FRISCO WINS THRILLER ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders mounted a five-run comeback in the ninth inning, featuring a **Thomas Saggese** grand slam, and **Luisangel Acuña** walked off the San Antonio Missions with a 10th-inning single on Friday for an 8-7 win at Riders Field. The RoughRiders (21-27) put the first four batters aboard in the ninth inning. **Jax Biggers** doubled to lead off and scored after three free passes. Saggese came up with the bases loaded and launched his second grand slam of the season to tie the game at 7-7. The RoughRiders lead minor league baseball with seven grand slams this year. The Missions (26-23) stranded their designated runner at third base in the 10th inning with **Nick Starr** (3-2) holding the Missions off the board. Starr got a groundout, a strikeout and a flyout to keep the score tied and eventually earn the win. In the bottom of the 10th, **Chris Seise** pinch ran as the designated runner and advanced to third on a balk. **J.P. Martinez** was intentionally walked and Acuña grounded a ball to the left side for the walkoff single. It was the second walkoff win for Frisco this season. **Evan Carter** had the other walkoff hit on a seven-run comeback win for the RoughRiders on May 20, also with an 8-7 final score. Those 10th inning wins are the only two extra inning victories for Frisco this season. In the second inning, Frisco struck first on Biggers' two-run single that brought home **Nick Tanielu** and **Liam Hicks**. That snapped a streak of 20 scoreless innings for the RoughRiders, dating back to Tuesday. San Antonio countered with six runs in the fourth inning, including back to back home runs. The Missions added an insurance run in the 8th and kept the RoughRiders off the board for six consecutive innings until the ninth. Kevin Kopps (3-1) suffered his first loss of the season for San Antonio, having given up the grand slam and then the unearned run in the 10th when Seise scored. **Dustin Harris**, Biggers and Tanielu both had two hits for Frisco in the ball-game. Hicks walked twice and started at catcher, celebrating his 24th birthday. The RoughRiders snapped a four-game losing streak with the win.

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 13 games (5-8 record), Frisco has hit just three home runs while batting .218/.327/.290/.617. The three home runs (from **Liam Hicks**, **Trevor Hauver** and **Thomas Saggese**) are the fewest in the league over the last 13. The Riders are averaging just 3.6 runs per game over the last 13 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.8).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, leading the Texas League with a .647 average (11-for-17) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.608 OPS on the first pitch. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .538 (14-for-26) on the initial offering.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 21 bases in 45 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 50 steals, which would by far be a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just nine while stealing 71 bases (89 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on Friday. They are the only team with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.261 OPS with the bags full, which is second in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 30 games, he is hitting .344 (42-for-122)/.400/.525/.925 with eight doubles, a triple, four homers, 24 RBIs and 21 runs. In the month of May, he batted .344/.400/.496/.896 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. He has hit two grand slams this season. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .299 (52-for-174)/.372/.425/.797 through the first 41 games. Over his last 37 games, he is batting .314/.393/.455/.848. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (117).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 241 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 36 walks while **Evan Carter** is 10th in OBP (.404) in the league and third in the league with 32 walks.

ABOUT ROBY

-On his name Tekoah: Born in Hendersonville, North Carolina and, about two hours away in Georgia, there is a beautiful area named Toccoa Falls with waterfalls and outdoor activities. His parents were driving around there one day and liked the way it sounded, so they changed the spelling and named their son Tekoah.

-Originally committed to Troy University in Alabama.

-Paired a 7-3 record with a 1.19 ERA in his junior season at Pine Forest High School in Pensacola, Fla., earning the 2019 Pensacola News Journal Pitcher of the Year award...recorded 109 strikeouts against just 10 walks that season while contributing a .384 batting average and 28 RBI at the plate to lead Pine Forest to its first regional appearance in 12 years.

-Is one of several Texas minor leaguers enrolled in the club's 'RangersU Powered by ACU' program, which allows players and coaches to earn academic credit by taking online courses taught by Abilene Christian University faculty and staff in both English and Spanish.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 12 prospect in the Rangers system per MLB.com.

-Struck out seven over six innings on April 15th in San Antonio, allowing all four runs with two outs (two runs in the second inning and two runs in the sixth before he exited).

-Threw first quality start of the season on May 16th against Amarillo. He took a no-hitter into the seventh inning, retiring 18 in a row before an A.J. Vukovich triple and Deyvison De Los Santos home run ended his night. Frisco went onto win 3-2 when Dustin Harris lifted a go-ahead solo home run to start the eighth.

2022 SEASON

-Was one of the youngest starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League, pitching the entire season at the age of 20.

-Late in the season, he added a slider to give himself a true four-pitch mix.

-Led the Crawdads staff in innings pitched (104.2) and strikeouts (126).

-Over his first six starts, he allowed 23 runs (7.67 ERA), but rebounded to collect a 3.59 ERA over his last 16 games (15 starts), starting on May 24th.

-In his last five starts, Roby owned a 2.22 ERA (6 ER/24.1 IP), striking out 36 batters to just five walks.

-On August 19th, he threw an immaculate inning against Winston-Salem (nine pitches with three strikeouts).

2021 SEASON

-Made only six starts because of an elbow sprain in June, but did not have surgery.

-It was a proximal tear in the UCL, which heals easier than a distal tear without surgery.

-In six starts, struck out 38.9% of hitters (35 of 90) and held opponents to a .177 batting average against.
