McKEITHAN'S CAREER DAY LIFTS CARDS OVER TRAVS: Aaron McKeithan drove in a career-high 5 runs while going 3-for-4 and the Cardinals went 6-for-14 with runners in scoring position as Springfield topped the Arkansas Travelers 10-6 on Thursday night at Dickey-Stephens Park. Mike Antico and Nathan Church had two hits each, and RJ Yeager drove in his 6th run in as many games. The Cardinals scored 5 times in the top of 3rd inning, and starter Edwin Nuñez tied a career high with 4.0 IP allowing just one run. With the win the Cards take a 1.5 game lead on the Travs for first place in the North Division.



**OPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Juan Mercedes** makes his 11th start of the season for the Travelers...Last pitched on Friday, April 1 against the Sod Poodles in game 2 of a doubleheader and tossed a complete game allowing just 1 R on 4 H with 4 K in a 5-1 Arkansas win...Got the win against Springfield on April 26 allowing just 1 R on 4 H with 5 K over 5.2 IP...The Travs won the game 3-1...Did not pitch against the Cardinals in the season-opening series at Dickey-Stephens Park...Made 12 appearances (10 starts) for Arkansas last season and went 2-1 with a 6.60 ERA...Began the season with High-A Everett goign 1-0 with a 3.43 ERA in 4 starts...Two stints on the IL last season...Pitched across 3 levels in 2022, spending time at every full-season affiliate besides Arkansas...Put together a 7-11 record with a 4.59 ERA over 26 apppearances (22 starts)...Made his full-season debut with the Low-A Modesto Nuts and went 7-4 with a 5.54 ERA in 34 relief appearances...Signed by the Mariners as an International Free Agent in 2017 out of the Dominican Republic...24 years old

CARDS AND TRAVS SQUARE OFF IN CRUCIAL SIX-GAME SERIES: The Cardinals make their second and final trip to North Little Rock this week for a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners). Just a half game separates the two clubs coming into the series with 18 games remaining in the first half. The Cards swept a 3-game series at Dickey-Stephens Park to start the season.



#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

**RDAD WARRIDRS:** The Cardinals have been more than solid on the road this season, going 19-10 away from Hammons Field. The Cards have a 3.82 ERA on the road, the 2nd best road ERA in the league behind Midland's 3.42, compared to a 5.80 mark at home.

**HITS, HITS:** For the greater part of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have owned the top hitting offense in Double-A with a .272 batting average, 7 points better than any other team in the level. The Cards have 12 more hits than any other Double-A team with 485 ahead of the Montgomery Biscuits with 473.

**Nathan Church** leads the Texas league in hits with 61, and **Bryan Torres** ranks 3rd with 56.

**CARDS CHASING STARTERS:** During the first 9 games of their road trip, opposing starting pitchers are having a tough time against the Springfield lineup. The Cards have scored 28 runs in 38 innings against opposing starters since last Tuesday, giving them a 6.16 ERA over an average of 4.1 IP per start. In this series against Arkansas, the Cards have scored 9 runs in just 4.1 innings combined over the last two games against starting pitchers. Over their previous 7 games the Travelers had 0.92 ERA, but the Birds have scored 16 R (14 ER) over the last two games raising the Travs ERA during their homestand to 2.34.

**GRINDIN':** Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 3rd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 384 whiffs in 54 games. The only teams with fewer strikeouts than Springfield are the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (368 K in 54 games) and Frisco RoughRiders (384 K). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game.

**POWER OUTAGE:** While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. The Cards have not hit a home run in any of their last 10 games, and have hit just one longball over their last 13 contests, and 2 homers over their last 15. Springfield's last home run came on Saturday, May 25: a two-run shot by **Mike Antico** off **Orlando Ortiz-Mayr** of the Tulsa Drillers at Hammons Field. The Birds have the 2nd-fewest longballs in the Texas League with 30 on the season.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Over their last 12 games the Cards have a team ERA of 3.18, 3rd in the Texas League during that time. During their current road trip, Springfield sports an ERA of 2.85.

**BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL PLAGUING CARDS STAFF:** So far in 2024, home runs and the big inning have hurt the Birds. Springfield has surrendered 36 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs. In those 36 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 140 of the 275 total runs scored by the opposition, 50.9% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. Springfield has allowed that production in just 7.9% of their innings pitched. In the other 424.2 IP Springfield has allowed 135 runs, which comes out to 2.86 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 23-4 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning". The Birds have not allowed a "big inning" in 8 of their last 9 games.

The Cardinals have also allowed 50 homers in 54 games this season, most in Double-A.

McKEITHAN BANGS UP TRAVS: Cardinals catcher Aaron McKeithan has saved his best for the Travelers so far in 2024. After driving in a career-high 5 runs on Thursday night, McKeithan is now batting .409 (9-for-22) against Arkansas this season with a home run and 8 RBIs. He's been even better at Dickey-Stephens Park going 6-for-12 with a home run and all 8 RBIs in just 3 games.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 206.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 23 straight games without a home run.




