WALKER HOMERS, ARIAS DRIVES IN THREE IN VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders shutout the San Antonio Missions on Saturday in a 4-0 victory from Nelson Wolff Stadium. The Riders (11-5) used six pitchers in the win. **Hans Crouse** started, throwing two perfect innings before **Hever Bueño** (2-0) entered and earned the win with two innings of his own. **Alex Speas** (0.2 innings), **Fernery Ozuna** (1.1), **Joe Gatto** (1.0) and **Cole Uvila** (2.0, save) then combined to finish the shutout out of the bullpen. On the offensive side, the Riders drew first blood in the first when Missions (7-10) starter Adrian Martinez (0-2) balked in **Bubba Thompson** for the game's first run in the first inning. In the fifth, **Diosbel Arias** plated **Elier Hernandez** on a sacrifice fly to make it 2-0. That score held until the ninth when Hernandez scored Thompson on an RBI groundout and **Steele Walker** came in on a wild pitch to advance the lead to 4-0.

LOCK IT, PUT IT IN YOUR POCKET:

The RoughRiders have been brilliant on the mound this season and it has showed in their record. In games in which the Riders are allowing two or fewer runs, Frisco is 10-0. Additionally, with the bullpen being as good as they have been early (2.90 bullpen ERA), when taking a lead into the eighth inning, Frisco is 9-0 this season. **Cole Uvila** threw two shutout innings in Saturday's game to earn his third save of the season.

TIMING IS EVERYTHING:

When the situation has been most dire, the Riders pitching staff has stepped up. With runners in scoring position this season, Frisco pitchers own the lowest opponent average (.188) in Double-A, while they are second in ERA (7.38) in Double-A. They have also limited the damage, allowing just two home runs on those situations, the lowest in the league. With RISP and two outs, the Riders also lead the Double-A Central in opponent average (.153) and ERA (5.94).

HOW A-DOROW-BLE:

Ryan Dorow has been a hit machine for the Riders at the beginning of this season. After going 0-for-4 with three strikeouts on Opening Day, Dorow has hit safely in his last 10 games, batting .459 (17-for-37)/.500/.757 (1.257 OPS) with five doubles, two home runs, nine RBIs and seven runs scored. Overall this season, his .415 average is first in the Double-A Central (third in all of Double-A) and his 1.205 OPS is third (sixth in Double-A). Dorow is also second in the league in doubles (5) and third in SLG (.683) and OBP (.455). This has been the best stretch of Dorow's career, breaking his longest hitting streak of nine games (June 14 to June 26, 2018). In that streak, he hit .432 (16-for-37) with a 1.056 OPS, 201 points lower than this streak.

WHIP IT REAL GOOD:

The Riders pitching staff has allowed very few baserunners this season and their WHIP (walks plus hits per inning pitched) stands at 1.08 as a team. That mark is the best in all of Double-A and fifth in Minor League Baseball. The Riders .181 batting average against is also first in Double-A and fifth in Minor League Baseball. They have walked the second-fewest batters (63) in the Double-A Central.

STARTING IT OFF ON A GOOD NOTE:

The Riders starting pitching has been incredible to start the 2021 campaign. Combined between **Jake Latz**, **Tyler Phillips**, **Cole Winn**, **Yerry Rodriguez**, **Hans Crouse** and **Tim Brennan**, the Riders starters over the last 10 games have just allowed four runs over 37.2 IP (0.96 ERA) while striking out 45 batters and just walking 13. During that stretch, the overall Riders starters' ERA has dropped from 6.11 to 2.60. Dating back to 5/9, Frisco starters have a 0.93 ERA, as Brennan went just one shutout inning in an abbreviated start. The Riders team ERA of 2.74 is first in Double-A and fourth in Minor League Baseball.

WHEN THE PITCHING GETS TOUGH, THE TOUGH GET PITCHING:

When the Riders have won this year, the pitching has been brilliant. In their 11 wins, the staff has just allowed 16 earned runs over 95 innings (1.52 ERA), including three shutouts and three one-run performances. In Frisco's five losses this year, the staff has allowed 30 earned in 57 innings (4.73 ERA).
