# RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (36-25) Inland Empire 66ers (17-44)





RHP Aidan Foeller (2-2, 4.68 ERA) vs. LHP Francis Texido (1-5, 5.88 ERA)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes continue a six-game road trip with the fifth game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels). The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on June 17th, when they host the Lake Elsinore Storm as part of the final home stand of the first half. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 17th of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the 11th of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. The Quakes have taken five of six in both series so far against the 66ers. After taking three of four in this set, they have a 13-3 mark against the 66ers, In 2024, Rancho went 10-2 at San Manuel Stadium, 17-7 overall. LAST GAME: The Quakes clinched the South Division First Half Crown with their third straight win overall, a 6-3 victory over the Inland Empire 66ers at San Manuel Stadium on Friday night. Samuel Munoz ripped a solo homer to break a 2-2 tie in the sixth, putting the Quakes ahead to stay against Inland Empire starter Chris Clark (1-6). The Quakes outhit the 66ers for the first time in the series (nine to eight) and got two each from Munoz and Eduardo Guerrero. Rancho reliever Samuel Sanchez (1-0) fired three scoreless, hitless innings and was credited with the win.

**FIRST HALF SOUTH DIVISION CHAMPS:** After stumbling a bit over the last two weeks with an eight-game losing streak while both Visalia and Lake Elsinore were in the middle of seven-game win streaks, respectively, the Quakes put all doubt behind them by wrapping up the First Half South Division with Friday's win over the 66ers. The Quakes will now return to the playoffs for the first time since 2023, when they were swept in the Cal League Championship series by Modesto. With 2025 marking their final year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers, the Quakes will have qualified for the playoffs in nine of the 14 seasons (2011, 2013, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2025). Rancho has won three Championships in franchise history (1994, 2015 and 2018) with the last two coming as a Dodgers' affiliate. This will mark the second time in five seasons they'll make it to the playoffs under Manager John Shoemaker.

**CLEAN SWEEP OF MONTHLY AWARDS:** The Quakes have continued their dominance of California League awards in 2025, as a pair of Quakes were honored last week. OF Eduardo Quintero was named the Player of the Month for May, while RHP Christian Zazueta was named Pitcher of the Month. Quintero's May was outstanding, as he batted .391 and led all of minor league baseball in hits (43). He led the league in doubles (10), triples (4), RBIs (28), stolen bases (15), slugging (.718) and OPS (1.195). Zazueta went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA in six starts. His 31 strikeouts over 30 innings led the league. Sean Paul Linan was named April's Cal League Pitcher of the Month, before heading to High-A AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his 12th start and 13th appearance, his third against Inland Empire. In two starts against the 66ers, he's 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA, allowing four earned runs on seven hits over 10.0 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs (three earned) on three hits with three walks over three innings in a no-decision against San Jose on June 8th. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern

FRANCIS TEXIDO: Francis Texido makes his 13th start and his third against the Quakes. In two starts against the Quakes, he's 0-2 with an 8.59 ERA, allowing nine runs (seven earned) on eight hits over 7.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run without allowing a hit over 6.1 innings in a no-decision at Visalia on June 8th. Last year, Texido made 25 appearances (24 starts), going 4-7 with a 6.77 ERA for Inland Empire. Texido signed with the Angels in March of 2023 out of Havana, Cuba.
