**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels shut out the Erie SeaWolves, 6-0. **Bryan Brickhouse** worked six innings, allowing three hits with no walks and four strikeouts. **John Russell** posted two scoreless innings. **Chris Wright** finished the game with a 1-2-3 ninth, striking out two. All six Richmond runs scored on homers. **Diego Rincones** hit a three-run homer in the fourth inning. **Will Wilson** added a two-run shot in the fifth. **Sean Roby** hit a solo homer to center in the sixth, his 14th of the year. It was also his 11th homer at The Diamond this season, setting a new team record for homers at home in a single season.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the second series between the two teams this year. From April 20-24, the Flying Squirrels dropped four-of-six at UPMC Park in Erie. The two teams will meet again for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 13-18 to close the regular season. The Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves enter the game locked in a three-way tie for first place in the division with 16 games left to play before the end of the first half.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won seven-of-nine games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road at Akron, knocking the RubberDucks out sole possession of first place. The Flying Squirrels have won five series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 573 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 224 walks issued, but did not walk any batters on Wednesday. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 0.70 ERA (2 ER/25.2 IP) over the last eight games since May 31.

**THE SEAWOLVES** have gone 13-6 since May 19 but have dropped three-of-five. They are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron and Richmond. Erie has won each of its last three series against New Hampshire, at Bowie and at home against Harrisburg. On the year, the Erie pitching staff has a 3.63 ERA, which is second in the EL. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Dillon Dingler (3), Gage Workman (10), Wilmer Flores (14), Reese Olson (16), Parker Meadows (18), Andre Lipcius (24) and Austin Bergner (28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** takes the mound for his third Double-A start. In his Double-A debut against the Yard Goats on May 27 in Richmond, Harrison allowed two runs over 5.2 innings. With his debut, he became the youngest pitcher in Flying Squirrels history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history. Last time out, he allowed six runs over 3.2 innings in a loss at Akron in the first game of Friday's doubleheader. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 2 prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Markus Solbach makes his seventh Double-A start of the season. He last pitched on Friday against Harrisburg and allowed three runs over three innings. Solbach began the season with the SeaWolves and posted a 3.50 ERA in his first five starts. He was promoted to Triple-A Toledo for two appearances on May 21 and May 28, going 1-1 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), allowing three total runs. He was assigned back to the SeaWolves on June 1 ahead of last week's start against the Senators. Solbach was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins in 2011 as an international free agent from Germany. After being released in 2013, he pitched in the independent Frontier League with Windy City to start 2014 before joining the Arizona Diamondbacks organization as a free agent halfway through that season. He pitched again in independent baseball with Rockland of the Can-Am Association in 2016 and 2017 before signing with the Dodgers in 2019, reaching Double-A for the first time that year. He split 2021 between Double-A Tulsa and Triple-A Oklahoma City. Solbach signed with the Tigers as a free agent last November.

**#WINNING:** The Flying Squirrels have posted their best record in franchise history through 53 games at 30-23, ahead of the previous best of 29-24, which was set in 2013 and 2014. The Flying Squirrels' best start through 54 games is 30-24, which was set in 2013 and 2014 and can be surpassed with a win tonight.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (5,900) and rank second in total attendance (153,398). Richmond is 12th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 68 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (75). **Sean Roby** is tied for second in the league with 14 homers on the season, with 11 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 177 home runs.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** After opening the season hit .162 through May 26, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is batting .361 (13-for-36) with three homers, five doubles and seven RBIs over his last 10 games since May 27. On May 29, Fitzgerald homered twice and tied a single-game franchise record with five hits. He also set new single-game franchise records with five runs scored and 13 total bases. He hit his seventh home runs of the season in the second game of Friday's doubleheader at Akron.

**SHANE TRAIN:** Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .338 (26-for-77) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 17 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. Matheny is currently riding an 12-game hitting streak dating back to May 14, during which he is batting .400 (16-for-40). That streak is the longest active hit streak in the league and the second-longest overall in the EL this year, trailing only a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on Tuesday. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles.

**ARMANI ARRIVES:** **Armani Smith** hit .429 (6-for-14) with a triple and two walks in his four games played in last week's series at Akron. After going hitless in his Double-A debut on May 15, Smith has picked up at least one hit in nine-of-his-last-12 games played. During that 12-game span since May 17, Smith is batting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, a triple, three RBIs, six runs scored and five walks.

**MARTY PARTY:** Over his last 20 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .315 (23-for-73) with five homers, four doubles, three triples and 15 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer last Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win and drove in the go-ahead run in last Thursday's 8-4 win over the 'Ducks.

**TOASTY:** **Frankie Tostado** is batting .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs over his last 39 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 40 of his 48 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked first in batting average (.326), ninth in SLG (.513), tied for first in hits (61) and tied for third in total bases (96).

**ROBUST:** With his solo homer on Wednesday, **Sean Roby** moved into a tie for second in the EL with 14 home runs this season. He has hit 11 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. With two homers on May 29 against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking five in his last 10 games since May 26.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked first in batting average (.326), ninth in SLG (.513), tied for first in hits (61) and tied for third in total bases (96). **Sean Roby** is tied for second in home runs (14). **Brandon Martorano** is 10th in SLG (.522). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for third in saves (6). **Jake Dahlberg** is ninth in ERA (3.55) and second in winning percentage (.750). **Taylor Rashi** is tied for seventh in games pitched (18). **Kai-Wei Teng** and **Bryan Brickhouse** are tied for first in games started (11).

**WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK:** In the Eastern League, Kerry Carpenter is first in homers (20), first in RBIs (42), first in SLG (.706), first in OPS (1.088), first in extra-base hits (29), first in total bases (127), second in batting average (.322), second in runs scored (38) and third in hits (58). Quincy Nieporte is tied for fourth in homers (12) and eighth in SLG (.525). Gage Workman is tied for fifth in doubles (14) and tied for fifth in stolen bases (15). Andre Lipcius is fourth in walks (37). Dillon Dingler is tied for seventh in doubles (13).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
