#### ROTONDO'S SLAM CARRIES CARDINALS TO DRAMATIC WIN: With

two outs in the bottom of the 9th inning and the Cardinals down 6-5, Chris Rotondo hit a grand slam to lift Springfield to a 9-6 win on Tuesday night at Hammons Field. Rotondo's slam capped a 6-run 9th for the Cardinals tying a season high for runs in an inning, and also extended his hitting streak to a season-high 8 games. Bryan Torres collected 3 hits to run his hitting streak to 8 games, and his multi-hit streak to 6 consecutive games. Jacob Buchberger also had 3 hits for the Cardinals, who have tallied double-digit hits in 8 of their last 9 games.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Carlos Duran** makes his 8th start of the season for the Drillers... Took the loss in his last start, allowing 2 ER on 6 H over 2.2 IP against Midland last Wednesday at ONE-OK Field...Started against the Cardinals at ONEOK Field on August 2 and took the loss allowing a run on 2 H with 7 K over 3.0 IP...Has not thrown more than 67 pitches in a start this season...Began the campaign with Low-A Rancho Cucamonga going 0-2 with a 4.61 ERA in 7 starts, striking out 22 while walking 11 over 13.2 IP...Opponents batted just .176 against him...Missed a month and a half with the Quakes (May 5-June 20) after making 5 starts to begin the season with the Quakes...Assigned to the Drillers on July 3...Did not pitch last season due to an elbow injury that required Tommy John surgery...Spent the 2022 season with High-A Great Lakes going 1-3 with a 4.25 ERA in 14 appearances (13 starts)...Spent most of the 2021 season in Rancho Cucamonga, his first full campaign...Made his stateside debut in 2019 in the ACL after pitching in the DSL in 2018...Signed with the Dodgers for \$300,000 as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018...23 years old



#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### **CARDS' RADIO HOME**



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**CARDIAC CARDS:** Over their last 7 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 5 of their last 7 games, Springfield is 6-1 during that time. The Cards scored 29 of their 53 (54.7%) runs in the 7th inning or later, and have outscored their opponents 25-7 in the 8th inning or later. Springfield has had big 9th innings in each of its last two games, totalling 11 runs in the 9th inning. **Chris Rotondo's** walk-off grand slam capped a 6-run bottom of the 9th inning on Tuesday night against the Drillers.

HITS, HITS: The top offense in the Texas League all season long, the Cardinals have turned up the temperature as the summer has worn on. Through 17 games in the month of August, Springfield is batting .297, the top mark in Double-A by 22 points (Erie SeaWolves, .275). The Cardinals have double-digit hits in 8 of their last 9 games and are batting .339 since August 10. For the season the Cards are batting .270, tops in Double-A, and have scored 593 runs, most in the Texas League.

The Cardinals have also already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 44 longballs in 46 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 66 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest SLG (.418) and OPS (.771) and has scored 13 more runs (254) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

**TORRES BRINGS HOME TLPOW HONORS:** For his performance last week in Frisco, Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the first time this season. Torres is the 2nd Cardinal to win the award this season; **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week for the week of April 15-21. **Cooper Hjerpe** earned Texas League Pitcher of the Week for June 17-23.

**Torres** had himself a week, batting .609 (14-for-23) with 2 2B, 4 RBIs and 8 runs scored against the RoughRiders. He added 3 BB and 2 SB and had a .654 OBP. **Torres'** week continues a red-hot month of August in which he is leading qualified Texas League hitters with a .450 batting average (27-for-60) with 3 2B and 8 RBIs while getting on base at a .514 clip. Torres went 3-for-5 on Tuesday night against the drillers, and is 21-for-37 (.568) during his 8-game hitting streak. He has tallied multiple hits in 6 straight games.

**CROOKS CATCHING FIRE:** Over his last 39 games dating back to June 23, the final day of the 1st half, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the Euless, TX native leads all qualified hitters in the circuit with a .371 average, 10 HR and 37 RBIs and is slugging a league-high .643 and with a 1.071 OPS. In his first 44 games of the season, **Crooks** batted .282 with 1 HR and a .786 OPS. He has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games and is batting .414 (24-for-66) with 4 HR and 18 RBIs over 15 games in August.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Among active, qualified hitters **Bryan Torres** (.328/.415) and **Jimmy Crooks** (.325/.415) are 1-2 atop the league in batting average and OBP, while **Crooks** leads the circuit in OBP, SLG (.514) and OPS (.929). **Torres** is 1st in hits (121) while **Nathan Church** is tied for the league lead in runs scored with 68.

SD LONG, KING: With Chandler Redmond's promotion to Triple-A Memphis on Wednesday, an era ended at Hammons Field. If Redmond's Springfield career is over, he finishes as the franchise leader in games played (341), HR (66), and RBIs (246). Redmond first joined the Cardinals in 2021 when he was promoted from Peoria and played in 32 games. He set both the home run and games played records this season.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 22-for-22 and his 45 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 22 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 20.0 IP (0.45 ERA) and is 12-for-12 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has been unscored upon over his last 17 appearances, allowing just 9 H with 14 K over his last 18.0 IP. The Cardinals are 47-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.


