Racing 'Round the Bases... The 2026 Bowling Green Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 284 stolen bases. The Hot Rods swiped five bags in Tuesday night's setback against the Greenville Drive. Nine different Bowling Green players have delivered 20-plus steal campaigns.

In Pole Position... Infielder Tony Santa Maria logged his league-leading 53rd stolen base on Tuesday night. He ranks third in most single-season swipes in Bowling Green franchise history, trailing 2010's Ty Morrison (58) and 2013's Andrew Toles (62).

McCoy Mashesh... First baseman Ryan McCoy sparked Bowling Green's offense in Tuesday's 13-11 loss. McCoy belted his team-leading 24th double and added a game-tying three-run home run in the seventh inning. He enters Wednesday with a .972 OPS, second-best in the SAL only to Greensboro Grasshoppers' infielder Jared Jones.

Cermak Attack... Outfielder Ryan Cermak clubbed his sixth home run in his last 10 games on Tuesday night. Cermak leads Bowling Green with an .870 OPS, six home runs, 18 RBI, 23 runs scored and 12 walks drawn since returning to the Hot Rods on August 4.

Polanco's Presence... Infielder Narciso Polanco delivered his 28th multi-hit game of the season in Tuesday's contest. Polanco has tallied the second-most multi-hit games of any Hot Rods player (Nathan Flewelling, 29) this season. The 21-year-old leads Bowling Green with 112 games played this season following leading the 2025 Carolina League with 121 appearances last season.

Fireballer Fritton... LHP Dominic Fritton starts for the Hot Rods on the mound Wednesday night. The southpaw matched his Bowling Green-best seven strikeouts in his last outing against the Winston-Salem Dash on August 27. Fritton led the 2026 Carolina League with 111 strikeouts for the Charleston RiverDogs prior to his promotion.
