REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

The Shuckers set a new single-game franchise record with 7 home runs on Friday night... In total, the Shuckers hit 2,676 feet (0.509 miles) worth of home runs across their 7 blasts, tied for the 2nd-most in a game in Southern League history... It marked the 8th time in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005) that a Southern League team had recorded at least 7 home runs in a game.

☛ The 7 home runs came from **1B BLAKE BURKE** (114 MPH, 379 FT // 106 MPH, 415 FT // 102 MPH, 383 FT), **OF JOSIAH RAGSDALE** (103 MPH, 422 FT // 90 MPH, 348 FT), **3B ANDREW FISCHER** (107 MPH, 356 FT) and **C MATTHEW WOOD** (99 MPH, 376 FT).

RAKE BURKE

1B BLAKE BURKE tied the Shuckers single-game franchise record with 3 home runs on Friday... Burke is the 7th Shucker in franchise history to record a 3-home run game and the 1st since **C JEFFERSON QUERO** on May 16, 2023 at Chattanooga... The 3 home runs traveled a combined 1,177 feet, with one to left, center and right field.

☛ Burke enters today with 24 home runs, 3 shy of tying the Shuckers single-season franchise record, set by **OF COREY RAY** in 2018.

☛ Burke also enters today with 35 career home runs in 119 Double-A games, 4 shy of tying the franchise record, set by **UTL ZAVIER WARREN** (39)... Burke's 12.94 AB/HR is the 5th-best mark by a Double-A hitter (min. 400 PA) since 2005.

NEARLY A NO-NO (TIMES 2!!)

RHP YORMAN GALINDEZ (5+ no-hit innings on Thursday) and **RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ** (6.0 innings on Tuesday) became the 3rd pair of Shuckers starters to carry no-hitters into the 6th inning in the same series... It marked the first time a Shuckers rotation has achieved the feat since 2017.

☛ Rodriguez became the 8th starting pitcher in franchise history (since 2015) to carry a no-hitter through the 6th inning and the 1st since **RHP TREY SUPAK** on July 16, 2019, against Chattanooga.

GONE FISCH-ING

On Friday, **3B ANDREW FISCHER** became the 17th player in Brewers Minor League history to record a 30 home run season... Fischer is the 1st to achieve the feat since 2001 and is the 3rd to achieve the feat since 1990... Fischer currently has the most home runs in a season by a Brewers MiLB player since **C LANCE BURKHART** (32) in 2001.

☛ Fischer needs 10 home runs over the final 44 games of the season to become the 3rd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **LF/3B BILL McNULTY** (55) and **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

With a win on Friday, the Shuckers tied 2018, 2019 and 2025 for the 2nd-best record (51-39) through 90 games in franchise history (since 2015)... Through 90 games, the Shuckers are among the franchise leaders in home runs (1st, 110), runs (1st, 523), OPS (1st, .799) and stolen bases (1st, 192).

FROM RAGS TO RICHES

OF JOSIAH RAGSDALE recorded his 1st career multi-home run game on Friday... It marked his 1st at the professional and 1st since April 19, 2024, against Saint Peter's as a member of the Iona University.

☛ In 18 Double-A games, Ragsdale owns a .313/.457/.641 slash line with a 1.097 OPS, 6 home runs and 17 walks.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

Entering today, **MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO** needs 4 more wins to reach 1,500 in his career... Guerrero's 1,496 career wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP BRAYLON OWENS (1-0, 6.43) makes his 4th Double-A appearance and 2nd start... Owens has recorded at least 5 strikeouts in all 3 appearances, including a season-high of 7 against Chattanooga on July 5, 2026, in his Double-A debut.
