YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 8-3. Thayron Liranzo opened a 2-0 lead in the first with a two-run homer. **Carter Howell** cut the gap in half with an RBI single in the top of the third, but Erie plated five runs in the bottom of the inning to open a 7-1 lead. In the fourth, **Jairo Pomares** drove an RBI double and later scored on a sacrifice fly by **Adrian Sugastey**, closing the score to 7-3. The SeaWolves brought in a run with a groundout in the eighth to extend the lead back to five runs. **Nick Sinacola** threw three scoreless relief innings for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Richmond dropped four-of-six at The Diamond against the SeaWolves from May 13-18. The two teams meet again for a six-game series at UPMC Park from August 5-10.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,935 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 3-12 in their last 15 games. They dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the Senators. The previous week, they went 1-5 at Binghamton and lost three times on walk-off hits. Of Richmond's 37 losses this season, 19 of them have been by two runs or less (12 by one, seven by two). The Richmond offense has the third-fewest strikeouts (411) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (161). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.71 ERA.

THE SEAWOLVES are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron. They are 5-1 in their last six games. For the year, the Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.261), runs (282), hits (441), total bases (718), doubles (104), OBP (.342), SLG (.425) and OPS (.767). Erie's roster features eight of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including C/1B Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 7), RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 17), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), INF Max Anderson (No. 21), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 25) and RHP RJ Petit (No. 28). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list features four Erie players, including Liranzo (No. 5), Hamm (No. 11), Melton (No. 24) and Bigbie (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 11th start of the season and the sixth of his career against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Thursday against the Senators and worked seven innings for the second time this year, allowing five runs (four earned) in a loss. Two of those runs scored in the seventh. He has one other start against Erie this year. On May 16, he threw seven innings and allowed one run on three hits in a win. In his last five starts since May 4, he is 1-1 with a 2.20 ERA (7 ER/28.2 IP). Bertrand started on Opening Day for the Flying Squirrels on April 4 against Akron, becoming the first pitcher to start back-to-back season openers for the Flying Squirrels. Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers defensively in assists (31) and ranked second in total chances (38). He finished the season ranked first among all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Joseph Montalvo makes his 10th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday at Reading and allowed two runs in five innings for his second straight win. He was charged with a loss on May 16 at The Diamond, allowing three runs over 4.1 innings. Montalvo is in his first Double-A season. He was selected in the 20th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Texas Rangers out of high school. Last July, he was traded along with RHP Chase Lee to the Tigers for LHP Andrew Chafin. Montalvo split the 2024 season between High-A Hickory and High-A West Michigan, going 5-3 with a 3.00 ERA in 18 starts.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 28 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for second among Double-A catchers with 17 runners caught stealing, which is tied for first in the EL. Morgan is tied for third in the Eastern League with 11, which is tied for 11th in Double-A.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on Tuesday. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 25 times, which is tied with **Frankie Tostado** for the eighth-most in franchise history, two behind a four-way tie for fourth place.

DID I HEAR YOU SAY YOU'RE GOING FAR AWAY AGAIN?: **Bryce Eldridge** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He began his season with Richmond on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For 2024 in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 20 prospect in baseball. Eldridge was the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. For his time with Richmond from late-April through last weekend, Eldridge was ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League in extra-base hits (15), tied for sixth in total bases (64), tied for third in homers (7) and 10th in OPS (.862).

HARRIS TO SAC: Reliever **Trent Harris** was promoted to Triple-A Sacramento on Tuesday. He made 13 appearances for the Flying Squirrels this year and in 12 of them he did not allow a run. The only three runs he surrendered this season came on a three-run, walk-off homer on May 20 at Binghamton. Harris struck out 25 batters and walked four over 16 innings of work with the Flying Squirrels. His 14.06 K/9 ranked 10th in the Eastern League (min. 10 IP) and his 391 strikeout percentage was fifth-best in the league. Harris played at High Point University before transferring to NCAA DI UNC Pembroke. After signing with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2023, he entered this year rated by MLB.com as the No. 11 prospect in the system.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. On Thursday night, he hit his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot to right. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in 10-of-14 Double-A games he has played, including five doubles, and is batting .341. He has played one game at shortstop and 12 games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Bryce Eldridge** is ranked seventh in SLG (.512) and ninth in OPS (.862). Diego Velasquez is tied for ninth in hits (47). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (53). **Seth Lonsway** is fifth in innings pitched (50.1). **John Michael Bertrand** is sixth in innings pitched (50.0). **Joe Whitman** is seventh in BAA (.200) and seventh in WHIP (1.08).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 219 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 21 overall by Baseball America and No. 21 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The first-place Richmond Virginians beat the Toronto Maple Leafs, 3-2, at Parker Field. Jerry Lumpe went 2-for-3, improving to 9-for-11 in his last three games, and picked up a sacrifice fly in the fifth inning. Toronto loaded the bases in the ninth inning but Johnny James worked a flyout from Mike Goliat to end the game. After an interference call in the second, Toronto manager Dixie Walker announced he was protesting the game. The umpires reversed their call, leading Richmond manager Eddie Lopat to declare he was protesting the game. The protest was nullified by the Vees' win. **1972:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 1-0, at Parker Field. With one out in the bottom of the ninth, Luis Alcaraz belted a walk-off, solo homer. It was his fifth homer of the season, three of them being game winners. **1977:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-1, at Parker Field. Toledo pitcher Cardell Camper threw a two-hitter, but one of the hits was a two-run homer by Dale Murphy in the fourth inning. Camper issued three straight walks in the seventh and Jerry Maddox brought in a third run with a sacrifice fly. **2017:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Trenton Thunder, 5-4, in 12 innings at The Diamond. The winning run scored in the bottom of the 12th inning on a bunt by Rando Moreno that scored Brandon Bednar from third. Trenton led, 3-2, before Richmond tied the score with a solo homer by Carlos Garcia in the eighth and Miguel Gomez hit a go-ahead double later in the inning for a 4-3 lead. In the top of the ninth with two outs, Trenton's Mike Ford tied the game with a solo homer.
