

-Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.

-Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

2024 SEASON

-Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.

-At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

2023 SEASON

-In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).

-As a starter with Asheville, Bellozo posted an 0-3 record and 7.34 ERA in 13 starts (57.2 IP, 65 H, 19 BB, 53 K, .284 BAA). Comparatively, as a reliever, he was 3-0 with a 4.38 ERA in nine appearances (37.0 IP, 41 H, 7 BB, 41 K, .273 BAA).

-Emanuel was originally selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 19th round of the 2010 draft out of Woodstock High School (Ga.) but opted to attend the University of North Carolina. He later signed with the Houston Astros after they picked him in the third round of the 2013 draft.

-Emanuel made his major league debut for the Astros on April 24, 2021 by firing 8.2 innings with just two runs against in a 16-2 win over the Angels. He pitched in relief that day.

-Emanuel was named the ACC Pitcher of the Year following his junior season in 2013 at North Carolina. He went 11-5 with a 3.14 ERA in 21 games, including 18 starts. He helped North Carolina reach the College World Series twice in his three years in Chapel Hill (2011, 2013).

-On November 19, 2021, the Philadelphia Phillies claimed Emanuel off of waivers. He pitched in Philadelphia's organization in 2022 and then the Pittsburgh Pirates' organization during the 2023 campaign.

2024 SEASON

2023 SEASON

-With Triple-A Indianapolis, Emanuel held left-handed hitters to a .236/.299/.393/.692 slash line in 97 plate appearances. However, right-handed batters hit .344/.384/.552/.936 against him in 281 plate appearances.

2022 SEASON

-First season back after season-ending UCL surgery (non-Tommy John) in 2021.

-Allowed more than three earned runs in a start just once (four runs, all earned on June 19 against Portland).

2021 SEASON

-Posted neutral platoon splits out of Houston's bullpen. Left-handed hitters posted a .233 average and .636 OPS against him compared to a .152 batting average and .624 OPS by opposing right-handed batters.

-Mother, Joanne, played volleyball and basketball in college.

-While at North Carolina, Emanuel majored in exercise and sports science.
