**LAST OUTING:** Gasser spun another gem on June 18 vs. Gwinnett, pitching six scoreless innings in Nashville's walk-off win. He allowed just four hits, walked one and struck out six. He did not factor into the decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Gasser's second start against Norfolk, with 4/ the first coming on April 12 of this season. He allowed two earned runs over 5.1 innings and struck out seven, good for a 3.38 ERA.
