**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game homestand against the Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds) on Wednesday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Left-handed pitcher Pete Hansen is scheduled to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Darren McCaughan for Louisville.

**LAST NIGHT'S RECAP:** The Memphis Redbirds kicked off a six-game homestand with a 6-5 extra-inning loss to the Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds) on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Center fielder Joshua Báez drove in three of the five Memphis runs and scored another in the series-opening loss to Louisville. The right-handed hitter went 4-for-5 with two doubles and tied the game with two strikes and two outs on an infield single in the bottom of the tenth inning. The three RBIs in the game pushed the team leader to 42 on the season. With Memphis down a run and two outs in the bottom of the eighth, first baseman Blaze Jordan smacked a triple down the right field line to plate MLB Rehabber Lars Nootbaar to tie the game. Nootbaar went 0-for-3 with a walk and run scored in his MLB Rehab appearance in left field. Nootbaar was lifted for a defensive replacement in the top of the tenth inning, as scheduled. Opener Tink Hence allowed one run on one hit, walked two and struck out one over 1.0 inning of work in his first Triple-A appearance since April 26. Brandt Thompson dazzled behind him in his Triple-A debut. The right-handed pitcher allowed three runs on four hits, walked two and struck out three in 6.0 innings pitched. The outing included a string of 12 batters faced without a hit in the middle innings, 11 of which retired. The loss moved Memphis into a tie for second place in the International League standings with the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers). The clubs sit a half-game behind the Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) in the first-half race.

**BATTLE FOR FIRST PLACE:** Thanks to a franchise-best 7-0 start to the 2026 season and steady play since, the Memphis Redbirds had yet to spend a day of the season outside of at least a share of first place in the International League until the club's May 24 loss at Iowa (Triple-A, Chicago Cubs). Memphis fell back behind the Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Red Wings with Tuesday night's extra-inning loss to the Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds). The Redbirds enter Tuesday night's game against Louisville tied with the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) for second place and a half-game behind Rochester atop the International League Standings. There are five teams within 3.0 games of first and 12 within 6.0 games. Memphis returns home Wednesday to continue an important six-game series against Louisville, which currently sits 4.0 games out of first place at the start of play Wednesday. Memphis has not won any International League (or Triple-A East) title since leaving the Pacific Coast League ahead of the 2021 season. The last Redbirds league title came in 2018. The Redbirds finish up the final two weeks of the first half with a six-game road trip at the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles), then return home against Nashville for a series that likely decides the first-half International League Champion and host of the 2026 International League Championship series Sept. 22-24.

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his eighth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his eighth year in the Cardinals organization.

### COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 428 - 435 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

### PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero is beginning his 14th season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his fourth season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for his efforts over 5.0 shutout innings at Iowa on May 21, 2026
- Making his first Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invite.
- Member of the Springfield (AA) Cardinals 2025 Texas League Championship squad.
- Burst on to the professional scene in 2023 leading the Florida State League in ERA (3.12), strikeouts (126), games started (23) and winning percentage (.786), while ranking 2nd in wins (11), innings pitched (112.2), WHIP (1.16) and opponent BA (.220).
- Led the league in strikeouts in consecutive seasons, first the Florida State League (2023) and then the Midwest League (2024)
- His 24 wins since his professional debut rank T-14th among all minor league pitchers and 2nd by a Cardinal behind Michael McGreevy (30).
- Ranked in the Top 10 in strikeouts (383, T-9th), innings pitched (379.1) and starts (73) among all minor league pitchers since the start of 2023.
- His 3.65 ERA ranked 2nd among Cardinals minor league pitchers (Hancel Rincon, 3.63) and 17th overall among pitchers with 300+ IP.
- Led all Cardinals minor league pitchers with 126 strikeouts in 2023.
- Had career-high pitches (100 vs. Fort Wayne 8/23/24), strikeouts (10 at Quad Cities 7/13/24) and innings pitched (7.2 at Quad Cities 7/13/24).
- Pitched 5.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball at Jupiter (9/12/23) in Game 2 of the Florida State League semi-finals.
- Left with a no decision as the Cardinals fell 3-2 in 10 innings.
- Rated as high as the No. 15 prospect in the Cardinals organization by Baseball America entering the 2023 season.

### BACKGROUND/PERSONAL

- Graduated from Oak Ridge (Calif.) High School in El Dorado Hills in 2019.
- Was born in Texas, but moved to California at age 5.
- Named Most Valuable Pitcher at the Perfect Game World Series in 2018.
- Played college baseball at the University of Texas (2020-22), where he was teammates with current Cardinals outfielder Mike Antico. Posted career marks of 22-4 with a 2.67 ERA over 215.2 innings with 218 strikeouts and one save.
- Did not allow an earned run in his first 17.0 innings as a freshman in 2020 before the season was cut short. Struck out a career-high 13 batters over 6.2 innings in a start vs. Fairfield (6/8/21) in the Austin Regional.
- Made two appearances in the College World Series in 2021.
- Pitched 2.0 scoreless innings in relief vs. Mississippi State (6/20/21) and 5.2 innings vs. Virginia (6/24/21).
- Pitched for Brewster during the summer of 2021 in the Cape Cod League. Was 1-1 with a 6.32 ERA and 15 strikeouts over 15.2 innings pitched helping the Whitecaps to the Cape Cod League championship.
- First Team ABCA All-American in 2021 and 2022.
- Resides in McKinney, Texas.
