LHP MASON ALBRIGHT (1-4, 6.99) vs. RHP Victor Mederos (5-5, 4.00)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 3-2 series advantage after holding on for a 9-7 win last night ... With the win yesterday, the Isotopes have won three of their last four and seven of 13. ... Mason Albright is expected to start for Albuquerque while Victor Mederos is slated to take the hill for the Bees.

SERIES: Albuquerque holds a 3-2 series lead for the fifth time on the season (last: May 27-31 vs. Sugar Land) and second occurrence against Salt Lake (other: April 1-5).

-With a win today, the Isotopes can claim their second series victory of the season (other May 27-June 1 vs. Sugar Land) and first in Salt Lake since taking three of five from April 24-18, 2019.

SAVES: Dugan Darnell earned his first save of the year last night and Albuquerque's 17th on the year (last: July 19 vs. Reno, Nick Anderson) ... The club's 17 saves on the year are the eight-fewest in the PCL ... Team has just six saves in the second-half of the season.

SWIPES: Albuquerque has swiped a base in six-straight games, tied for the longest streak of the season (also: July 1-6).

-Since July 1 (19 games, Braiden Ward's promotion to Albuquerque), the Isotopes have stolen 29 bags, the eighth-most in Triple-A and third-most in the PCL after swiping 56 in their first 80 games.

ROAD WOES: The Isotopes are 7-18 in their last 25 road games dating back to June 6 at El Paso ... The club has not won a series on the road since June 18-23, 2024, at OKC when they took four of six

XBH: The Isotopes were held to two extra-base hits last night, the 34th time with two or fewer in 2025, second-straight and eighth against the Bees.

BY WAY OF THE K: The Isotopes struck out 15 times last night, tied for the second-most on the season (also: June 17 at Tacoma).

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson extended his hit streak to nine games with two singles last night, his 23rd multi-hit contest of the year. During stretch is slashing .342/.405/5474 with two doubles, one homer and four RBI. ... One of 13 players in the PCL with at least 20 doubles and 10 home runs this season ... T-1st in triples (7) in the PCL.

-Over his last 53 games, is slashing .327/.414/.576 with 15 doubles, six triples, eight homers and 34 RBI., increasing batting average from .178 to .276.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk extended his hit streak to nine games with two knocks yesterday. During streak is slashing .361/.351/.611 with two doubles, two triples, one homer and five RBI.

-Has a hit in 16 of his last 17 games and is slashing .359/.353/.641 with three doubles, three triples, three homers and 15 RBI, with the only hitless night coming in one pinch-hit appearance ... Recorded his seventh game of 2025 with three-plus RBI (last: July 2 vs. El Paso, three).

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura went 2-for-4 Saturday with his 12th homer of the year and 20th multi-hit game of the season. Was his first homer since July 2 vs. El Paso and just his third extra-base hit of July. ... Has two homers in his last 18 games after hitting nine in previous 28.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard belted his ninth homer of the season yesterday and second in his last three games ... Has reached base in 47 of 50 games with the Isotopes in 2025 ... Connected on his 85th all-time home run in an Isotopes uniform Saturday (franchise record).

THE KID: Kyle Karros went 1-for-4 Friday and is 5-for-13 in last three games after going 2-for-15 in first four Triple-A games ... Has one extra-base hit (double) and a 7:4 K:BB ratio.

NEW GUY: Braiden Ward delivered his third multi-hit game with Albuquerque Friday (also: July 1-2 vs. El Paso) ... He also stole second base in the fifth inning, giving him at least one swipe in nine of 12 Triple-A contests. ... Has reached base in 10 of 11 Triple-A games with a plate appearance.

-Has 184 swipes since the beginning of 2022, third-most in MiLB during span (Chandler Simpson, 225 and Jonatan Clase, 192).

BRAX: Over Braxton Fulford's last 12 Triple-A games (dating back to May 29), is 20-for-44 with two doubles, six homers and 14 RBI. ... 23 of his 48 hits have gone for extra bases ... Has a five-game hit streak (9x17 with one double, two homers and five RBI.

VEEN, VEEN: Zac Veen went 1-for-4 Friday with an RBI ... Has a hit in 21 of his last 23 games, slashing .380/.442/.576 with five doubles, two triples, three homers and 18 RBI ... Has an active six-game hit streak (7x24).

IT'S DREW: Drew Romo is hitting .315 in July (17x54) after hitting .222 over first 22 contests ... Has 13 walks on the year (37 games) after drawing only 16 on 85 games last season.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
