LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn suffered its 10th shutout of the season, falling to Hudson Valley in the series opener, 5-0...The Renegades scored four runs in the sixth and one more in the eighth to win...RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** tossed 5.0 innings of shutout ball, taking a no-decision for the Cyclones...The 26-year-old scattered three hits and two walks, striking out seven...IB **Nick Lorusso** provided two of Brooklyn's four hits, reaching base three times...RHP **Baron Stuart** (5.2 IP), LHP **Joel Valdez** (1), and RHP **Cole Ayers** (1.0) combined on the four-hit shutout for the Renegades.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On July 2, 2004, Cyclones LHP **Edgar Alfonzo** and RHP **Celso Rondón** combined to strike out the game's final seven batters to close out Brooklyn's victory over the New Jersey Cardinals...In 2006, RHPs **Nelson Portillo** (6.0 IP), **Jonathan Castillo** (2.0), and **Joe Smith** (1.0) united on a seven-hit shutout in Brooklyn's 3-0 win at Hudson Valley...In 2008, the Cyclones erased a 3-0 deficit entering the eighth, scoring one in that frame and three in the ninth to win at Williamsport, 4-3...DH **Reese Havens** provided the go-ahead three-run home run in the top of the ninth...In 2009, LHPs **Mark Cohoon** (8.0 IP) and **Brandon Sage** (1.0) combined on a four-hit shutout, as Brooklyn defeated Tri-City, 5-0, at Maimonides Park...In 2012, C **Kevin Plawecki** hit a game-tying home run to lead off the bottom of the ninth and IB **Jayce Boyd** provided the walk-off sacrifice fly in the 11th to help the Cyclones beat Hudson Valley, 7-6.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision on Wednesday night in Aberdeen...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the 21-year-old is fourth in the circuit in ERA (3.38) and tied for fifth in strikeouts (56)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the year...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fourth in strikeout rate (35.9%), seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%), and tied for 13th in strikeouts (92).

KODAI ISLAND: The New York Mets announced on Monday that RHP **Kodai Senga** will make a Major League rehab start for the Brooklyn Cyclones on Wednesday night vs. Hudson Valley...The 31-year-old was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on March 28 (retro 3/25) with a right shoulder capsule strain...He was transferred to the 60-day injured list on April 10...He will be the sixth player to make a Major League rehab appearance for the Cyclones on Coney Island this year, joining RHP **Sean Reid-Foley**, RHP **Tyler Megill**, RHP **Drew Smith**, C **Francisco Alvarez**, and RHP **Edwin Diaz**...Senga was a National League All-Star in his 2023 rookie campaign for the Mets, tallying a 12-7 record with a 2.98 ERA (55 ER in 166.1 IP), 77 walks (11.10 BB%), and 60-2 strikeouts (29.11 K%) in 29 starts...The Gamagori, Japan, native finished second behind Arizona OF **Corbin Carroll** in the 2023 NL Rookie of the Year voting...Senga signed a five-year, \$75 million contract with the Mets on December 17, 2022.

BACK TO THE FUTURE: RHP **Brandon Sproat**, who started the 2024 season in the Cyclones' rotation, was named as the New York Mets' lone representative on the National League squad for the Sirius/XM All-Star Futures Game to be held at Globe Life Park in Arlington, Texas, on Saturday, July 13...In six appearances (five starts) for the Cyclones this year, the 23-year-old went 2-1 with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 16 walks (15.69 BB%), and 33 strikeouts (32.35%)...Since joining Double-A Binghamton on May 13, Sproat has continued his dominance going 3-0 with a 1.94 ERA (9 ER in 41.2 IP), 10 walks (6.53 BB%), and 43 strikeouts (28.10%) in seven starts.

ROSTER MOVES: LHP **Ryan Ammons** was transferred to Brooklyn's roster on Tuesday from Single-A St. Lucie...Over 18 relief appearances in the Florida State League, the 23-year-old accumulated a 1-4 record with a 2.88 ERA (8 ER in 25.0 IP) and three saves in five opportunities...Ammons walked 19 (16.96 BB%) and struck out 35 (31.25 K%)...The New York Mets acquired the southpaw from the Boston Red Sox in exchange for RHP **Justin Slaten** on December 6, 2023...C **Carlos Oviedo** was transferred to the Florida Complex League Mets...The 19-year-old did not make an appearance after re-joining the Cyclones on June 27.

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...Lorusso is seventh in the South Atlantic League in total bases (116), tied for seventh in OPS (.857), eighth in slugging (.485) and walks (39), and 10th in extra-base hits (27)...Lorusso is second among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.857)...He is also third in slugging (.485), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (27), home runs (11), RBI (40) and triples (3), fifth in total bases (116), and tied for fifth in walks (39)...Morabito is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (34)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for second in the circuit in hits (52), tied for third in stolen bases (23), and ninth in batting average (.295)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.332), on-base percentage (.436), and stolen bases (34)...He also is second in hits (83), third in OPS (.847), third in runs scored (45) and tied for fifth in walks (39).

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with last Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn will play a home-and-home six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley boasts four of the Yankees' High-A's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley in the first meeting on Coney Island (May 23-28), but the Renegades to 4-of-6 from Brooklyn in their last meeting in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...In 2023, the Cyclones went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 146-151 (.492).

game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 1-6 in the stretch...The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

BROOKLYN-BOUND BÁEZ: INF **Jesús Báez** clobbered his first High-A home run in Saturday's loss and has reached base safely in each of his first six games at the High-A level...Báez is the No. 15 prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and is the first player in franchise history born in 2005...In 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (16), second in total bases (123), third in hits (72) and extra-base hits (28), tied for fourth in runs scored (43), home runs (11), and RBI (40), and fifth in slugging (.446).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster last Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite appearing in only three games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 28 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (65) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (137).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 28 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .366/.449/.683 with a 1.132 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 14 walks to 15 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.357), on-base percentage (.449), slugging (.684), and OPS (1.123)...The University of Maryland alum ranks sixth, 11th, third, and third throughout Minor League Baseball in those four categories, respectively...In 36 road affairs, Lorusso hits .196/.317/.341 with a .658 OPS, adding five home runs and 22 RBI with 25 walks to 42 K's...On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** is loving his time on the road...He is hitting .333/.429/.444 with a .873 OPS, adding two home runs, seven RBI, and 22 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is tied for the most road hits in the circuit (36)...He is also tied for third in runs scored (23) while swiping seven more bases (22) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .235/.297/.265 line with a .562 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 16 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has also thrived at home posting a .301/.362/.417 mark with a .779 OPS, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 29 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .164/.266/.245 with a .511 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 30 contests.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday...The submariner earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 63 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP) and eight saves, walking just 25 and striking out 95.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

Relieved by RHP **Justin Lawson** to start the bottom of the seventh inning with game tied at one...The IronBirds walked off with a 3-1 victory on 3B/2B **Angel Tejada's** two-out, two-run home run to left in the bottom of the ninth.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: The 21-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zach Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
