#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders shut out the Clearwater Threshers in an 8-0 victory on Thursday night at LECOM Park. Carlson Reed struck out a career-high nine in five innings while Esmerlyn Valdez hit two home runs and reached base four times. Javier Rivas drove in three and fell just a double shy of the cycle. Peyton Stumbo struck out six in three-scoreless frames to earn his second save of the season.

BLANKED: With an 8-0 victory on Thursday night, the Marauders tossed their sixth shutout of the season which is tied for the most in the FSL. It's the teams first since May 7, third against the Threshers, and fifth thrown at LECOM Park this year. Last year, Bradenton only had seven the entire season in 130 games. The franchise record for most shutouts in a season is 18 set back in 2014. That rotation featured future Major Leaguers in Chad Kuhl. Tyler Glasnow, and Shane Carle.

GOOD THINGS COME IN BUNCHES: Esmerlyn Valdez smacked two home runs on Thursday night against Clearwater to become the first Marauders hitter with a multi-home run game this season. He's the first Marauder to do so at home since Pirates' No. 2 prospect Termarr Johnson hit two against Dunedin on 7/14/23. It's the second multi-HR game of Valdez' career, after he hit two on 6/29/23 vs the FCL Twins. No Marauder in franchise history has ever hit three home runs in a game.

WELCOME TO THE K ZONE: Bradenton's pitching racked up a season-high 17 strikeouts en route to an 8-0 victory over Clearwater on Thursday night. It's the thirdmost total by a team in the FSL this season with Clearwater having struck out 18 Lakeland hitters on 5/29 to lead the way. Bradenton struck out 17 hitters in game twice last year, with the most recent one on 6/9 vs Dunedin. The franchise-record is 21 set on 7/9/22 @ Lakeland.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the addition of OF Enmanuel Terrero on Wednesday night, the Bradenton Marauders now hold seven of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline, which is the most of any Minor League team in the Pirates system. The Altoona Curve (Double-A) are the close the pipeline of the pipeliteam holding six of the Top 30 with five of the Pirates top eight prospects there. LHP Michael Kennedy is the highest-rated player on the Marauders roster at No. 14.

LIFT OFF: After only hitting one home run in their first nine meetings, Bradenton has slugged six in three games this week at LECOM Park. The only other home run against Clearwater hit by the Marauders came on April 26 at BayCare Ballpark when P.J. Hilson hit a two-out eighth inning go-ahead solo-home run in a 1-0 victory.

BEST OF MAY: The Bradenton Marauders' pitching staff finished May with the second-best ERA in Florida State League at 3.32, which was also the seventh-best in Single-A. The bullpen posted a 2.73 ERA and struck out 134 batters in 115.1 innings, which is good for the best ERA in Single-A and seventh-best in Mil.B. The 16

HERE COMES THE POWER: The Marauders finished the month of May with 20 home runs in 26 games the second-most in the FSL with the Dunedin Blue Jays in first at 24. It's also the fourth-most HR in Single-A with Dunedin leading the charge. This comes after the Marauders had only 10 longballs in 22 games in April. So far in June, Bradenton has eight home runs in six games which is the most in the FSL and second-most in Single-A behind the Angels affiliate in the Inland Empire 66ers (9).

THE FIGHTIN PHILS ARE BACK: Bradenton welcomes back the Clearwater Threshers to LECOM Park for the first time since Opening Weekend. After playing nine games in April, both sides square off 12 times in June to wrap up their regular season matchup. The Threshers are the Marauders most common opponent this season, as they battle them 21 times this year

TURN THE LIGHTS OFF: RHP Landon Tomkins struck out the side in order in the ninth inning on Tuesday to pick up his seventh save of the season, which is now tied for the Florida State League lead with Saul Teran of the Clearwater Threshers. The seven saves are also the most by a pitcher in the Plrates organization this year.

CLOSE OUARTERS: Sunday's loss in Fort Myers marked the Marauders 21st one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 11-10 record in those games with 38 of their first 54 (70.3%) games having been decided by three runs or less

GOT EM!: Hunter Furtado picked off Poncho Ruiz in the seventh inning on Tuesday night for the Marauders 14th pickoff of the season. As of Thursday, the Marauders are currently fifth in MiLB, with the Quad Cities River Bandits (High-A, KC) leading the way with 17. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.
