SHRIMP SWEPT IN 11-2 LOSS TO BULLS

Brian Navarreto homered on Sunday but the Jumbo Shrimp were swept with an 11-2 loss to the Bulls. Navarreto's homer broke a scoreless tie in the second, but Durham scored 11 unanswered runs, three of them coming on home runs from Bob Seymour (twice) and Tristan Peters. Jacksonville's bullpen struggled again, giving up eight runs, all earned, on nine hits in just 3.2 innings. They walked five and struck out four. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered just three hits in the defeat. They gave up a season-high 14 knocks, while matching a season-worst with 11 runs against.

A WEEK TO FORGET

Jacksonville relievers came into their series at Durham leading Triple-A in ERA by more than a full run at 2.40. The club's starting pitchers had combined for a 2.86 ERA, good enough for second at the level. Jumbo Shrimp pitching really struggled during the Bulls' six-game sweep, yielding a total of 48 runs (8.0 per game) compared to 86 (3.2 per game) in the first 27 contests of the season. The Jacksonville bullpen combined to surrender 30 runs, all earned, on 37 hits in 26.0 innings for an 10.38 ERA (12 BB, 31 K). Meanwhile, Jumbo Shrimp starters went a combined 22.0 innings in the six games, yielding 18 runs, 17 earned, on 20 hits for a 6.95 ERA (13 BB, 20 K).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Of the Jumbo Shrimp's last 24 games, a whopping 19 have been decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 13-6 (.684) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 15-7 (.682) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 10-3 (.769) mark in one-run games. Those 10 one-run victories are the most of any team in the minors.

JACK OF ALL TRADES

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jack Winkler played in just four of the club's first 11 games, going just 2-for-14 with seven strikeouts at the plate. The Littleton, Colo., native has appeared in 17 games since then, racking up seven multi-hit games. Over his last 17 contests, Winkler is 24-for-61 at the plate, slashing .393/.422/.557/.979 with four doubles, two home runs, six RBIs, three walks, 10 runs scored and eight

MEET THE METS

For the first time since the Jacksonville Suns were a New York Mets affiliate from 1966-68, Northeast Florida will welcome in a Mets minor league team on Tuesday when the Jumbo Shrimp host the Syracuse Mets at VyStar Ballpark. These six games, however, are not the first meeting between the clubs; Jacksonville split a series with the Mets in Syracuse from July 12-17, 2022. The 1966-68 Suns featured legendary Mets Tom Seaver, Nolan Ryan, Jerry Koosman and Tug McGraw, with the '68 team winning the International League title.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 20 of their last 32 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte: Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank fourth in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 81 stolen bases.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 16-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a nearly 2:1 margin at 83-46 at VyStar Ballpark and tying for the minor league lead for home wins. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-10 on the road, getting outscored by an 87-59 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .767 (16th in Triple-A) and at home compared to .657 on the road (25th). Their team ERA is 2.05 at home (1st) and 5.64 on the road (25th).

SIX FEET UNDER

Jacksonville came into this set with Durham riding high. leading the minor leagues with 21 wins and coming off their second sweep of the season. Seven days later, the Jumbo Shrimp are on a six-game losing streak - their longest since an eight-game skid from May 9-17 of last season. Jacksonville was swent for the first time since Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre broomed them in a six-game set from April 30-May 5, 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp have been outscored 48-17 during this current six-game losing streak.

ABOUT CONNOR

- -Gillispie was originally selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the ninth round of the $2019 \, \mathrm{draft}$ out of VCU.
- -After pitching in the Orioles' organization and reaching Double-A Bowie in 2023, Gillispie was selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the minor league phase of the 2023 Rule 5 draft.
- -Gillispie made his major league debut for the Guardians on August 4, 2024 in a game against the Orioles in Cleveland. He pitched 3.0 innings, yielding one run on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts in Baltimore's 9-5 victory.
- -Following the 2024 season, Cleveland designated Gillispie for assignment and then non-tendered him, making him a free agent. He signed a one-year major league contract with the Atlanta Braves on November 29, 2024. Gillispie was later designated for assignment by the Braves and claimed off waivers by the Miami Marlins on January 29, 2025.
- -In college at VCU, Gillispie majored in Business Real Estate.

2025 SEASON

-Gillispie made Miami's Opening Day starting rotation but struggled in the big leagues. He was optioned on April 27 to Jacksonville.

With runners on in the major leagues, opponents slashed .358/.379/.623/1.002 in 58 plate appearances against Gillispie.

2024 SEASON

-Gillispie excelled as a reliever; in 15 appearances out of the bullpen, he went 3-3 with a 2.63 ERA (51.1 IP, 32 H, 21 BB, 44 K, .180 BAA). In 15 starts, all coming with Triple-A Columbus, he posted a 2-4 record and 4.89 ERA (70.0 IP, 64 H, 32 BB, 83 K, .242 BAA).

-Gillispie held right-handed hitters to a .196/.287/.396/.683 batting line in 278 plate appearances. Left-handed batters hit .242/.330/.470/.800 against him 224 plate appearances.

2023 SEASON

-In 239 plate appearances, righties slashed .222/.296/.361/.657 against him compared to a .225/.295/.404/.699 line for opposing left-handed hitters in 235 plate appearances.

-Gillispie was 4-3 with a 3.48 ERA in 14 starts (67.1 IP, 55 H, 18 BB, 53 K, .219 BAA). Over 13 relief appearances, he posted a 3.1 record and 4.47 ERA (48.1 IP, 41 H, 19 BB, 46 K, .230 BAA).
