TONIGHT'S GAME: The final home stand of the regular season continues, as the Quakes host the Visalia Rawhide (AZ) in the fifth game of a six-game series. Tonight is our final Fireworks Display of the year, as part of Marvel Super Heroes Night with a special jersey auction, thanks to Baker's Drive-Thrus. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com. VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the 29th of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the 14th of 15 at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 13-15 against the Rawhide in 2024, 6-7 here at home. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 7-5 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes saw their playoff hopes come to an end, as the Visalia Rawhide clinched a postseason berth with a 7-0 win over Rancho Cucamonga on Friday night at LoanMart Field. The Rawhide clubbed a pair of tworun homers (Ruben Santana and Angel Ortiz), while starting pitcher Casey Anderson (6-8) limited the Quakes to just two hits over five scoreless innings. Rancho starter Sterling Patick (0-1) suffered his first defeat, but only allowed one run over 2.2 innings of work. Rancho finished with just five hits, with Eduardo Quintero picking up two of them.

CONGRATS GOES OUT TO THE RAWHIDE: Last night's loss means the Quakes will miss the 2024 playoffs, the first time they'll miss the playoffs since 2022. Entering this series, the Quakes needed five of six in order to prevent the Visalia Rawhide from making the postseason. The playoffs will open next Tuesday in Visalia, as the Rawhide will host the First Half South Division Champion Lake Elsinore Storm in game one of the best-of-three. Games two and then three (if necessary) will take place in Lake Elsinore next Thursday and Friday, respectively. The North Division Playoffs are already set, as San Jose hosts Modesto next Tuesday in game one of the best-of-three.

TEAM LEADERS: With the season coming to an end on Sunday, let's look at the team leaders going into the final weekend of the 2024 season. Cameron Decker's homer on Thursday gives him a team-best 11, with Zyhir Hope at nine. Wilman Diaz has 54 RBIs to lead the team, with Decker now at 50 and Samuel Munoz at 49. Kendall George (currently on the Injured List) is the top base-stealer with 36. Carlos Rojas' .291 average is the highest average on the club, but he technically doesn't have enough plate appearances to qualify for the league's top-10. Kendall George is hitting .276 and is ninth in the league. George has also scored 76 runs, fifth in the league. On the pitching side, Sean Paul Linan and reliever Felix Cabrera each have six wins (tied for seventh in the league). Roque Gutierrez leads the team in strikeouts with 116 (fifth in the league). Cam Day's ERA of 4.68 is tops on the team and fifth in the league, while his innings pitched of 102.0 is seventh in the league. Noah Ruen's seven saves are fifth in the league.

LUKE FOX: Left-hander Luke Fox makes his 12th start for the Quakes and third against the Rawhide. In two games against Visalia, he's 0-0, while allowing one run on no hits over 4.2 innings of work. In his last game overall, he allowed one run on one hit over two innings in a no-decision at San Jose on August 1. Fox joined the Quakes in late-June from the Arizona Complex League, where he was 0-0 with an ERA of 0.00 over four games (two starts). Fox was a 17thround selection out of Duke in the 2023 draft.

DANIEL NUNEZ: Right-hander Daniel Nunez will make his 20th appearance and 11th start for Visalia, his third start against Rancho and fifth overall appearance. In three games against Rancho, he's 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA, allowing four runs on ten hits over 13 innings. In his last start, he allowed just one run on six hits over 6.2 innings in a win over Fresno on August 31. Nunez was signed by Arizona out of Mexico in December of 2023.
