Today marks game #90 of the 2022 season, the third game of a three-game roadtrip, and the last game of a three-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2021 regular season, with the Whitecaps going 10-14. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 28th season in professional baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 15th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return home for a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons beginning on Tuesday, July 26 from LMCU Ballpark before hitting the road for a six-game set in the State Capital against the Lansing Lugnuts from Aug 2-7 at Jackson Field.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: Brant Hurter tossed five scoreless innings, and the West Michigan Whitecaps bullpen made it stand as part of a 3-2 victory over the Great Lakes Loons on Saturday in front of 4,636 fans at Dow Diamond. Hurter, a Detroit Tigers Top-30 Prospect, dominated with five frames without allowing a run while giving up just one hit and one walk and tying his Whitecaps season-high with seven strikeouts. Pitchers RJ Petit, Jared Tobey, Dario Gardea, and Andrew Magno tossed the final four frames to get the "Caps a closely contested victory. The game began as a pitcher's duel, as both starters in lefty Brant Hurter and righty Nick Nastrini for West Michigan and Great Lakes tossed three scoreless frames before the "Caps got on the board in the fourth. Josh Crouch blasted his sixth home run of the season – a solo shot recorded at 384 feet to give West Michigan a 1-0 lead. A wild pitch by Nastrini in the sixth allowed Corey Joyce to score, extending the Whitecaps lead to 2-0. Jose King added a run-scoring double in the seventh to increase the lead to 3-0. The Loons stranded runners at the corners in the sixth as reliever RJ Petit struck out Alex De Jesus to end the threat, and righty Dario Gardea escaped a bases-loaded one-out jam in the seventh by only allowing one run. In the ninth, Magno allowed a one-out, RBI-double to Imanuel Vargas to bring the Loons within a run but struck out Harold Restituyo and Kekai Rios to finish the contest and give West Michigan its third win of the season in five games at Dow Diamond this season. Hurter (4-0) earns his fourth victory as a Whitecap, while Loons pitcher Nick Nastrini (3-3) takes the tough-luck loss despite giving up just two runs in six innings. Magno earned his eighth save of the season and improved to a perfect 8-for-8 in save opportunities this season. The Whitecaps improve to 48-41 and 17-6 in the second half. The Loons fall to 54-35 and 14-9 in the second half. Infielder Ryan Kriedler, the Detroit Tigers No. 6 Prospect by MLB Pipeline, joined the club before the contest as part of a minor league rehab assignment on Friday but did not play on Saturday as part of a scheduled off-day.

GOT US A 12-PACK: The 'Caps scored 12 runs in the third inning of their 7/4 20-1 victory over the Dayton Dragons -- the most runs in a single frame by any team in Minor League Baseball. The 19-run win also broke the franchise record for largest margin of victory in a game, topping the mark of 18 runs in a 19-1 win on 6/1/14 at Fort Wayne.

LEAVING ON A HIGH NOTE: The Whitecaps have won 11 of their 15 games to end a series during the 2022 season.

MADDEN '22: Pitcher Ty Madden was named Midwest League Player of the Week on June 27 after tossing 10 scoreless innings while only giving up three hits and striking out nine batters. Madden ranks as the Tigers No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

HISTORY FOR HOLTON: Infielder Jake Holton collected seven RBI, including two homers -- one of which served as the game-winning home run as part of a June 14 8-7 win over the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park - a performance last replicated by 2012 infielder Aaron Westlake on June 3 at Great Lakes. Only one player in franchise history has collected more RBI in a single game -- Jeremy Laster -- who drove in eight runs in a game played on 8-8-08, at Alliant Energy Field at Clinton. The performance led to his being named the MWL Player of the Week on June 19.

2,000 SECURED: The West Michigan Whitecaps opened the 2022 regular season with a 5-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons for their 2,000th win in club history at Dow Diamond on April 8. The Whitecaps finished the 2021 season one victory short of the franchise milestone, but wasted no time hitting the mark in 2022. West Michigan recorded their 1,000th win when they beat the Clinton LumberKings 5-0 in Comstock Park on April 14, 2007.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold six of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.
