TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club (Los Angeles Dodgers) will finish their six-game series on Sunday at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Express RHP Tim Brennan is scheduled to face Oklahoma City RHP Ben Casparius. First pitch is slated for 6:05 p.m. CT.

ANOTHER VICTORY

Round Rock held on for a 3-2 win on Saturday night in Oklahoma City. The Express have won three straight games over the Baseball Club. For the second consecutive night, the first run of the night came in the bottom of the fourth frame when a pair of Los Angeles Dodgers rehabbers combined to spark the offense. 3B Max Muncy doubled home CF Tommy Edman, who reached on a base hit to open the inning. Oklahoma City took a 1-0 advantage. Round Rock jumped out to a 2-1 lead in the top of the sixth. 1B Blaine Crim led off the inning with a solo blast to left field to even the game at one. A walk by LF Dustin Harris and a single by C Matt Whatley set up CF Kellen Strahm with runners on first and third. Strahm lined a base hit into right field that put the E-Train in front as Harris scored. Whatley gave the Express some insurance in the top of the eighth inning as his single allowed Harris to come home to increase the lead to 3-1. The Baseball Club clawed back to within one in the bottom of the eighth inning thanks to a sacrifice fly by RF Ryan Ward which drove in CF Drew Avans. RHP Owen White came in to shut the door for the E-Train. He recorded a four-out save and locked down the 3-2 win.

HERE COMES BRENNAN

Round Rock RHP Tim Brennan is scheduled to make his ninth start of the year on Sunday. He has allowed seven earned runs with eight walks in his last two starts and 4.1 innings. Brennan has induced eight double plays which is the most on the team despite only throwing 25.0 innings. Opponents are hitting .315 against him.

THE CRIM IS RISING

Round Rock 1B Blaine Crim has reached base in 32 consecutive games which is the longest active streak in the PCL and the second-longest streak among any player in the PCL this year. Sugar Land INF Shay Whitcomb owns the longest streak at 44 games from April 7-June 4. Crim has a hit in 29 of the 32 games. He now has an eight-game hitting streak. During the on-base streak, he is slashing .420/.411/.598 with eight doubles, four home runs, 19 runs scored, 20 RBI, 22 walks and 18 strikeouts.

WHATLEY! (SEINFELD VOICE)

Express C Matt Whatley finished 2-for-4 with an RBI on Saturday. He has reached base in eight consecutive games and has a hit in seven of his last eight. In his last 10 games he is slashing .324/.361/.618 with one double, three home runs, eight RBI, five runs scored, two walks and five strikeouts.

ROUGHRIDERS TO ROUND ROCK

RHP Ryan Garcia, LHP Robby Ahlstrom and INF Frainger Chavez have all come up big since joining the Express from Double-A Frisco. Garcia owns a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) in two starts while Ahlstrom has a 1.80 ERA (1 ER/5.0 IP) in his first three relief appearances. Chavez is 4-for-12 since joining the E-Train on Wednesday.

SERIES WIN?

With a win on Sunday, the E-Train can go 3-1 in their first four series since the All-Star break. They are 3.5 games back of the Salt Lake Bees for the second playoff spot.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
