SEA DOGS BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN Two five-run innings propelled the Sea Dogs over the Yard Goats last night, 10-1. The Yard Goats were first to strike in the bottom of the first inning. After a leadoff walk issued to Zach Veen, he scored on a fielder's choice and Hartford led, 1-0. The Sea Dogs then would score five runs in the fourth inning. Kristian Campbell drove home the tying run with an RBI single to left field then Eddinson Paulino brought home two more runs with a single to right field and Portland led, 3-1. Phillip Sikes then lined a two-run double to left field and the Sea Dogs continued to lead, 5-1. Portland would strike again in the top of the sixth inning. Elih Marrero led off the inning with a double then Campbell worked a walk. Paulino then drove home Marrero and the Sea Dogs led, 6-1. Alex Binelas drilled a two-run triple to left field further extending Portland's lead, 8-1. Paulino came home on a balk. Tyler McDonough then hit a sacrifice fly to left field and Portland continued to lead, 10-1.

TURNING THE PAGE Until last night, the Sea Dogs were 0-9 on the road when the opposing team scored first. Despite Hartford scoring in the first inning, Portland was still able to score 10 runs en route to the win.

BULLPEN STAYS STRONG The Yard Goats scored their only run of the game in the first inning. Robert Kwiatkowski, Wyatt Olds and Brendan Cellucci combined for 6.0 shutout relief innings. Kwiatkowski earned his eighth win of the season with 2.0 shutout innings with two strikeouts. Olds and Cellucci each pitched 2.0 innings while Olds struck out three and Cellucci fanned four in his 2.0 perfect innings.

TOP DOGS With the win last night over Hartford, the Sea Dogs are now tied with the Somerset Patriots for the top spot in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League. Binghamton is in second place, 1.5 games out of first.

BEST IN DOUBLE-A The Portland Sea Dogs currently lead all teams in Double-A in five offensive categories. They lead the level in average (.266), doubles (186), on-base percentage (.354), slugging percentage (.429) and OPS (.783).

TRIO OF SEA DOGS HEADING TO TEXAS For the second straight season, the Portland Sea Dogs have three current players selected to the All-Star Futures Game. Marcelo Mayer, Roman Anthony and Kyle Teel will participate in the prestigious event that will take place on Saturday, July 13th at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Marcelo Mayer becomes part of an elite group of players with his second selection to the Futures Game, after participating in 2023. He is the first player in Sea Dogs history to be selected to the Futures Game roster twice. He has been among the offensive leaders in the Eastern League all season and currently leads in average (.307), doubles (25), extra-base hits (32) and runs (54). Roman Anthony is the #2 Red Sox prospect and is ranked as the #14 prospect in MiLB. Anthony currently ranks sixth in the Eastern League in walks (36) and extra-base hits (26). Kyle Teel is the #3 prospect in Boston's system and is the #25 prospect in MiLB. Among the past Sea Dogs participants of the Futures Game include Kevin Youkilis (2003), Hanley Ramirez (2005), Clay Buchholz (2007), Will Middlebrooks (2011), Rafael Devers (2017), Jarren Duran (2019), Brayan Bello (2021), Ceddanne Rafaela (2022), Nick Yorke (2023) and Shane Drohan (2023).

HISTORICALLY AGAINST HARTFORD This week will mark the fourth and final meeting between the Yard Goats and the Sea Dogs this season. Currently, Portland owns a 7-9 record against Hartford this season and a 71-94 record all-time. Portland is 3-4 against the Yard Goats at Dunkin' Park after visiting Hartford April 23rd-28th.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY July 12, 2013 – Ryan Dent became the second position player in franchise history to earn a win, working two scoreless on two hits. Portland scored three in the 15th to win at Binghamton 8-5.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP Wikelman Gonzalez will start for the Sea Dogs tonight. He last pitched on July 4th at New Hampshire and tossed 3.0 shutout innings allowing one hit while walking two and striking out three. It was his second straight shutout start for the Sea Dogs. Gonzalez has faced the Yard Goats once. On April 28th, he pitched 5.0 innings allowing two runs on one hit while walking one and striking out a season-high eight batters.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

Recognized by the Red Sox as the organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Year. Went 9-4 with a 3.96 ERA (49 ER/11.1 IP) and a .190 opponent AVG in 25 starts between High-A Greenville (15 GS) and Double-A Portland (10 GS). Led Minor League Baseball (min. 100.0 IP) with 13.58 SO/9.0 IP and a 35.2% strikeout rate (168 SO in 111.1 IP). Named an MiLB.com Organization All-Star. Recorded 10+ SO in a start 4 times, including a career-high 12 SO on 5/27 at Rome. Began the season with Greenville and went 0-2 with a 15.58 ERA, 3.00 WHIP, and .294 opponent AVG in 4 April starts (8.2 IP, 15 ER, 10 H, 16 BB). In 10 starts during May and June, went 6-0 with a 2.55 ERA, 1.11 WHIP, and .175 opponent AVG (49.1 IP, 14 ER, 31 H, 24 BB). Won 4 consecutive starts from 6/10-30 (1.29 ERA, 21.0 IP, 3 ER, 10 H, 8 BB, 36 SO)...Struck out 10 batters in consecutive outings on 6/23 at Bowling Green and 6/30 at Asheville. Promoted to Portland on 7/14... Allowed 4 ER in 2.2 IP on 8/19 at Binghamton, but posted a 1.77 ERA (9 ER/45.2 IP) in his other 9 outings with the Sea Dogs.

Is in his 6th professional season. Added to the Sox'40-man roster on 11/14/23. Ranked by Baseball America as the Red Sox' No. 7 prospect and top pitching prospect...Also rated by BA as having the best curveball in the organization. Also ranked by Baseball America as a top Sox prospect entering 2022 (No. 13) and 2023 (No. 12). Has struck out 30.4% of batters faced (399 of 1,312) and averaged 11.63 SO/9.0 IP in his minor league career. Has twice been named his league's Pitcher of the Week: Carolina League (8/18-14/22) and Eastern League (7/17-23/23). Participated in the Red Sox Rookie Development Pro- gram in January 2024... The program included 2 workouts daily, seminars focused on assimilation into Major League life on and off the field, an RBI clinic with the Red Sox Foundation, and a visit to Boston Children's Hospital. Attended Red Sox Winter Weekend in January 2024, signing autographs and posing for pictures with fans.


