The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators on Thursday night. It is the third-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six games in Reading. The Fightin Phils went 7-5 against Harrisburg in 2024, including a 4-2 record at home and 3-3 record on the road. Following this week, the Fightin Phils head to Harrisburg from June 3-8. Harrisburg leads the season-series 2-0.

R-Phils.

Game 21 Recap

A late Harrisburg rally handed the Fightin Phils their 10th-straight loss on Wednesday night. Reading had a 3-0 lead entering the seventh inning, but the Senators scored six-unasnwered runs off Mitch Neunborn and Gunner Mayer. Moises Chace started for Reading and turned in his best outing of the seaosn. The Phillies No. 5 prospect went four-shutout innings, scaterring three hits and striking out four. Hendry Mendez stayed red-hot with two hits and two runs, along with a double. Felix Reyes continued his strong start with a pair of hits and two runs driven in. Jack Dallas followed Chace with two-scoreless innings in relief.

Looking to Get Back in the Win Column

Entering tonight, the Fightin Phils have lost 10 games in a row. It marks the longest R-Phils losing streak since dropping eight in a row from July 22-30 of the 2022 season. With Wednesday night's loss, it is the first time the R-Phils have dropped 10-or-more games in a row since June 17 to 29, of 2014, when Reading lost 12 games in a row.

Miller Gets on Base

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller extended his season-best on-base streak to 14 games on Wednesday night. Over the on-base streak, Miller has a .349 onbase percentage. Miller's 14-game on-base streak leads the Fightin Phils and is currently the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League.

Keaton Anthony hit his team-leading seventh double of the season on Tuesday night. Entering play tonight, Anthony is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in Anthony is slashing .308/.365/.385 (.752 OPS), along with two runs, two doubles and four RBI. Anthony added another RBI on Wednesday night, which ties him with Robert Moore for the team lead in RBI with 12.

A Look at Some Numbers

Through 21 games this season, Reading has scored first in nine games. But, in those games, the Fighitn Phils hold just a 1-8 record. Through the first six innings of games this season, Reading has a -7 run differential, and in innings 7-9 the R-Phils' run differential is -22.

April Showers, Bring May Flowers?

It was a slow start to the season for the Fightin Phils in the first month of the season. Reading went 5-16 in April and is currently marred in a 10-game losing streak. For the month, the Fightin Phils posted a .219 average and 4.65 ERA.

Hendry Mendez turned in one of his best games of the season on Tuesday night. Mendez had three hits, one run, a double and two RBI. Entering play today, Mendez leads the Fightin Phils in hits, average and runs scored. He also leads Reading in multi-hit games with seven and three-hit games with three. Mendez stayed hot on Wednesday when he had two more hits and scored two runs, and he now owns back-to-back multi-hit games.

FirstEnergy Stadium is known as a hitters park and the Fightin Phils have the numbers to back that up. Over 11 home games this season, Reading has hit 11 home runs, which is fourth in the Eastern League for home home runs. When on the road, the Fightin Phils have hit just two home runs across 10 games, which is the least amount of road home runs in the league.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 1, 2011: At Reading, Cody Overbeck hits two solo home runs and walks in his other two plate appearances to lead the Phillies to a 3-2 win over Portland. Overbeck increases his league-best RBI total to 22.

Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 10-12 record, sitting in fifth place in the Eastern League Southwest Division. In 2024, the Senators finished with a 68-70 record, which was the third best record in the Southwest Divsion, and didn't qualify for the playoffs. Harrisburg's roster features seven of the Nationals' top-30 prospects: Jarlin Susana (2), Cade Cavalli (7), Daylen Lile (9), Cayden Wallace (10), Yohandy Morales (12), Marquis Grissom Jr. (23) and Kevin Made (27).

Throwing for the Senators

Lefty Dustin Saenz makes the start tonight for Harrisubrg. This season, he's 1-2, with a 7.13 ERA over five games/four starts (17.2 IP, 22 H, 6 BB, 15 SO). Saenz Last piched Apr. 26 vs Erie, allowing five runs on six hits over five innings, taking the loss. He combined to make 13 starts last season at three levels, going 1-6, with a 6.54 ERA. He faced the Fightin Phils once last season, on Sept. 11, allowing one run on three hits over six innings, but taking the loss. The 25-year old was drafted by the Nationals in the fourth round of the 2021 draft out of Texas A&M. He pitched for the Aggies from 2018-21.

Cabrera went a season-high six innings, and threw a season-best 89 pitches in his last start at Portland. He did surrender a season-most four runs in the no-decision, but was able to remain economical with his pitch count. All four runs he allowed came in the fourth inning, as he posted a zero in 5/6 frames. His six innings marked the first time a Reading pitcher tossed six innings this season. Cabrera was relieved by Nelson Alvarez in the bottom of the seventh.

2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft
- The Phillies optioned Cabrera to Reading (AA) on March 8

- Cabrera pitched in two spring training games for the Phillies, allowing one run over three innings and also earning a win on Feb. 28 vs Boston
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two
 innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opens the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Named the Fightin Phils Opening Day starter and allowed 1 ER over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on Apr. 4 vs Portland
