LAST GAME

The Baysox fell 11-2 to the Altoona Curve on Wednesday night. Altoona scored three runs in the top of the first inning to get out to an early lead. Matt Gorski and Jacob Gonzalez each notched a sacrifice fly RBI while Drew Maggi hit an RBI double against Bowie starter Cade Povich. The southpaw would go four frames and allow no further damage, but the Curve would open the game up against the Baysox bullpen. The top of the sixth saw Altoona send all nine batters to the plate and score five runs to take an 8-0 lead, helped out in part by one of three errors on the night for Bowie. The Curve tacked on a run in the seventh and two more unearned runs in the eighth off another Baysox error, as Maggi, Gorski, Gonzalez, and Liover Peguero all had two RBI nights for Altoona. The only offense for the Baysox came in the bottom of the sixth, when Heston Kjerstad singled home Billy Cook, before getting caught in a rundown that allowed Coby Mayo to score. The nine-run defeat marked Bowie's largest of the season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter the week with a record of 16-17. Altoona currently sits fourth in the Southwest division standings - just two games out of first place. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.127 - 1st), on-base percentage (.464 - 1st), slugging (.663 - 1st), batting average (.316 - 3rd), home runs (9 - 3rd), and extra-base hits (15 - 5th). Davis' on-base percentage also leads all of Double-A, while his OPS is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona sends right-hander Aaron Shortridge to the hill this evening. Shortridge has shown high-contact numbers through his first seven appearances (six starts) of the season, with 16 runs (14 earned) off 29 hits, compared to 11 walks and 21 strikeouts in 31.2 innings. Still, the right-hander is coming off his best start of 2023, where he fired six shutout frames against Akron on Friday, surrendering just four hits and one walk. Shortridge also had a successful outing against Bowie back on April 23, where he fired six innings, allowing just two runs (one earned) on four hits and three walks and a pair of strikeouts. In that inning, Shortridge allowed both runs on three hits and a walk in the first inning, but only allowed three baserunners the rest of the game, facing just one over the minimum thanks to two double plays. His second season in Altoona after throwing 55.1 innings for the Curve in 2022, Shortridge has allowed 12 earned runs in 5.2 innings across his two starts at Prince George's Stadium (19.05 ERA). Originally a fourth round pick of the Pirates back in 2018 out of Cal, Shortridge features a fastball in the low-to-mid-90s, along with a slider and changeup.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 49 hits and a .383 average - 54 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hit a scorching .423 in the month of May with a .464 on-base percentage. He has collected hits in 12 of his 13 games this month, and has 15 multi-hit games in his first 32 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.428), along with fourth in OPS (.967).

HOBBLING AT HOME

The Baysox enter this week sporting the worst home record in the Eastern League at 6-13. Bowie has been outscored 109-75 at Prince George's Stadium this season. The struggles stem, in part, from the pitching staff, who sports a 4.71 ERA at home, compared to a 3.30 ERA away from home. Bowie arms have also surrendered the second-most long balls in home contests this season. 29 of the staff's 39 home runs have been conceded at home.

TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.15 ERA with 155 strikeouts in 143 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 7.00 ERA, with only 48 strikeouts in 54 innings.

BOLSTERING THE BULLPEN

Despite the struggles with tandems the Baysox have had this season, the short relievers have been quite effective for Bowie. Among arms used strictly as relievers this season, the Baysox have a 3.51 ERA. In addition, four of the five lowest ERAs on the staff come from short relievers, with three of them yet to allow an earned run this season (RHPs Wandisson Charles, Conner Loeprich, and Jensen Elliott). In total, four Baysox relievers have an active scoreless streak of at least four appearances (and six innings) - Charles, Elliot, Loeprich, and Tyler Burch.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts.
