FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas wrap up their road trip on Sunday afternoon with the finale (2-3) of a six-game series against the Cincinnati Reds affiliate Chattanooga Lookouts at Erlanger Park.

FLINT, RODRIGUEZ HOMER IN 4-2 WIN: Raudi Rodriguez and Tucker Flint each homered as the Trash Pandas earned a 4-2 victory over Chattanooga on Saturday night, moving within 3.0 games of first place with eight games remaining in the first half. Rodriguez finished 2-for-3 with a home run, double, walk, and two runs scored, while Flint delivered the go-ahead solo homer in the sixth inning. Jose Gonzalez earned the win with 2.1 scoreless innings in relief, and the Rocket City bullpen combined to allow just one hit over the final 4.1 innings.

GETTING RAUDI: Through 58 games, Raudi Rodriguez, is the only Double-A player with 50+ hits, 50+ runs, 30+ RBIs, 40+ walks, and 20+ stolen bases

MILB'S SAVES LEADER: After his save on Wednesday night, Luke Murphy leads all of Minor League Baseball with 12 saves. Murphy has allowed just 1 earned run over 19 games, and 20.2 innings pitched (0.44 ERA), 7 walks, 25 strikeouts, and no earned runs over his last 14 outings, 17.0 innings, 3 walks, and 20 strikeouts.

PUTTING THE HURT ON 'EM: Joel Hurtado ranks 2nd in the Southern League with a 2.87 ERA over 12 starts. Hurtado has induced 73 ground ball outs, 2nd most in the league, and 4th among Double-A pitchers. Over his last eight starts, since April 29, Hurtado has a 1.59 ERA, tops in the league, and 2nd in Double-A.

TOP PITCHING STAFF SINCE MAY 3: Over the Trash Pandas' last 35 games, since May 3, the pitching staff has a 3.42 ERA, which is the best in Double-A, and 2nd among full season Minor League clubs.

WHAT ABOUT THE BULLPEN?: The bullpen had a 5.38 ERA over the first 26 games, with six blown saves. Over those 35 games since, they are 3rd in Minor League Baseball with a 2.82 ERA, and the highest strikeout rate in MiLB at 30.6%.

AMONG THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Raudi Rodriguez is 1st in runs (49), 4th in OBP (.402), 3rd in walks (40), T-5th in hits (58), 9th in batting (.282), T-10th in stolen bases (20), 7th in OPS (.868) ... Tucker Flint is T-7th in doubles (12), and T-8th in runs (36), 9th in walks (31) ... Nick Rodriguez is 1st in in doubles (16) ... Jose Gonzalez is 7th in ERA (4.61), 7th in WHIP (1.33), and BAA (.234) ... Joel Hurtado is 2nd in ERA (2.87), 3rd in WHIP (1.09), 6th in innings pitched (59.2), 4th in BAA (.211), and T-7th in wins (4) ... Ryan Costeiu is T-3rd in wins (5) ... Kenyon Yovan is T-5th in appearances (20), and T-4th in saves (5), Leonard Garcia

is T-1st in appearances (21) ... Luke Murphy is 1st in saves (12), and T-5th in appearances (20).

KRUZEL REACHES 500 CAREER WINS: Last Saturday's 2-1 victory over Columbus at Toyota Field marked the 500th career managerial win for Joe Krugel. In his first season with Rocket City, Krugel reached the milestone in his ninth year as a manager and now owns 501 career victories across stops in the Reds, Cardinals, and Angels organizations.

FIRST LOOK AT ERLANGER PARK: This series marks the second of four meetings (24 games) between the Rocket City Trash Pandas and Chattanooga Lookouts in 2026. Rocket City is 6-5 this season, and hold a 76-78 all-time record against the Reds affiliate, including a 37-40 in Chattanooga. The series also marks the Trash Pandas' first visit to new Erlanger Park, which is the 11th Southern League ballpark the franchise has visited.

"LOOK'ING AHEAD: The clubs will meet 12 more times in the second half, July 7-12 at Toyota Field and September 8-13 at Erlanger Park.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Nick Rodriguez doubled three times on Tuesday night, giving him 16 on the season, which is tops in the Southern League, and T-5th in Double-A. He became just the third Trash Panda to record three doubles in a game, the first by a Southern League player in 2026, and just the 6th in Double-A.

THE NEW GUYS: On Tuesday, the Angels promoted infielders Kyren Paris, and Ben Gobel to Triple-A Salt Lake, while utility man Caleb Bartolero, and outfielder Anthony Scull were promoted to Rocket City from High-A Tri-City. Bartolero was hitting .306 with an .866 OPS in 40 games at High-A Tri-City. Scull won Northwest League Player of the Month in May after hitting .319 with eight home runs and a 1.024 OPS.

LOST PRODUCTION: Over the last three weeks, the Trash Pandas have lost three key pieces of their lineup. Wade Meckler (promoted to Los Angeles), Matthew Lugo (claimed off waivers by KC), and Gustavo Campero (right hand fracture) combined for 116 hits, 36 extra-base hits, 78 runs, 66 RBIs, and 28 stolen bases.

MEANINGFUL MAY: The Pandas matched a club record for wins in May, going 15-11 (15-11 in '22), and posted a 3.61 ERA as a team, which was the tops in Double-A, and 5th in all of Minor League Baseball. The Pandas will finish the May 31 suspended game on June 16 vs. Montgomery, which will impact the May stats.

PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas feature five of the Angels' top 30 prospects.

RETURN OF THE MECK: Anaheim native Wade Meckler was promoted from Rocket City to Los Angeles on May 22, and homered off Jacob deGrom in his first MLB at-bat since 2023. Meckler added his first career grand slam on May 30 at Tampa Bay. Meckler is batting .305 over his first 19 games for the Angels with five doubles, two homers, 12 RBIs, and seven walks.

MAKING THE JUMP FROM LOW-A: INF Harold Coll, INF Nick Rodriguez, and OF Raudi Rodriguez are all making the jump from Low-A to Double-A, bypassing High-A Tri-City altogether.

LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: LHP Samy Natera Jr. became the 50th player in franchise history to make their Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' game on June 6 against the Dodgers. Natera joins fellow pitching alums **Coleman Crow** (4/17 for MIL), **Walbert Urena** (3/26 for LAA) and **George Klassen** (4/5 for LAA) on making their MLB debuts this season. Natera has the claim of being the 50th to debut, 50th former Trash Panda to make his Major League debut. The Juárez, Mexico native tossed 2.0 hitless innings with three strikeouts against the Dodgers in his debut after emerging as one of the Angels' top relief prospects in 2025, posting a 4-1 record, 2.64 ERA, 68 strikeouts, and eight saves in 41 appearances with Rocket City, after reaching the Double-A level in 2024. Crow, originally selected by the Angels, Crow was acquired by Milwaukee in December 2023 after prior stints in the Angels and Mets organizations. Crow spent part of the 2022-23 season with Rocket City, where he ranked among the franchise's career leaders in innings pitched (152), strikeouts (159), wins (11), and starts (27). He earned Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors three times in 2022 and was named Pitcher of the Month in June of that season. Notably, Crow threw six hitless innings in a combined no-hitter on April 8, 2023, vs. Chattanooga, in a seven-inning game at Toyota Field. The infamous game included Rocket City issuing five walks, four hit batters, and committing an error, allowing seven runs without surrendering a hit—one of the rare instances in professional baseball history of a team throwing a no-hitter and losing. RHP **George Klassen**, 24, made his Major League debut with the Los Angeles Angels on April 5 against Seattle at Angel Stadium, becoming the 48th former Trash Panda to reach the Majors, and second so far in 2026. A native of West Bend, Indiana, Klassen worked 2.2 innings, allowing two runs while striking out four, and the Angels went on to win the game 8-7 in 11 innings. Ranked as the Angels' No. 4 prospect by MLB Pipeline, Klassen was a key member of Rocket City's 2025 rotation, earning a Futures Game selection and ranking among the franchise leaders in starts during his first full Double-A season. **Walbert Ureña** became the 47th player in franchise history to make his Major League debut, doing so during the Los Angeles Angels' Opening Day win over the Houston Astros on March 26.

HIGH SCHOOL TEAMMATES REUNITE: RHP **Camden Minacci**, and INF **Nick Rodriguez** reunite in Rocket City after being teammates at Tampa Jesuit High School. Minacci was the Florida 6A Player of the Year in 2020, and Rodriguez, a year younger, graduating in 2021. Both played under head coach Miguel Menendez.

2026 SCHEDULE: The complete 138-game schedule will run from April 3 to Sunday, September 13 ... The first half of the season will conclude with a six-game series against Montgomery at Toyota Field from June 16-21. The regular season will wrap up with another six-game series at Chattanooga, scheduled for September 8-13. The final home series at Toyota Field will take place from September 1-6 against Montgomery.

GLOBAL BASEBALL SERIES: The Trash Pandas picked up a 6-3 win over Japan's Toyota Red Cruisers on April 1 at Toyota Field. **Tucker Flint** led the way offensively, homering twice and reaching base four times. The victory capped

the three-game Global Baseball Series in front of a crowd of 4,355. The Red Cruisers are the official industrial team for TOYOTA Japan.

2025 SEASON IN REVIEW: The Trash Pandas, managed by **Andy Schatzley** concluded their fifth season with a 45-92 record, finishing fourth in the Southern League's North Division, 35.5 games behind the champion Birmingham Barons. Rocket City went 24-45 at Toyota Field and 21-47 on the road, being outscored 637-445 for a -192 run differential. In the first half, the Trash Pandas posted a 24-44 record, placing fourth, 15 games back of the Chattanooga Lookouts. The team went 13-26 at home and 11-19 on the road, ending the half on a nine-game losing streak, including a seven-game sweep by Chattanooga, a new club record. Rocket City scored 219 runs while allowing 310. The second half saw the team finish 21-48, again fourth in the division and 22 games behind Birmingham. The Trash Pandas went 11-19 at home and 10-29 on the road, scoring 226 runs while surrendering 327.

NEW TO THE ANGELS ORGANIZATION: **Elijah Dunham** (NYY), **Jose Gonzalez** (TEX), **Eybersson Polanco** (Rule 5, BOS), and **JJ D'Orazio** (ARI) are all making their Angels organizational debut this season.

NEW COACHING STAFF: **Joe Kruzel** was named manager of the Rocket City Trash Pandas prior to the 2026 season, becoming the third manager in franchise history following **Jay Bell** (2021) and **Andy Schatzley** (2022-25). Kruzel enters the role with more than 30 years of coaching experience at the professional and collegiate levels. The 2026 season marks his first year managing in the Angels' system after serving four seasons in a developmental leadership role. His all-time managerial record is 473-472. Joining Kruzel in Madison this season are **Daren Brown** (Coach), **Tim Leveque** (Pitching Coach), **Doug Henry** (Assistant Pitching Coach), **Tony Jaramillo** (Hitting Coach), **Dylan Culwell** (Athletic Trainer), **Chase Galloway** (Assistant Athletic Trainer), **Matt Gabriel** (Strength and Conditioning Coach), **Tristan Saglime** (Game Planning Strategist), and **Joe Wike** (Video Assistant).

BUILDING THE BRAND: From January through August 2025, the Trash Pandas generated 41.3 million social media impressions—an average of 5.2 million per month—ranking second among all Double-A clubs and ninth across Minor League Baseball. The team's combined audience on Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, and X grew by 10% this year to 356,000 followers. Since debuting in 2021, the Trash Pandas have surpassed 200 million total impressions, establishing themselves as one of the most consistently engaging brands in MiLB. In addition,

THE 2025 ROSTER AND HISTORIC MOVEMENT: The Trash Pandas made a club record 128 roster moves during the 2025 season, reflecting a busy and ever-changing lineup. The moves were distributed throughout the year with eight in April, 13 in May, 28 in June—including 11 on June 17—plus 17 in July, 24 from August 1-6 (16 on August 2), six on June 2-3, and 16 in September. These frequent changes shaped the team's roster and contributed to the dynamic nature of the season. 57 players took the field for the Trash Pandas in 2025, which included 32 pitchers and 25 position players.
