, allowing five runs (all earned) on eight hits in 6.2 innings. The UW-La Crosse product finished tied for the league lead in wins last year, posting a 12-2 record with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The right-hander was originally drafted in the 33rd round by San Diego in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

Jeff Lindgren: 26-year-old Jeff Lindgren starts for the Jumbo Shrimp in game one. The right-hander is 4-2 with a 5.44 ERA (43.0 IP/26 ER) with Jacksonville. He had a no decision in his last start on June 1 at Durham, allowing four runs (all earned) on seven hits in 6.0 innings in a 6-5 loss. He made his Major League debut on April 3 vs. Minnesota, appearing in relief for the Marlins (5.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 0 K). The Marlins drafted Lindgren in the 24th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Illinois State University.

Robert Gasser: 24-year-old Robert Gasser gets the ball for Nashville in game two. The No. 7 prospect in the Brewers system (MLB Pipeline) is 3-1 with a 4.59 ERA (49.0 IP/25 ER). He leads the league with 60 strikeouts and ranks among league leaders in BAA (3rd, .231) and WHIP (7th, 1.41). Gasser tossed a gem on May 31 at Charlotte with seven scoreless innings, nine strikeouts and no walks in a 4-0 win. The left-hander was acquired by Milwaukee in the trade that sent Josh Hader to the Padres on August 1, 2022.

Ronald Bolaños: 26-year-old Ronald Bolaños starts for Jacksonville in game two. The right-hander is 1-6 with a 9.37 ERA (32.2 IP/34 ER) through eight outings. He took his fourth consecutive loss on May 29 at Durham (3.2 IP, 10 H, 9 R, 9 ER, 3 BB, 4 K). The Cuba native was signed as a free agent by Miami on March 24. He has combined to go 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA in 18 appearances (5 starts) in the Majors with San Diego (2019) and Kansas City (2020-22).

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 15, Fifth: 21, Sixth: 9, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

Rehabbing Brewers: Left-hander Eric Lauer and right-hander J.B. Bukauskas both got work in their first game on rehab assignment with the Sounds. Lauer went 2.2 innings and gave up four runs (2 ER), while Bukauskas worked a scoreless sixth inning. Lauer and Bukauskas are the sixth and seventh Brewers to play for Nashville on rehab this season, respectively (Adrian Houser, Tyrone Taylor, Gus Varland, Luke Voit and Luis Urias).

Michael Reed Hitting Company: Outfielder Michael Reed hit his first home run as a Sound and finished with four RBI in another multi-hit effort. It was his first four RBI night since July 14, 2019 at Frisco while with Amarillo in the Padres organization. Since May 31, Reed is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with two doubles, a homer, five RBI, four walks, and four runs.

Devanney is Always On Base: Shortstop Cam Devanney extended his on-base streak to 11 games with two doubles last night. Since the streak began on May 17, Devanney is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with seven doubles, five RBI, seven runs and an .864 OPS.

Hammering Henry: Payton Henry added his second four-hit performance of the season last night, previously going 4-for-4 on May 26 vs. Iowa. The catcher is batting .333 (31-for-93) and has eight multi-hit days in 24 games this season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 629-546 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley picked up the win in his last start on June 1 at Charlotte. The right-hander went a season-long 6.2 innings, allowing eight hits on five runs (all earned). He gave up a homer in the sixth then walked a couple in the seventh before his exited.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is 1-0 with a 2.76 ERA (16.1 IP/5 ER) and 14 strikeouts in three career starts against Jacksonville. He worked six scoreless innings in a start on September 17, 2022 at First Horizon Park. He took a no decision in Nashville's 3-1 win over Jacksonville on April 20.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Made first Opening Day start for Nashville, pitching in Game 1 of the season-opening doubleheader against Louisville
- Allowed just one earned run over first two starts (1.42 ERA), both coming in doubleheaders

LAST OUTING: Gasser earned the win in a stellar outing on May 31 at Charlotte. The left-hander tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts in Nashville's 4-0 win. He did not allow a walk on 97 pitches and 69 strikes. He tied a career-high in innings pitched and strikes for his third win of 2023.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gasser's third start against Jacksonville and second this season. All-time the left-hander is 0-1 with a 3.12 ERA (8.2 IP/3 ER) against the Jumbo Shrimp. His first outing came on September 16, 2022 (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 4 K). He last pitched against Jacksonville on April 19 (3.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 4 K).

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12
- Is averaging 6.667 strikeouts a start and has the most strikeouts by a Sounds starter this season (9, June 1 at Charlotte)
- Allowed a career-high three home runs on April 30 vs. Omaha - one each in the third, fourth and fifth innings
- After posting 2.77 ERA (13.0 IP/4 ER) over first three starts, had 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP/14 ER) in next four games
- Spun a 6.2-inning gem in a convincing win on May 19 at Durham...was the longest outing this season by a Sounds pitcher at the time
- Tossed 7.0 scoreless inning gem on June 1 at Charlotte with no walks and nine strikeouts
