Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Charlotte Knights in game four of the series. Blake Perkins went yard twice in Nashville's 10-7 triumph yesterday. Left-hander Thomas Pannone gets the start for Nashville, facing Charlotte's Luke Farrell.

Thomas Pannone: 29-year-old Thomas Pannone makes his sixth start for Nashville tonight. The left-hander is 1-0 with a 3.45 ERA (28.2 IP/11 ER) in seven appearances on the year. Pannone had another no-decision on May 26 vs. Iowa, allowing four runs (all earned) on eight hits and three walks in 5.0 innings. The Rhode Island native has gone at least five innings in each of his last three starts, with two of those being quality starts (May 14 vs. Gwinnett and May 20 at Durham). Pannone pitched for Worcester in 2022, going 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 outings (12 starts) for the Red Sox Triple-A affiliate. He made 49 appearances with Toronto in 2018 and 2019 (7-7, 5.43 ERA). Pannone was drafted in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by Cleveland out of the Community College of Southern Nevada.

Luke Farrell: 31-year-old Luke Farrell starts for Charlotte tonight. The right-hander is 0-3 with a 9.20 ERA (14.2 IP/15 ER) through six starts for the Knights. Farrell pitched three innings in his last start on May 28 at Jacksonville, allowing two runs (both earned) on three hits with four strikeouts. He threw a total of 62 pitches, 37 for strikes, both season highs. Farrell was signed as a minor league free agent by the White Sox on April 17. He pitched for the Cubs and Reds in the big leagues last year, combining to go 0-0 with a 5.40 ERA (15.0 IP/9 ER) in six outings (2 starts). Farrell also went 3-4 with a 5.03 ERA (59.0 IP/33 ER) in 17 games (11 starts) for Triple-A Iowa in 2022. The son of former Blue Jays (2011-12) and Red Sox (2013-17) manager John Farrell, Luke was drafted in the sixth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft by the Royals.

Rake Perkins: Outfielder Blake Perkins drilled a couple blasts, including a leadoff homer in yesterday's 10-7 triumph. Perkins became the first Sound to hit a leadoff homer (last was Pablo Reyes on July 6, 2022 at Columbus) and to hit multiple home runs (last was Patrick Dorrian on September 28, 2022 vs. Memphis) in a game this season. He holds the longest active hitting streak on the team at seven games. Perkins is batting .440 (11-for-25) with three doubles, three homers, seven RBI, seven walks and nine runs during the streak.

Singleton Streaks: Sounds first baseman Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 16 games with a three-hit performance yesterday. The power hitting lefty has a .323 average (20-for-62) with a .425 on-base percentage, .726 slugging percentage and a 1.151 OPS during the streak. Since the on-base streak began on May 13, Singleton ranks among league leaders in extra-base hits (T-6th, 12), slugging (7th), OPS (9th) and total bases (9th, 45).

Vamos Vieira: Sounds reliever Thyago Vieira added his second save with another 1.2 scoreless innings last night with four strikeouts. He has yet to allow a run with Nashville with a total of 13.1 scoreless innings in 10 appearances. Among pitchers with at least 13 innings thrown, Vieira ranks third in the league in WHIP at 0.75, trailing only Scranton/WB's Nick Ramirez (0.62) and Norfolk's Yacksel Rios (0.68).

Urias On the Mend: Luis Urias continued his rehab stint as a designated hitter last night. He has hit safely in four straight games, batting .194 (6-for-31) with a double and RBI. Urias has been on the 60-day injured list with a strained left hamstring since March 31.

Ajax on Track: Alex Jackson has hit safely in six-straight games dating back to May 19. During the streak, Jackson is batting .435 (10-for-23) with a double, triple, two homers, six RBI and nine runs.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Bryce Turang and OF Joey Wiener. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 627-544 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Pannone last appeared on May 26 vs. Iowa. He allowed four earned runs on a season-high eight hits over 5.0 innings. Pannone also walked three and struck out five. The southpaw threw a season-high 93 pitches and did not factor into the decision in Nashville's 7-4 win.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Pannone has two previous appearances vs. Charlotte, his last coming on June 22, 2022 with Worcester. In that contest, he tossed 5.2 scoreless innings, punching out seven as he earned the win. It was his last game in affiliated baseball before his release from Boston. Pannone is 2-0 with a 0.79 ERA (11.1 IP/2 ER), 0.79 WHIP and 10 strikeouts over his two starts.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began season on development list...activated on April 22.
- Made first appearance of season on April 23, coming out of the bullpen.
- Made first start on May 3, allowing two runs (both earned) in 3.0 innings.
- Tossed quality start (6.0 IP, 1 ER) in win over Gwinnett on May 14...was his first win of the season...was the first quality start by a Sounds pitcher in 2023... followed it up with another (6.0 IP, 3 ER) in loss at Durham on May 20.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-3 with a 4.57 ERA in 14 games (12 starts) with Triple-A Worcester...walked just 3.1% of hitters faced, the 2nd lowest in International League (min. 60 IP).
- After being released by Boston on June 27, made 14 starts for the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization...went 3-4 with a 2.72 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 82.2 innings.

2021 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 5-11 with a 7.07 ERA in 24 games (21 starts) with Triple-A Salt Lake (Los Angeles-AL)...posted highest ERA in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 IP).
- Led the Triple-A West in innings pitched...was one of just seven qualifying pitchers in the league.

CAREER NOTES:

- Made Toronto's Opening Day roster in 2019.
- Threw an "immaculate" inning on April 14, 2019 vs. Tampa Bay, striking out Avisail Garcia, Brandon Lowe and Daniel Robertson in order on nine pitches in the fifth...was the third such inning in Blue Jays history...went on to retire all nine batters faced (4 K) in that outing.
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for June 30, 2019 after going 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and 14 strikeouts.
- Carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning of his first Major League start on August 22, 2018 vs. Baltimore...only hit was Trey Mancini's single to start seventh.
- In 2017, went 9-3 with a 2.36 ERA in 25 starts with Double-A Akron, Double-A New Hampshire and Advanced-A Lynchburg.
- Named an Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017...led the Eastern League in BAA (.227) and WHIP (1.09)...ranked among Eastern League leaders in ERA (2nd, 2.92), winning percentage (3rd, .700) and strikeouts (10th, 110).
- Did not allow an earned run (1 R) through first six starts of 2017 between Lynchburg (5 GS) and Akron (1 GS)...streak of 33.1 innings without an earned run was the second longest in the full season minor leagues by a starting pitcher.
- Traded to Toronto on July 31 alongside 2B Samad Taylor in exchange for RHP Joe Smith
- Named a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star in 2016.
- Drafted by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2013 First-Year Player Draft.

COLLEGE/PREP NOTES:

- Graduated from Bishop Hendricken High School (RI).
- Initially drafted by Chicago-NL in the 33rd round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, but did not sign.
- Attended Community College of Southern Nevada, where two-time NL MVP Bryce Harper and former Brewer Phil Bickford also played baseball.
