LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones finished the series in Jersey Shore with a win on Sunday, 5-2, to earn a series split against the BlueClaws...LF Ryan Clifford saw his seven-game hitting streak come to an end but walked a career-high four times while scoring three of Brooklyn's five runs...Clifford was not the only batter with a keen eye, as Jersey Shore pitching issued II walks in the contest, the most since April 7, 2023...RHP Brandon Sproat pieced together a third straight strong outing to begin his season, hurling three innings of one-run ball, while punching two and walking one...In three outings this season, Sproat has not allowed more than one run in any of them...The former Florida Gator has given up just seven hits across 9.2 innings of work.

CANARSIE'S OWN: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer returns to his native Brooklyn to start a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday, recovering ...The 23-year-old grew up in the Canarsie neighborhood, roughly 10 miles northeast of Maimonides Park...Palmer also attended Holy Cross High School in Flushing, Queens, approximately five miles east of Citi Field...The right-handed swinger has appeared in at least one game with Brooklyn each season since 2021 and enters the day as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (200), runs scored (100), walks (107), stolen bases (48), and hit-bypitches (17).

CLIFF NOTES: IB/OF **Ryan Clifford** enters Tuesday's matchup on a personal and team season-high 12-game on-base streak...His on-base streak stretches since April 9...During that span, Clifford is 11-for-38 (.289) with five extra-base hits — including a home run — four RBI, and 11 walks...He holds a 21.6% walk rate and a 179 wRC+ during the stretch...While his seven-game hit streak was snapped on Sunday, the 20-year-old also worked a franchise-record-tying four walks in the victory...The feat was also accomplished twice last season by 3B **Jaylen Palmer** (4/7 vJS) and LF **Rhylan Thomas** (8/23 @ASH)...Clifford enters play tied with teammate INF **William Lugo** and one other for second in the South Atlantic League in walks (12).

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP Nolan McLean has been a revelation for the Cyclones so far in 2024...The 22-year-old has picked up at least one extra-base hit in all five games he has appeared as a position player...At the dish, McLean is 7-for-20 (.350) with six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...On Saturday, the Willow Springs, N.C. native registered a career-high three hits — including a pair of doubles — and an RBI...Offensively, McLean enters the day tied for sixth in the South Atlantic League with six extra-base knocks, despite at least 23 fewer plate appearances than any of the players tied or ahead of him...The former Oklahoma State Cowboy tossed 3.1 shutout innings in his first start and has punched out six over 6.0 total innings, thus far.

WALK IT OUT: The Cyclones coaxed a season-high 11 walks in their 5-2 victory over Jersey Shore on Sunday afternoon...The 11 free passes are tied for the third most in a single game in franchise history...Brooklyn earned 12 walks in a 7-4 win vs. Vermont on August 11, 2016, and matched the mark in their 9-8 triumph vs. Jersey Shore in 11 innings on Opening Day, April 7, 2023.

HIT 'EM UP: Brooklyn's offense erupted for a season-best nine runs on 14 hits in Saturday's 9-7 victory over Jersey Shore...The Cyclones' previous high-water marks were six runs and nine hits in Thursday's 6-4 win...Brooklyn's nine tallies were the most for the franchise in a single game since a 13-12 victory at Asheville last August 24...The 14-knock performance was the Cyclones' best since a 15-hit effort in an 11-9 loss in 10 innings vs. Wilmington on July 25, 2023...That contest was also the last time Brooklyn registered 9+ runs and 14+ hits in the same game.

WIZARD OF OS: C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Friday, the 25-year-old reached base four times thanks to an error and went 2-for-3 at the dish with a double, a walk... Osborn has reached base safely in all seven games he's played, hitting 409 (9-22) with a 1.155 OPS and adding two doubles, a home run, and three RBI... Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 25 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in on-base percentage (.519) and OPS (1.155).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Tuesday's series opener 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is three steals shy of matching IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**'s (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for eighth across the Minors for swipes (115)... He broke INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn opens their first two-week homestand of the season against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess three of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Daylen Lile (11), INF Kevin Made (24), and INF T.J. White (28)...Wilmington swept a three-game season-opening set against Brooklyn, winning the last two games on walk-offs from OF Jared McKenzie...In 30 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 16-14 record against Wilmington, but just a 9-9 record at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones were 7-5 last year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...Including 2024, the 'Clones are 42-41 (.506) all-time against the 'Rocks.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Jordany Ventura, Sean Reid-Foley, Justin Lawson, and Ben Simon united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in Sunday's walk-off victory...RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Josh Hejka, Dakota Hawkins, and Joshua Corneilly also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday... The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 95 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Álvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

HOME OPENER: The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule last Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years... The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs. Aberdeen...RHP John Gant (5.0 IP), RHP Tim Peterson (2.2), and LHP John Mincone (1.1) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, Dariel, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, José, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, Héctor, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (11th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)... MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

player on the Brooklyn Cyclones roster and is expected to serve as a designated hitter on weekends during the season...At the plate this season, the 22-year-old has picked up an extra-base hit in all five games played...He is 7-for-20 (.350) with a six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...In his professional career, McLean is 9-for-36 (.250) at the plate with a four doubles, three home runs, and seven RBI.

PROSPECT RADAR: McLean enters the 2024 campaign as one of the top prospects in the New York Mets farm system...The 22-year-old is considered New York's No. 15 prospect per *Baseball America* and No. 19 by MLB Pipeline.

SPRING BREAKOUT: The Willow Springs, N.C. native earned the win pitching in relief for the New York Mets prospects in their contest against the Washington Nationals' farmhands on Friday, March 15...McLean came on in support of former Cyclone RHP **Blade Tidwell** in the top of the fifth...The right-hander did not allow a run on one hit, did not walk a batter, and struck out a batter...Tossed only 10 pitches (7 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Brandon Sproat** to start the sixth in the Mets' 4-2 win.

COWBOY UP: The second-year pro had a tremendous career at Oklahoma State before departing...ln 2023, McLean served predominantly as a relief pitcher, posting a 1-2 record with a 3.30 ERA (11 ER in 30.0 IP) and six saves, tallying 34 strikeouts...As a hitter, he collected a .250/.379/.532 line with a .911 OPS, nine home runs and 29 RBI...McLean was a Perfect Game/Rawlings Second Team All-American in 2022 and was a member of the Oklahoma State football team as a quarterback in 2020.

TWO TIMES: McLean was drafted for the second time last summer, as the New York Mets chose him with the 91st-overall pick...The right-hander was also selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oklahoma State University, but did not sign... Joined teammate RHP **Brandon Sproat** as two of three players selected in the top 10 rounds that did not sign.

FAMILIAR FACES: While at the Oklahoma State University, McLean spent the summer of 2021 pitching for the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League... During that time, the right-hander was teammates with current Cyclones RHP **Brandon Sproat** and former Brooklyn RHP **Kolby Kubichek** and C **Kevin Parada**.
