Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, open up the second half with the fourth game in a six-game series at the Quad Cities River Bandits, High-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, the only meetings between the clubs this year. The Nuts opened the series (and closed the first half) with two wins in the first three games.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, River Bandits 4 (10 innings). Quad Cities was eliminated from West Division contention by a Cedar Rapids doubleheader sweep in Beloit, then fell in extra innings on a Joshua Kuroda-Grauer RBI groundout. Native Iowan Grant Judkins tossed six innings of three-hit, two-run ball in a no-decision for Lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and River Bandits play through Sunday, the Nuts enjoy a day off on Monday and return home to welcome in the Dayton Dragons from Tuesday, June 24, through Sunday, June 29, at Jackson Field. The Lugnuts won five of six games in Dayton earlier this month.

Happy Birthday! Today is **T.J. Schofield-Sam's** 24th birthday, one of four Lugnuts celebrating their birthday this month. (**Ryan Lasko** is next, celebrating his 23rd birthday in four days.) Schofield-Sam shares his birthday with Carlos Lee, Kendrys Morales, Paul Beeston and Hall of Famer Cum Posey.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts have six of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 A's prospects: No. 8 prospect (Tommy White), No. 11 (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer), No. 13 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Ryan Lasko), No. 18 (Rodney Green, Jr.) and No. 28 (Nate Nankil). Overall, 21 of the 30 prospects have seen time in Lansing.

First Things First: The Nuts' 36-30 first half record compared to prior seasons: 32-33 in 2024, 31-34 in 2023, 25-41 in 2022, 29-31 in 2021, 32-37 in 2019, and - in the club's most recent successful season, 43-27 in 2018. Second half records: 37-33 in 2018, 36-34 in 2019, 29-31 in 2021, 29-36 in 2022, 29-37 in 2023, 27-39 in 2024.

A Look at the Second Half: With the second half of the Midwest League season starting today, the Lugnuts will battle Great Lakes, Dayton, Lake County and Fort Wayne for the second East Division playoff berth while the River Bandits compete against Peoria, Beloit, Wisconsin and South Bend. Breaking down the 66 games remaining for Lansing: 36 games will be on the road, 30 at home; only nine games will be against the West (three at QC, six at home vs. Cedar Rapids) while 57 will be against the East (18 vs. Dayton, 12 at Great Lakes, 12 vs. Lake County, nine vs. West Michigan, six vs. Fort Wayne).

Division Domination: With yesterday's victory, the Lugnuts improved to 15-6 vs. West Division teams this season (5-1 at Wisconsin, 5-1 vs. South Bend, 2-1 at Quad Cities and 3-3 vs. Beloit) compared to 21-24 vs. East Division teams. The Nuts will not play Peoria this season.

Ladies and Gentlemen... Your American League Rookie of the Year: Athletics shortstop Jacob Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023, collected his 100th and 101st (his 9th HR) base hits of the year yesterday, tying Aaron Judge for the Major League lead. Wilson ranks 2nd in the Majors in batting average (.359), trailing only Judge.

Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam ranks 1st in MiLB with a .354 batting average; closer Mark Adamiak is tied for 1st in MiLB in saves (11); 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump is tied for 1st with 2021 Lugnut Jack Cushing in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut Colby Thomas (currently with Triple-A Las Vegas) ranks atop the minors in total bases (157), runs batted in (65) and extrabase hits (36). Thomas led MiLB in extra-base hits last year with 80.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam went 2-for-5 with two singles last night, giving him a league-leading 80 base hits this season. He also ranks 2nd in OPS (.953), 1st in total bases (118), 2nd in OBP (.431), 3rd in slugging (.522), tied for 4th in triples (4) and 4th in runs scored (43).

The Men in the Pen: The Nuts have four of the most heavily used relievers in the league. Blaze Pontes leads the league with 23 appearances, Mark Adamiak is tied for 2nd with Hunter Breault with 22 appearances, and Yehizon Sanchez is tied for 5th with 21 appearances.

Welcome Back to the QC: Outfielder Jared Dickey was drafted by the Kansas City Royals in the 11th round in 2023 from Tennessee, played 82 games for the River Bandits in 2024, was traded to the Athletics at the deadline last year, and returned to Quad Cities last August to slug his 10th home run of the season. Dickey, tied for 5th in the MWL in walks (40), has supplied extra-base hits in the ninth inning in each of the first three games of the series: an RBI triple on Tuesday, a two-run double on Wednesday, and a double last night.

History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 76-82 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 41-37 at home and 35-45 in Davenport.

After not meeting up at all in 2021 and 2022, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played 12 games against one another in 2023. Lansing went 7-5, 3-3 in QC.

Last year, the Nuts went 2-4 at Quad Cities, held in late August. Future Royal Jac Caglianone went 6-for-25, .240, .589 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts. The Nuts batted .188 and scored 20 runs in the series.

June 20th in Lugnuts History

1997: José Amado changed dugouts, going from Seattle-affiliated Wisconsin to Kansas City-affiliated Lansing, as the Mariners acquired Rusty Meacham from the Royals. Amado immediately became the Lugnuts' starting third baseman and a key part of the offense.

2010: The Lake County Captains (the eventual league champions) clinched the Eastern Division title on the final day of the first half, thanks to SS Casey Frawley's walk-off home run off Brian Slover, 3-2. Weird Lugnuts stat: The Nuts collected nine hits and one walk, plus Lake County committed an error, yet they only had two at-bats with runners in scoring position all game. (They went 2-for-2.) Three Lugnuts runners were caught stealing.

2015: A triple play! Also: The Lugnuts clinched their first division title since 2012, beating the Great Lakes Loons, 8-2, on a Saturday night at Cooley Law School Stadium. In the second inning, the Loons had Kelvin Ramos at second base and Alex Verdugo at first base with none out. Jimmy Allen sent a line drive to shortstop Richard Ureña, who dropped it – allowed by the umpiring crew – and then tagged out Ramos (one out), stepped on second to force out Verdugo (two outs) and threw to first to retire Allen (three outs).
