LANGFORD COLLECTS SIXTH-MULTI HIT GAME IN A ROW IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped a late lead to the Amarillo Sod Poodles in a 5-4 walkoff loss, despite two hits from **Wyatt Langford** on Friday from HODGETOWN. Langford singled in the first inning and stole his first base at the Double-A level. He also singled in the ninth inning on a ground ball at 111 miles per hour to left field. Langford now has seven multi-hit games of his 10 games played at Double-A, including six in a row. Frisco (32-35, 63-72) led 4-1 until a rain-soaked eighth inning, when Amarillo (42-25, 76-60) hit back-to-back homers to tie, and then walked it off in the ninth inning on a balk. **Ryan Garcia** allowed just one run in his five-inning start for Frisco. He allowed a home run to the first batter he faced and did not concede another run, giving up five hits with five strikeouts in a no-decision. **Reid Birlingmaier** chipped in two hitless innings for the Riders. **Michael Brewer** (2-3) took the loss, allowing the walkoff run in the ninth inning. **Raffi Vizcaino** (1-1) garnered the win for the Sod Poodles, pitching a scoreless ninth inning as the seventh pitcher of the night. Frisco tied the game at 1-1 in the second inning after **David Garcia** walked and advanced to third on **Zion Bannister's** double. It was Bannister's first Double-A hit in his first start with the RoughRiders. Garcia then scored on a ground ball by **Keyber Rodriguez**. The RoughRiders took the lead on another RBI groundout in the fourth inning. **Aaron Zavala** led off the frame with a walk and later scored on Bannister's bounce. Zavala added to the lead the next inning with an RBI double. **Josh Hatcher** added an RBI double of his own in the seventh inning to score **Kellen Strahm** from first base after Strahm's single. **Liam Hicks** drew two free passes for the second-straight game, both time with one walk and one hit by pitch.

WELCOME, WYATT:

Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/1.217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday against Northwest Arkansas, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday. On Wednesday, he had his first two-homer game. On Thursday, he became the first player for the RoughRiders to have multiple hits in six games in a row. During this stretch, he is hitting .545 (12-for-22) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBIs, six walks and five runs scored.

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder **Evan Carter** was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit .284/.411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

BROKEN BATS:

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.6 runs per game, a .236 batting average, 24 home runs and a .705 OPS over their 40 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 17-22. The 24 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in eight of the last 19 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 98 over their 135 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .273/.372/.432/.804 in the first inning with 15 home runs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 676 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Kellen Strahm** (73, 6th), **Aaron Zavala** (72, 7th) and **Trevor Hauver** (71, 8th). In 2015, **Drew Robinson** set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 138. Next up is **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 50 games, Hicks is batting .294 (48-for-163)/.435/.380/.815 with nine doubles, a triple, a home run, 23 RBIs, 31 walks and 21 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.
