WICHITA SURGES LATE, CARDS FALL 7-3: The Wichita Wind Surge scored 5 runs from the 7th inning on and the Cardinals went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position as the Birds fell 7-3 on Wednesday night at Hammons Field. **Matt Lloyd** went 2-for-3 with a home run and 2 RBIs, while **Nathan Church** and **Jeremy Rivas** each chipped in with two hits apiece. **Alex Cornwell** fired his 2nd quality start of the season allowing 2 ER on 6 H over 6.0 IP while tying a season high with 7 strikeouts. The loss was just the Cardinals' 2nd of the season to Wichita, and the first time they've fallen to the Wind Surge at Hammons Field.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Travis Adams** makes his 13th start (15th appearance) of the season for Wichita...Last pitched in relief of Kyle Jones on Thursday, July 4 at Tulsa and took the loss allowing 4 ER on 7 H with 6 K over 3.2 IP...It was his first relief appearance since May 24 vs San Antonio...Came after going 2-1 with 2.05 ERA over 4 starts in June, striking out 27 over 22.0 IP...Has been touched up by the Cardinals this season, going 0-2 with a 14.09 ERA in 2 starts against Springfield, allowing 16 H and 13 R (12 ER) over just 7.2 IP...The Birds are batting .432 against him...Spent the entire 2023 season in Wichita's starting rotation and went 4-10 with a 5.66 ERA over 26 appearances (25 starts)...Made 5 starts against Springfield, going 1-2 with a 5.91 ERA...Spent the 2022 season between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids and went 6-8 with a 3.93 ERA in 22 starts...Selected by the Twins in the 6th round of the 2021 draft out of Sacramento State...Went 6-3 with a 4.31 ERA in 14 starts with the Hornets in 2021...24 years old

CARDS, SURGE SQUARE OFF FOR FINAL TIME AT HAMMONS FIELD: The Cardinals head into the All-Star break with a six-game series at home against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins), the final regular season meeting between the two in Springfield. The Cardinals swept a six-game series from Wichita in April at Hammons and come into the series 11-1 in the season series.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

EDMAN REHABBING IN SPRINGFIELD: St. Louis Cardinals utilityman **Tommy Edman** began his rehab assignment with Springfield on Tuesday night going 1-for-3 with an RBI as the DH and got Wednesday off. The 5-year veteran is recovering from right wrist surgery last October and has not played in a game yet this season. In 137 games with St. Louis in 2023, **Edman** batted .248 with 13 HR and 47 RBIs while going 27-for-31 in SB playing 2B, SS, CF and RF. He won a Gold Glove Award at 2B in 2021. **Edman** and the Cardinals agreed to a 2-year, \$16.5 million deal in January.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half, the Cardinals have won 7 of their last 9 to run their 2nd-half record to 8-6. Springfield had a 5-game winning streak snapped by NW Arkansas on Friday night, their longest since winning 9 in a row to start the season.

HOME COOKING TASTING BETTER: Going 4-2 over their last 6 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals are doing their best to reverse their fortunes at home. Over their last 6 home games, during which the Cardinals have outscored their opponent 34-23, Springfield has lowered its home ERA from 6.07 to 5.65. Going into last Sunday's game against the Travelers the Cards had dropped 11 of their last 12 and 22 of 28 at Hammons Field after an 8-0 start to the season. The Cards are now 18-24 (.439) at home this season.

On the road, the Cardinals have a league-best 27-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.55, just 0.10 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

POWER SURGE: While the Cards have been on the wrong side of the home run ball during the 2024 season, Springfield has outomered their opponents 7-1 over their last 9 games. The Cardinal pitching staff went 7 straight games without allowing a homer before Luke Keaschall's leadoff shot to open the ballgame on Tuesday night at Hammons Field.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Cardinals bullpen has especially been up to the task, going 6-2 during this most recent stretch with a 2.43 ERA. Birds relievers have thrown 40.2 innings over the Cards last 9 games for an average of 4.2 per game and have allowed just 11 ER. Birds relievers during that time have lowered their ERA as a unit from 4.40 to 4.17.

The Cardinals as a staff has been solid while Springfield has won 7 of its last 9, registering a 3.07 team ERA, 3rd in the Texas League during that time.

CROOKS CRUSHING: Despite an 0-for-5 performance on Tuesday night, Springfield C **Jimmy Crooks** has been filling up the box score recently. Over his last 12 games since June 23, the last day of the first half, **Crooks** is batting .381 (16-for-42) with 2 2B, a 3B, 2 HR, 10 RBIs and a 1.066 OPS.

Among Texas League leaders, **Crooks** is the leader in OBP (.412), is 2nd in batting average (.304), and 3rd in OPS (.847).

RED-HOT RIVAS: Cardinals SS **Jeremy Rivas** has enjoyed a breakout campaign at the plate and has been swinging it particularly well of late. Over his last 16 games since June 21, **Rivas** is batting .375 (21-for-56) with 3 2B and a home run. He has walked 5 times to just 8 K during that stretch and is 6-for-7 in stolen bases.

THE FUTURE IS BRIGHT: Major League Baseball announced the AL and NL rosters for the 25th annual All-Star Futures Game, and two Cardinals pitchers were honored with a nod. **RHP Tink Hence** will be taking part in the event for the 2nd straight season, and **LHP Quinn Mathews** also received the honor in his first full season of professional baseball. The game will take place Saturday, July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 220.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 42 straight games without a home run.
