E-TRAIN'S WILD WALK-OFF

Round Rock came back for a wild 5-4 win in 10 innings on Sunday. The Comets got on the board in the seventh as RF Esteury Ruiz hit a solo home run, putting Oklahoma City ahead 1-0. In the eighth, the Comets loaded the bases with a pair of singles and a walk. SS Alex Freeland snuck a single through the left side scoring CF Justin Dean from third and extending the lead to 2-0. Comets LF Steward Berroa led off the ninth with a double and moved to third on 1B Kody Hoese's single. 2B Austin Gauthier hit a sacrifice fly allowing Berroa to tag and score from third. With two down in the bottom of the ninth, 1B Blaine Crim belted his ninth home run of the year and the game was tied at three heading into the 10th. Okey started the 10th on second for the Comets and moved to third on Ruiz's single. Freeland grounded into a double play and Okey scored the go-ahead run to make it 4-3. SS Cody Freeman opened the bottom of the 10th on second. The Express loaded the bases with a walk and a single. With two outs, DH Kellen Strahm lined a base hit through the right-side sending Freeman and Ornelas around to complete the comeback and tie the series with a 5-4 walk-off win.

DANE TOES THE SLAB

Express RHP Dane Dunning is set to make his eighth appearance and seventh start for the Express on Tuesday night. Dunning owns a 1-1 record and a 7.88 ERA (21 ER/24.0 IP). He threw 2.1 innings against Oklahoma City on May 16. He allowed three earned runs on three hits, two walks and one strikeout in a loss. The righty resides in Charlotte in the offseason.

NICE TO SEE YA, OWEN

Charlotte starter RHP Owen White is set to face his old team tonight. White appeared in 42 games with 27 starts for the Express over the 2023-2024 seasons. He owned a 5.41 ERA (91 ER/151.1 IP) over his two seasons. White appeared in five games over 2023-2024 with Texas and was given his World Series ring prior to a game at Dell Diamond last season.

CAN'T BEAT CRIM

INF Blaine Crim hit a game tying homer on Sunday for his ninth bomb of the season. Crim ranks seventh in the PCL in RBI (31) despite appearing in six fewer games than five of the players in front of him. He is also seventh in the league in slugging (.543). Crim's average exit velocity of 92.5 is the second-highest in the PCL (min. 100 PA).

DE GOTI'S GETTING HOT

INF Alex De Goti slashed .353/.368/.529 in six games against Oklahoma City last week. He was 6-for-17 with a homer, five RBI, a run scored, one walk and five strikeouts. De Goti notched a walk-off single in the 10th inning on Thursday.

THIS IS NEW

Round Rock will play Charlotte for the first time in club history on Tuesday. The Express went 5-1 against Toledo last month. They will go to St. Paul from August 19-24 to wrap up interleague play.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
