FIVE-RUN ROCHESTER SIXTH SINKS SHRIMP

The Rochester Red Wings scored five runs in the sixth inning on Friday to beat the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp 8-7 from VyStar Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp plated a pair of runs in the first inning on a **Kemp Alderman** single and **Nathan Martorella** bases-loaded walk. After a Red Wings run in the second, **Deyvison De Los Santos** smacked a three-run home run to make it 5-1 in the fourth. Rochester exploded for five runs in the fifth and added one more tally in the seventh to make it 7-5. Martorella tied the game with a two-run base hit in the bottom of the seventh. In the ninth, **Yohandy Morales** walked with the bases loaded to score what proved to be the game-winning run.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1964

Jacksonville finished 2025 with an 89-61 (.593) record, the best mark in Triple-A. The 89 victories tied the 1964 Jacksonville Suns for the fourth-most in Jacksonville Minor League Baseball history, which dates back to 1904, and were also the most in franchise history since those 1964 Suns. By winning percentage, Jacksonville enjoyed its best season since the 2006 Suns posted an 86-54 (.614) record.

MEN OF STEAL

In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered only 86 stolen bases, 29th in Triple-A and 119th out of the 120 MiLB teams. Jacksonville was not much better in the 2023 (124 steals, 20th in Triple-A) nor 2022 (114, 23rd in Triple-A) campaigns. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp swiped a franchise-record 305 bags, second-most in Triple-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Jacksonville, which had not finished in the top five at their level in stolen bases since at least 2005, had more games with multiple stolen bases (84) in 2025 than games with either one steal (32) or no steals (34) combined.

FORMULA ONE

With a 29-14 (.674) record in one-run games in 2025, Jacksonville tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in all of Minor League Baseball. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS

Thanks to **Jacob Berry's** walk-off home run, Jacksonville bested Las Vegas 8-7 in the 2025 Triple-A National Championship. To reach the Triple-A National Championship game, the Jumbo Shrimp beat the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders 2-1 in the best-of-three International League Championship Series. The victory in the ILCS sealed the first title of the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present) and Northeast Florida's first International League crown since the 1968 Jacksonville Suns won the Governors' Cup. In between, these two Triple-A titles, Jacksonville claimed six Double-A Southern League titles.

RECORDS ARE MADE TO BE BROKEN

Jacksonville set franchise-records in 2025 in stolen bases (305) and pitching strikeouts (1,344). The club also neared a pair of other records; The Jumbo Shrimp used a whopping 90 players last season, matching the club record set in 2024. Of those 90 players, 49 were pitchers, just two away from tying another club record set in 2024. Jacksonville logged 35 different starting pitchers, smashing the previous record of 28 set in 2024. At VyStar Ballpark, the club's 44 home victories in 2025 were their most at home since 2010 (also 44), while their 45 road triumphs were their most in recorded club history (since at least 2005).

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

While the Jumbo Shrimp made 126 errors in 2025, sixth-most in Triple-A, Jacksonville's rangy defense helped the club yield the fewest hits and second-fewest runs at the level this season. The Jumbo Shrimp led Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .715, meaning they turned 71.5 percent of balls put in play into outs.

SHRIMP BITES

Rochester's five-run sixth inning represented the most runs Jacksonville allowed in a regular season inning since a six-run Gwinnett first inning on September 19, 2024... The 10 walks the Jumbo Shrimp issued last night were their most in a game since June 26, 2024, when they walked 11 Nashville Sounds... Jacksonville's 10 walks offensively Friday were the club's most since August 8, 2024 (11 at Toledo).

ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujanyer Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 15, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.
