TODAY'S GAME

The Texas Rangers and Kansas City Royals close out their three-game Alternate Training Site exhibition series on Wednesday morning. Rangers RHP Drew Anderson is set to get the starting nod while the Royals plan to counter with LHP Daniel Lynch. First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 11:05 a.m.

BACK FOR A REBOUND

Rangers starter RHP Drew Anderson is looking to rebound from his first loss at the Alternate Training Site, which came in his last start on April 23 against the Royals at Globe Life Field in Arlington. The righty allowed six runs, only five of which were earned, on five hits and two walks while striking out three in 3.0 innings of work.

OUT OF THE 'PEN

Texas starter RHP Drew Anderson is scheduled to pitch approximately three innings in today's contest. Following Anderson out of the Rangers bullpen, in no particular order, is expected to be RHP Joe Barlow, RHP Jake Lemoine, RHP Luis Ortiz, RHP Spencer Patton and RHP Nick Vincent.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Kansas City Royals knocked off the Texas Rangers by a final score of 6-1 on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond to level the Alternate Training Site exhibition series at a game apiece. The Royals opened the scoring in the fifth inning as 2B Gabriel Cancel worked a leadoff walk before later scoring on a Clay Dungan single. An inning later, CF Edward Olivares walked prior to a booming two-run homer off the bat of 1B Emmanuel Rivera. The inning continued as 3B Kelvin Gutierrez walked before eventually scoring on a Texas error. Texas' lone run of the night came in the bottom of the sixth when CF Delino DeShields singled before an Andy Ibañez double left two runners in scoring position. An ensuing Andres Sotillet wild pitch allowed DeShields to sprint home, trimming the gap to 4-1. However, Kansas City tacked on a pair of insurance runs in the top of the ninth inning. Dungan opened the frame with a double prior to a Sebastian Rivero walk. Rangers RHP Cole Uvila tossed a wild pitch, allowing Dungan to race home. A Bobby Witt, Jr. sacrifice fly extended the final score to 6-1.

KHRUSH COMES TO TOWN

The Texas Rangers announced on Wednesday morning that 2018 MLB Home Run Leader DH Kris Davis has joined the Alternate Training Site roster on a Major League rehab assignment. The slugger has been sidelined with a left quad strain since April 1. Davis has logged 218 career home runs across eight professional seasons with Milwaukee and Oakland.

IT'S BASEBALL TIME IN ROUND ROCK

On February 9, the Round Rock Express officially accepted their invitation to become the new Triple-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers. The 10-year agreement will keep Rangers Triple-A baseball in Round Rock through the 2030 season. Kicking off with the Alternate Training Site, the Express are reuniting with the Rangers after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018.

WELCOME TO THE ALTERNATE TRAINING SITE

Created during the cancelled 2020 Minor League Baseball season, the Alternate Training Site concept provides a secondary location within close geographic proximity to each Major League Baseball club for players to train and be ready to quickly and safely be called up if necessary. At MLB's request, the Alternate Training Site model will be implemented for the month of April after the start of the Triple-A baseball season was postponed until early May.
