FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders won their sixth-straight contest after defeating the St. Lucie Mets 3-2 on walk-off RBI single from Jeral Toledo in the ninth inning on Wednesday night. **Eddy Rodriguez** and **Omar Alfonso** each tallied multi-hit games while **Keiner Delgado** slugged a solo-home run.

STUDY OF FORESTRY: Over the last 11 games, **INF Garret Forrester** is slashing .429/.535/.657 with five doubles, one HR, five RBIs, seven walks, and seven runs scored. Since April 24, the former Oregon State Beaver has hits in eight of those 11 games while tallying two or more hits in five contests. In the last two Tuesday games versus Fort Myers and St. Lucie, Forrester has recorded a season-high three hits.

WE CALL THAT A WINNING STREAK: Wednesday night's walk-off victory marked the Marauders' sixth-straight win. Bradenton had three streaks of six-plus wins last season with their longest streak lasting from April 14 - April 21 at seven games.

ROSTER MOVES: On Tuesday morning, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced several roster moves affecting Single-A Bradenton, including the additions of **INF Keiner Delgado** and **RHP Thomas Harrington** (MiLB rehab). Delgado was just recently acquired last week in a trade with the New York Yankees as the player to be named later to complete the JT Brubaker deal made last month. At the time, Delgado was listed as the No. 20 prospect in the Yankees organization. Harrington begins his Minor League rehab from Double-A Altoona after making eight starts for Bradenton last season. The Pirates' No. 6 prospect has yet to pitch in 2024.

BLANKED: The Marauders blanked the St. Lucie Mets 4-0 on Tuesday to pick up their fifth shutout win of the season and their third in their last five games. The first two came against the Clearwater Threshers before Bradenton pitched back-to-back shutouts last week against Fort Myers. The five shutouts on the year are tied for the second-most in MiLB only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who have six.

KING OF THE HILLS: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the best ERA in Minor League Baseball at 2.28. The Marauders just edged out Birmingham Batons (CWS, Double-A) at 2.37. So far in the month of May, Bradenton has allowed just nine runs in 63.0 innings, which is good for a 1.29 ERA and the best in MiLB. The next closest team, the Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA, Double-A), have a 1.74 ERA.

AMAZIN IS HERE: For the first time since 2019, the Bradenton Marauders welcome in the St. Lucie Mets to LECOM Park. Bradenton has visited Clover Park for a six-game series in 2021 and 2023. In 2019, the Marauders and Mets started the season with a two-game home & home series with St. Lucie winning three of the four contests. The Mets also won three of four from Bradenton at LECOM Park later on at the end of July.

ED, ED, AND EDDY: Over the last five games, **Eddy Rodriguez** has been hard to stop at the plate. The 20-year-old is 9-for-17 with two doubles, six RBIs, three walks, and four runs scored in his last five contests. The four RBIs on Saturday night were a season-high among any Marauders batter this season.

GOT EM!: **Hunter Furtado** picked off Brandon Winokur in the fifth inning on Sunday afternoon for the Marauders 10th pickoff of the season. As of Thursday, the Marauders are currently tied for second in MiLB, only trailing the Fredericksburgh Nationals (Single-A, WAS) who have 11. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

HEATING UP: Over the last seven games, **Esmerlyn Valdez** is hitting .353/.522/.588 with four doubles, a HR, six RBIs, three walks, and six runs scored. Valdez has also reaching base in 10 straight contests, his longest on-base streak of the season.

IN HIS GROOVE: With another scoreless outing on Sunday, **LHP Hunter Furtado** has extended his season-long scoreless streak to 5.2 innings. Over his last three outings, the 2023 Sixth-Round pick has struck out seven and walking one while allowing just three hits. **LHP Connor Oliver** tossed a scoreless inning on Tuesday against St. Lucie to extend his streak to 10.2 innings.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Wednesday's win versus St. Lucie marked their 12th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 5-7 record in those games with 20 of their first 29 (68.9%) games having been decided by three runs or less.
