.295-284 MATTHEWS & ADAMS TAME I-CUBS IN DES MOINES: Zebby Matthews and Travis Adams Under Gardenhire (since '21)... combined for nine innings of one-run baseball and Carson McCusker's two-run double in the fourth stood up as the Saints edged lowa 2-1 in Tuesday night's series opener. Current Streak last 5 Matthews was superb in his third start of the year, retiring the first six lowa hitters he faced and flashing a fastball that topped out at a career-high 99.5 miles-per-hour on his second-to-last pitch of the night. He struck out seven across five innings, and was Last 10. Home touched up for a run by the bottom of the order in the third (a leadoff double by Carlso Perez turned into a 1-0 lead when Reese McGuire singled). In the fourth, McCusker got a Road Overall Series. 1-1-1 2-0 fastball and hammered it over centerfielder Kelvin Alcantara's head, leaving the bat at 111.8 mph. Adams pinned down a 12-out save, giving up just 2 hits and punching out Home Series 1-0-1 Away Series. .0-1-0 a pair. The Saints were helped out by two terrrific grabs by Jeferson Morales, including ____3_1 flagging down a game-tying hit in the gap in left-center to end the ballgame. fastballs to begin the season and rank third in the International League as a team by weighted on-base average (wOBA) with a .387 mark that trails only Louisville (CIN) and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY). The Saints are hitting .318 (74-233, 1st in IL) while slugging .451 (6th in IL) with a 21.5% whiff-rate (3rd-lowest) on the hard-stuff. Five of the seven St. Paul home runs have come vs fastballs so far this season. Conversely, the Saints rank 12th in team wOBA against non-fastballs (.276). Some of the Saints' best hitters against fastballs early are listed below:

1-0 Mccusker Mashing: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks t-3rd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below), averaging 96.4 mph on his batted balls in 2025. The 6-8 slugger crushed two game-winning homers, his first two of the season, during the previous homestand and crushed a two-run double on Tuesday in Iowa that registered 111.8 mph off the bat, the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Saint this year. McCusker now has four of the top-6 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. Since making his Triple-A debut on August 24 last season, his average exit velo is tops among Saints hitters with at least 25 AB during that stretch (91.6). Now just 33 games into his short Triple-A tenure, he already has eight batted balls registered at 110 mph+ (four so far this season).

WALKIN' DOWN THE LINE: St. Paul's 73 walks drawn as a lineup currently ranks t-3rd in the International League entering Wednesday and the Saints' .371 team on-base percentage is second only to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY). The Saints have drawn at least two walks <u>in</u> each game this season and have taken four or more bases on balls in 10-of-13 contests so far this year, peaking with as many as 10 in a game twice this year.

GET IN THE GAP, BALL!!: Despite a propensity to get on base, the St. Paul lineup has struggled to consistently hit for power early in the season. Before last Thursday, the Saints ranked second-to-last in the International League with 15 extra-base hits. After cracking 17 in the past five games since, the Saints still rank just <u>among the bottom-5 in the IL in XBH (</u>32) and 11th in SLG% (.376). The Saints are bottom-3 in the league in HR (7) even after hitting six out of the ballpark the past six games entering Wednesday.

START ME UP: The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a tremendous start to the year, spinning a 2.36 ERA among starters that ranks tops in Triple-A and fifth in Minor League Baseball to open the year. If you throw out David Festa's rocky outing on April 4 in game two of a doubleheader in Columbus (3.1 IP, 5 ER), the Saints starting staff have a 1.62 ERA (9 ER, 50.0 IP). The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so (It's only the <u>second time ever</u> that Saints starters did not allowed a run in three consecutive games with the last coming from June 29-July 1, 2023 when Randy Dobnak and Blayne Enlow threw 5.0 shutout in back-to-back games before Dallas Kuechel vent 4.1 scoreless the following night, all against Gwinnett)

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints Opening Day roster features nine of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to Baseball Minifesora's 109-30 prospects according to MLB.com and ten according to baseband. America while also touting five of Minnesora's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No 2. MLB.com, No. 2 BA), INF Luke Keaschall (3/3), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Both Rodriguez (19/37) and Keaschall (45/60) rank among the top-100 overall lists of both publications.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins have won two of their last three following a 4-11 start after beating the Mets, 6-3, yesterday at Target Field. Brooks Lee made it a three-run lead with his first homer of the season in the 7th, backing a quality start (6.1 IP, 3 ER) from Bailey Ober. Down in Low-A Fort Myers yesterday, Brock Stewart struck out two-of-three batters faced, totaling 17 pitches in his first game of MLB rehab assignment. Saints rehabber Brady Feigl went a scoreless frame (1 SO, 1 BB, 0 H) on 20 pitches as the Mighty Mussels won 9-4.

LAST APPEARANCE: In his first home start of the season, pitched around traffic in 4-or-5 innings of work, but extended his scoreless streak to 10.0 consecutive innings to open the season, another no-decision. Recorded five fly-ball outs and just one on the ground out. Induced eight swings-and-misses, four each on the 4-seamer and the cutter, while recording two punchouts with the cut-fasthall. the other with the cut-fastball.

ON THE FAST TRACK: In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS: Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where

LET'S GET FUNKY: Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in <u>last year's mid-season report</u> that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior. Tech as a redshirt junior.

MAD MORRIS: Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but reall it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."
