### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, a remarkable 24 games over .500 at 40-16 (.714)

- 40 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, 4 ahead of the next winningest team ... of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .714 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Modesto Nuts (35-15 / .700 / Mariner's Single-A).
- 23 wins in May were the most of any Minor League Baseball team ... 23 wins were also the most in a single month for an MiLB team since the Ogden Raptors went 24-4 in July 2019.

#### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 6 straight series and 26 of its last 31 games ... 22 of those 31 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 19 of the team's 26 wins in this stretch.

- Omaha is 15-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... 21 games decided by 1 run are tied for the 2nd-most in the Minors ... the Chasers have won their last 5 1-run games and 8 of the last 11.
- Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, but 17 of 31 games since have had a save awarded (from 7 pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors since May 1 ... Will Klein has 5 saves in that span, while Carlos Hernández has 3 Dan Altavilla, and Walter Pennington and Sam Long each have 2 ... Steven Cruz and Evan Sisk each have 1 save in the last 31 games.
- In total, 39 of Omaha's 56 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (70%), including 12 of 16 losses this season.

#### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 334 to 250 this season, a +84 run differential.

- A +84 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the second-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +93 ... Omaha ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... Modesto leads all Minor League teams at +139 (358 to 219).

#### YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.

- When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 19-3 record (2.863 winning %), compared to 21-13 (.618 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
- When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 26-4 (.877 winning %), while the team is just 14-12 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.538 winning %).

#### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .203 average (5th in MiLB), while the .669 opposing OPS ranks 2nd-best and a 3.74 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 3rd-best in Triple-A.
- Last Friday's win was the 13th time this season Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run ... that is an average of once ever 4.31 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
- The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) at the Triple-A level in 2024 have come from Omaha pitchers ... Evan Sisk has not allowed a run over his last 14 games, 14.0 innings since April 20 ... Dan Altavilla's scoreless streak ended yesterday, what was 13.2 innings over 13 games since April 23.
- LHP Walter Pennington has 62 strikeouts in 39.0 innings this season, largely pitching in relief (21 relief appearances/2 opener starts) ... his 62 strikeouts are tied 5th-most in the International League, while 50 strikeouts as a reliever lead Minor League Baseball ... his 40.8% strikeout rate is 2nd in MiLB (min. 35.0 IP).

#### PENNY PUNCHIES

Lefty Walter Pennington was named the International League's Pitcher of the Week for his performance last week in Omaha's series win over Indianapolis.

- Pennington struck out 12 batters over 6.1 scoreless innings and allowed just one hit while not walking a batter ... 12 K was tied 2nd in the league, with the most strikeouts among pitchers with 6.0 or more scoreless innings.
- He appeared in 3 games, including a start in the second game of a doubleheader sweep on Thursday ... he struck out 4 over 2.0 perfect innings in relief on Monday, tied a career high with 6 strikeouts over his 3.0-inning start and then struck out 2 over 1.2 perfect innings on Sunday to finish the game and earn the win.

#### IT'S GONNA BE MAY

The month of May the Storm Chasers produced this year is arguably one of the greatest single months in the modern era of the club.

- 23 wins in May 2024 marks the most wins the team has had in a single month in the modern era (2005-present), passing the August 2005 Omaha Royals who went 21-9.

**TODAY'S START**

- Champlain is making his **3rd start with Omaha** and his **10th overall start** this season ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Champlain made 7 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha two weeks ago, on Monday, May 20.
- Ranks 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in 2024 in strikeouts (59), is 1st among full-season qualifiers in WHIP (0.98), 3rd in opponents' batting average (.217) and 5th in ERA (3.64), while tied 5th in innings pitched (47.0 IP).
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the **No. 11 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 Royals prospect.**

**LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, MAY 30 @ INDIANAPOLIS**

Made his second Triple-A start but took a second straight no-decision, got 14 whiffs on 45 swings (31%) ... allowed a leadoff home run to **Jack Suwinski** in the bottom of the 1st inning but held the Indians to the one run over the first four innings of the game, limited Indy to two singles a walk and a hit batter through the end of the 4th ... faced the minimum over a 10-batter span between the 2nd and 5th innings, interrupted by 2 singles and a double that plated a run with 2 outs in the 5th inning ... did not come out for the 6th.

**2024 HIGHLIGHTS**

- Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 1-0 with a 9.00 ERA (2 ER in 2.0 IP).
- Struggled in his season debut in Double-A on April 7 vs. Tulsa, tied a career-high with 8 runs allowed in just 2.2 innings, but threw at least 5.0 innings and did not allow more than two runs in each of his final 6 Double-A starts, including three quality starts.
- At the time of his promotion to Triple-A, ranked 4th in the Double-A Texas League in strikeouts (48) and 2nd among qualifiers in WHIP (0.92) ... ranked 2nd on the Naturals staff in ERA (3.50), opponents' average (.203) and strikeouts (48).
- Worked career-best 12.1-inning scoreless streak that spanned his last two starts in Double-A, May 9 vs. Springfield and May 15 @ Arkansas, a stretch where he allowed 6 hits and 1 walk while striking out 17.

**CAREER NOTES**

- 2023**
- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA), combined to go 11-8 with a 3.33 ERA (50 ER in 135.1 IP) and 125 strikeouts over 25 starts.
- Totaled 13 quality starts of his 25 starts across two teams in 2023, the most of any Royals Minor League pitcher and tied for the 3rd-most among all Minor League pitchers ... the closest in the organization was **Brady Singer's** 9 quality starts in the big leagues.
